It can be said that Red Dead Redemption 2 is one of the most spectacular open world games on the market today. There are many interesting but equally challenging tasks that you face in the game, from hunting animals to bank robbers, all of which will be shown to be truly authentic in Red Dead Redemption 2. However, this also has two sides, sometimes gamers will have a lot of difficulties in conquering challenges in the game because of that authenticity.



There will be some basic things you need to know to be able to fully enjoy Red Dead Redemption 2, minimize silly incidents that may inhibit you. So, here are some essential tips in Red Dead Redemption 2 that all players should know!

Take note of everything around you



This seems obvious when we play games, especially action games, but still worth repeating. As for Red Dead Redemption 2, you not only need to focus on the destination or mission requirements, but also pay attention to the surroundings. Stone niches, groves of trees and bushes may contain things you didn't expect. For example, you see a column of smoke rising into the air means someone is burning a camp camp recently. A white circle indicates a nearby task. You will also be able to see or hear the animals nearby to start the hunt.

Always remember to locate the destination on your map



The map in Red Dead Redemption 2 is extremely vast. Therefore, choosing the appropriate way to move is also a problem. There is an accelerated option available in Chapter 2, you can use this option by upgrading Arthur's accommodation.

However, if you are moving in any location, always set the destination on your map, just like you do with Google Maps. For what? The game will show you the shortest routes and with this setting, you can also activate the camera and hands-free mode.

Pay attention to your character



In Red Dead Redemption 2, you must pay attention to both your character stats. For example, health indicators, endurance. Also, you should come to your horse.

All of these indicators need to be maintained, otherwise your character will be affected.

For all offenses that you cause (though random), you will be hunted and accompanied by a bonus, depending on the area you committed, you may be banned go to that area in the future.

So if you commit a crime, don't think about killing more people to escape. Instead, surrender, go to the lawyers or leave the area while the case is investigated. After everything is done, come and return the bonus at the nearest post office.

Understand your horse



Horses are important mounts in this game. Without horses, you will hardly be able to reach anywhere or do anything. That's why you should care about your horse as much as possible.

When you are closer, you and the horse can create new actions, such as whistling to call the horse, or patting, touching the horse to order a specific action.

Friendly behavior with people you meet



Red Dead Redemption 2 uses an honor scoring system. When you do a good job (such as helping strangers), your honor score will also increase. On the contrary, when doing bad things (such as killing people), of course your honor points will be severely deducted.

You will have a lot of advantages when you have a high honor score. And one of the simple ways to increase your honor score is to greet any person you meet, instead of fighting or assaulting them.

talk with strangers



Our children are taught not to talk to strangers, but in the world of Red Dead Redemption 2 it is the exact opposite. Even random NPCs can bring you useful and interesting information, or pay for your work if you help them.

Use Dead Eye Whenever possible



To survive in Red Dead Redemption 2, you need to know how to use your gun effectively. Using Dead Eye is the best method to win a gun battle. This function allows you to target a number of enemies at the same time following slow movements, which gives you certain advantages.

To activate Dead Eye, hold the target aiming button, and then click on the right bar. Everything will slow down, allowing you to locate the enemy before firing.

Keep your weapons clean



During the exploration of the world of Red Dead Redemption 2 you will get many different weapons, and you will definitely have to use them a lot.

Your weapons will be dirty after being used a lot, and when dirty, they will slow down and may not work exactly as before. So buy some gun oils and clean your weapons regularly, even more than cleaning your clothes. To clean up your weapon, simply open the Weapon Wheel, select a weapon, and press the right bar to check. Information on the state of the weapon will be displayed, where you can select the weapon cleaning option.

Pay attention to the fence areas



In Red Dead Redemption 2, the fenced area is often the place where black market traders will buy and sell illegal items. You will be unlocked this trading feature after completing the task of chapter 2, but you can also go a long way to Saint Denis to meet these merchants wedding. They will buy things that you don't need, and sell you valuable items such as new recipes, charms, and a key breaking device, for example.
