#5 Villagers can run faster than players

These villagers simply don't possess any weapons or armor to protect themselves, so if the village's defenses are threatened, their speed will be the only advantage for survival. in the ruthless Minecraft world.

#4 Farmers are very helpful in growing crops



Farmers are the hardest working villagers in the village that I can find. They take care of the fields all day, making sure the crops grow healthy. They will actively use bone meal on plants to speed up their growth placing spare seeds in the compost bin. If you place a boat near the bed, the villagers can lie on it and rest in the wooden vessel. This seemed ridiculous, like they were lying in a coffin. In essence, this comes from the fact that villagers cannot sit on boats like players, so they will either stand up or lie down.
