External SSD

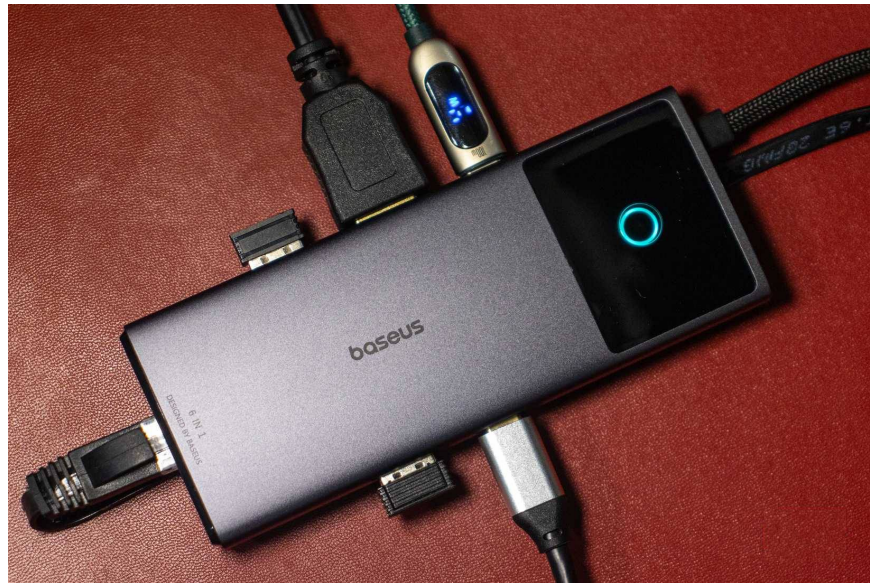
An economical way to speed up

USB-C hub

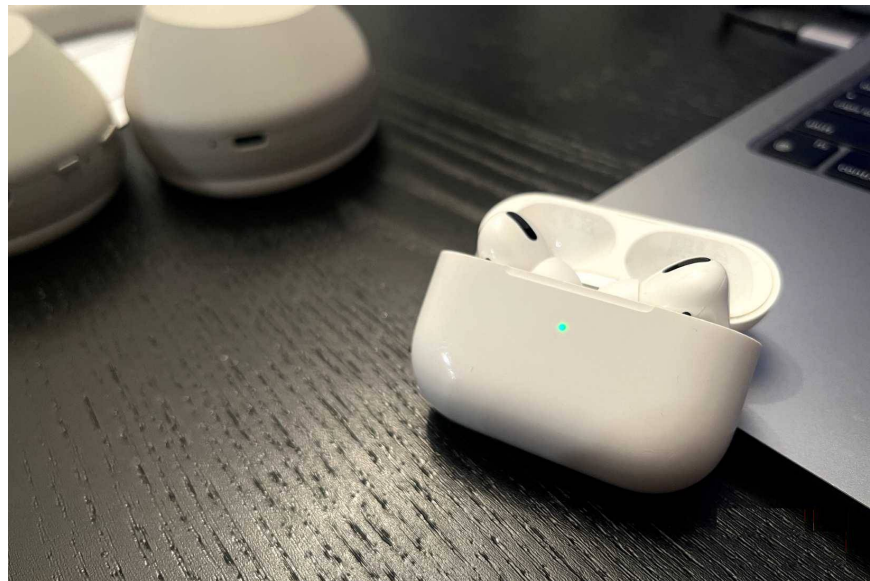
Helps keep your desk neat and tidy

Instead of constantly swapping cables or carrying multiple adapters, using a USB-C hub makes more sense. It only takes up one port on your laptop and opens up a whole new world of connectivity.

Create a space of concentration in a noisy world



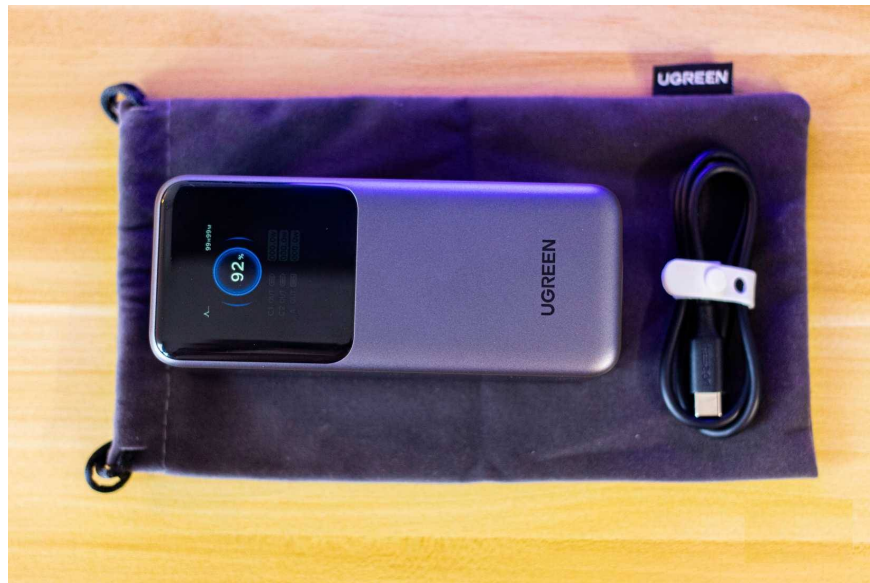
