

# Things to note when using a winter heating fan

There are now many families opting for a fan to create a warm space for families in the cold winter. However, heating fans also have their proper use, to both ensure warmth for the family, and to operate the fan capacity properly.

For families with young children or the elderly who are not eligible to buy two-way air conditioners, heating fans will be the first choice to protect family health during winter days. However, to use fans properly, not all families know. How to ensure a warm space for the family, while saving electricity to ensure the durability of the machine is something that everyone cares about.

## 1. Choose the location of fan heating away from people:

It is completely wrong for many families to fan too close to their position, especially for young children. As recommended, the safe distance to set the fan heater is about 1.5 m to ensure the operation of the fan capacity, both safe for family health. With this distance, we still feel the warmth during use, do not cause skin dryness or eye damage.

In addition, limit objects to be around or too close to the heating fan. In particular, clothes, towels, curtains, . flammable items when placed at heating fans. Avoid blocking the heating elements, air inlet and outlet of the fan to limit the explosion.

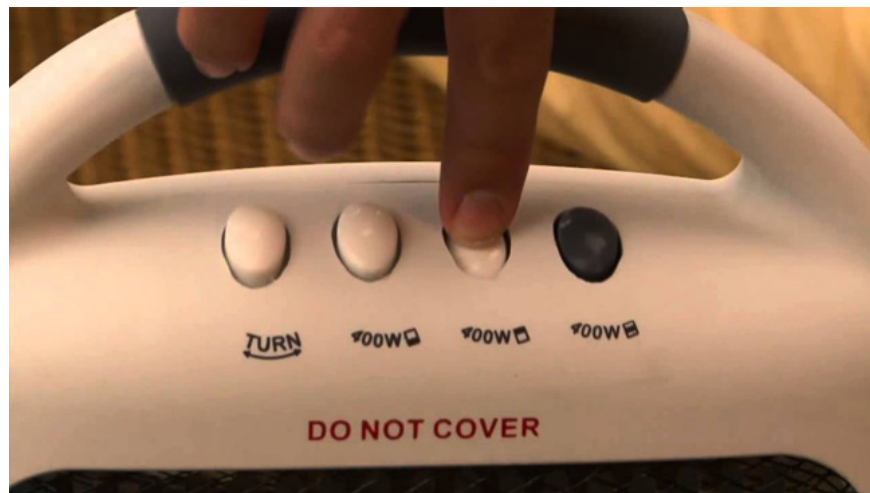


Do not place on chairs, beds, heating fan positions are easy to fall, fall, and easily blocked airways, even if there is an automatic power off feature in these cases, but it does not guarantee absolute safety for users so you need to place a fan on the floor, tabletop or leveling plane, stable. Do not place a heating fan in a humid place, where there is plenty of water to prevent short-circuiting, electrical leakage.



## **2. Use the fan in accordance with the instructions:**

Any type of heating fan comes with an instruction manual. Study first to know the basic buttons on the fan, as well as how to use them. The manual will tell you the information to help you use the fan efficiently and safely like the location, the buttons that correspond to which functions, how to use the heating fan safely, do not do anything when heating fan is operating.



## **3. Use the fan within the specified time:**

Heating fans also have a limited shelf life. We should not use the fan continuously for many hours, but should turn off a few minutes so that they can rest.

When the heating fan is operating for too long, the internal equipment is easily overloaded, many smart fan heaters will automatically disconnect the power in this case. But if your heating fan does not have this feature, the heating fan will continue to operate, fast internal devices are damaged, durability is reduced, power consumption is high and importantly, it is not safe for users. .

#### **4. Use ventilation fan in the room:**

Many people think that, if the room is closed, it will ensure the warmth from the fan radiating, avoiding the escape of hot air out. Those things are completely wrong. A room is closed, the air inside is not circulating, when you enter the room, breathe and breathe in the hot air of the room. At first it will not feel anything but the longer you will feel more difficult to breathe, stuffy, many cases even lead to lack of gas, fainting.

So, open the main door and window to allow good air circulation while using the heating fan.



#### **5. Modify the temperature of moderate fan:**

Just like when using air conditioning, you must adjust so that the temperature of the air conditioner with the outdoor temperature is not too different. And heating fans are similar. When you go out, the big difference in temperature can make your body not adapt well, easily infected with cold. So, if possible, instead of using a fan at the maximum capacity when it is too cold, you should instead incorporate a moderate heating fan and exercise so that the body will warm itself better. .
