In this article, I will introduce the most frequently used shortcuts.



Common keyboard shortcuts for managing Windows

Windows key + up arrow: Maximize the current window.

Windows key + down arrow: Minimize current window.

Windows key + left arrow: Switch the current window to the left half of the screen.

Windows key + right arrow: Switch the current window to the right half of the screen.

Windows + [number]: Opens the applications in the order they are pinned on the Taskbar.

Windows + Home: All other windows are minimized except for the current window.

Windows key + Space: All windows are transparent.

Windows Key + Pause Break: Opens the System dialog box.

Windows + Tab: Minimize 3D windows, press Tab to move to select the display window.

Windows key + B: Move back to the Taskbar

Windows key + D: Minimize windows to the Taskbar, restore them to their *default* appearance.

Windows key + E: Open the Windows Explorer dialog box.

Windows key + F: Opens the search box.

Windows key + L: Phone lock

Windows + M: Minimize all currently visible windows to the taskbar.

Windows key + P: Opens a menu of options for the projector.

Windows key + R: Open the Windows Run dialog box.

Windows key + T: Shows thumbnails of the active applications under the taskbar.

Windows + [=]: Open magnifying glass.

Windows + [+/-]: Adjust the magnifying glass zoom in / out.

Windows key + Shift + Up arrow: Maximize the vertical size of the current window.

Windows key + Shift + Down arrow: Minimize the current window size.

Windows key + Shift + M: Undo zoomed out of all visible windows.

Ctrl + Shift + Esc: Open Task Manager.

Ctrl + Shift + N: Create a new (Folder) folder.

Shortcuts with Window Explorer

Alt + Left arrow: Return to the previous folder.

Alt + Right arrow: *Go to* the following folder.

Alt + Up arrow: Go up one folder.

Alt + Enter: Open the properties window of the current selected directory.

Alt + F4: Close the current window.

Alt + Tab: Switch to other windows, press tab to select the window to display.

Alt + D: Move the cursor to the address bar of the window.

Alt + P: Show / Hide preview.

Ctrl + N: Open a new window like the current window.

Ctrl + Scroll: Zoom in on files in the current directory.

Shift + Del: Delete the selected file, not saving to the trash.

F2: Rename (Rename) the selected file.

Login, Logout shortcut keys in Windows 7

Note: These shortcuts you need to press each button one by one, then press and release the key and then press the key.

Windows key + Right arrow + Enter: Shutdown.

Windows key + Right arrow + Right arrow + S: Restart the computer.

Windows key + Right arrow + Right arrow + R: Sleep mode.

Windows key + Right arrow + Right arrow + W: Switch User (Switch user).
