

This is the longest road on Earth, no one has ever conquered it

If every day you walk continuously for 8 hours and 20km, you will take up to 1,153 days (more than 3 years) to complete this road.

Recently, Joseph Pienti - YouTber of RealLifeLore channel pointed out the longest walking path possible on Earth. This road starts from the coastal village L'Agulhas located in the southernmost - Africa and the final point is the town of Magadan - Russia, 23,068 km long without any interruption.

If every day you walk continuously for 8 hours and 20km, you will take up to 1,153 days (more than 3 years) to complete this road. To walk all the way, you will have to overcome a total change (Elevation change) total of 123,000m, 14 times higher than the height of Mount Everest.



In this journey, you will face many difficulties and challenges, especially crossing the borders of countries. If you ask Google Maps for directions, when entering the start and end points of the journey, this application will show you the shorter route, which is to cross the river by ferry, but then will not be also the longest walking path.

So far, no one has been recorded as conquering this road. Humans have achieved many important milestones in the journey to explore the Earth and the universe, dive into the deepest part of the ocean, conquer the highest peaks, set foot on the Moon but no one has completed the road. this longest set.
