Is your favorite porcelain cup stained by tea or coffee stains that can't be washed? Why don't you try bleaching them with vinegar? Rinse two small tablespoons of vinegar around the inside of the dirty cup, then rinse with clean water, you will be satisfied with the cup as beautiful as new.

Vinegar also helps you take care of oily hair. Vinegar is a good degreaser for oily hair, because it helps balance the pH level. Wash your hair with your usual shampoo, rinse with clean water, and then wash your hair with 1/4 cup of vinegar. Finally rinse with clean water.

Remove stubborn stains from boots, this is another great use of vinegar. Dip an old discarded shirt in vinegar, then rub it over the stain to restore the original beauty of your pet's boots.

Your sweaters will look silky smooth again with the help of vinegar. Just add a little vinegar in between rinse cycles of the washing machine or mix vinegar in one of the hand rinses, when you hold the dried shirt in your lap, you will feel the extremely soft feeling like a newly bought sweater.

If you have a coffee machine at home, this is another interesting use of vinegar for you to clean this machine. Fill the water tank with vinegar into the water tank of the coffee machine and press the button to start the machine as if you were making a batch of coffee. Just do this a few times, your coffee machine will be clean of stains caused by long-term coffee.

Vinegar is also an effective assistant to help housewives clean the dirty dishwasher. Just once a month, pour a cup of vinegar into an empty dishwasher, press the button to run the machine once, the vinegar will help clean the soap stains on the inside of the dishwasher and glass details. on the machine.

Another surprising use of vinegar is to easily dislodge the most stubborn price tags or labels on any product.
