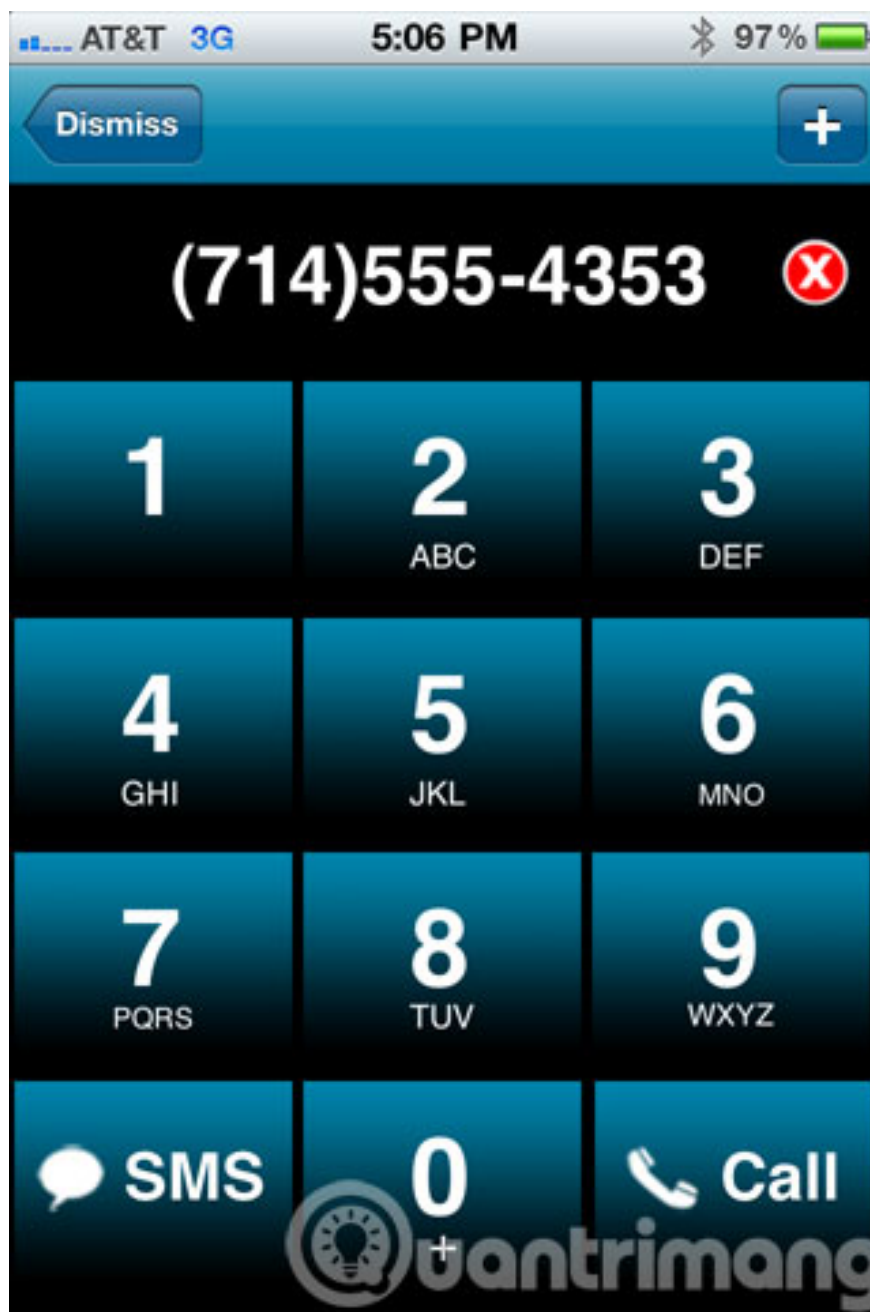
Stating when you left the house

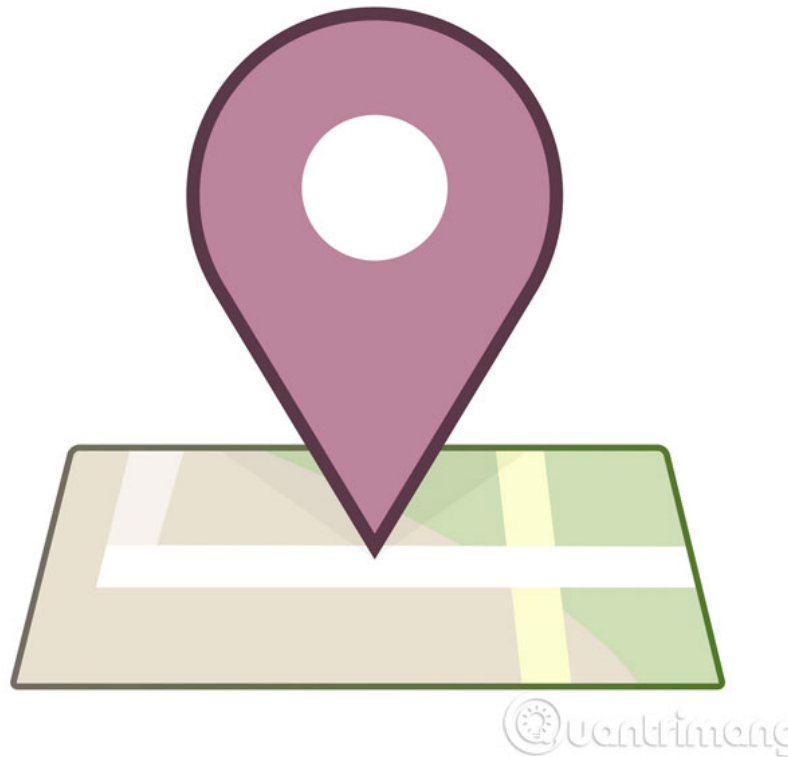
