Windows 10X is a new Microsoft operating system, developed to provide maximum support as well as customized interface for dual screen devices.

Windows 10X is a new operating system from Microsoft, developed to provide maximum support and custom interfaces for dual-screen devices such as Surface Neo, HP Omen X 2S, Lenovo YOGA BOOK C930, or Asus ZenBook Pro 15 .

This new operating system basically still fully supports Windows applications, meaning you'll still be able to run all traditional Windows desktop applications on Windows 10X as usual.

Overall, in most Windows 10X user interfaces there are relatively familiar elements like you have seen on Windows 10, such as the taskbar or application icon. However, there will be interesting differences, such as WonderBar.

WonderBar is a completely new user interface, making Windows 10X different from any other computer operating system on the market today. So what is worth experiencing at WonderBar?



WonderBar is an area above the hard or virtual keyboard of 2-screen devices. By default, applications will be allowed to display up to 50% of the WonderBar's space, and this area is also easily accessible using existing APIs. Microsoft's introduction is as follows:

*"WonderBar is an area that is always ready to help Windows 10X users work and work more efficiently by providing additional input feature options to support the keyboard - custom features. select which you will not*

*be able to find or manipulate using the regular keyboard "*.

In addition, WonderBar will also provide the ability to flexibly and efficiently multi-tasking, displaying necessary information and options related to applications running on the system.

In simpler terms, WonderBar will function quite similar to the MacBook's Touch Bar.

For the application, it is possible to go through the Compact Overlay Mode to display a part of the application on the WonderBar, thereby helping to manipulate more effectively. For example, for a photo editing application, you can display the image on the main screen, the editing tools in WonderBar and manipulate directly by hand instead of using the mouse as before. The main purpose that Microsoft aims at this feature is to facilitate the ability to work multi-task without distracting from the content on the main screen.

Virtual touchpads are also an important part of WonderBar.



Finally, WonderBar will also be the area to provide text suggestions during inputting, emoticons, GIFs, even watching videos and many other content.
