However, in the past, during wartime, a white flag often symbolized surrender, so no country wanted to use it. So why would a large country like France use a white flag?



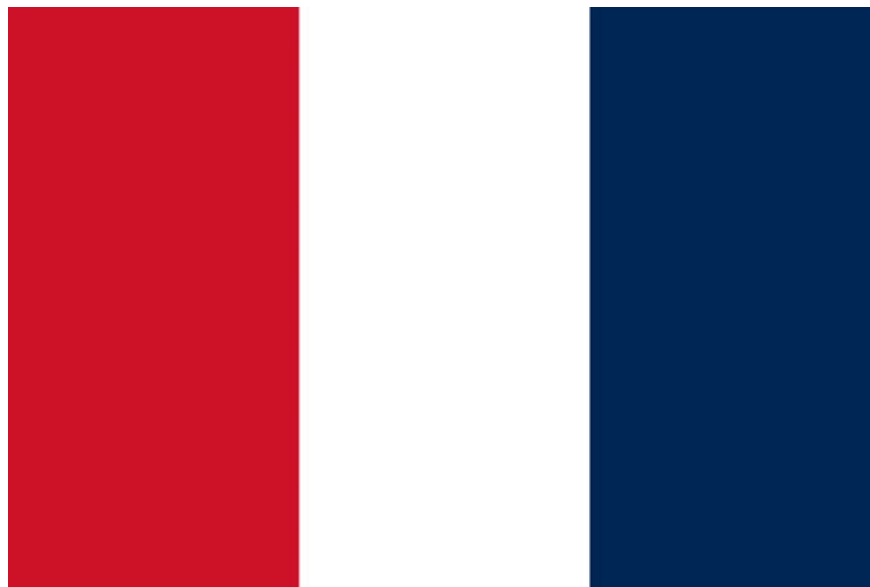
Let's look back at the history of the French national flag to understand the meaning of this country's white flag.

The red and blue are the traditional colors of Paris, while the white in the middle symbolizes the Bourbon dynasty – the royal lineage that ruled France from the late 16th century. These three colors convey the message that the king is among the people, and the people stand alongside the king.

In 1792, the Bourbon dynasty collapsed, and the monarchy was completely abolished in France.

In 1814, following Napoleon's defeat, the Bourbon dynasty was restored in France, with King Louis XVIII ascending the throne. To reaffirm the lost status of the Bourbon royal family, the country changed its national flag to plain white.

With the Second French Revolution in 1830, the country abandoned the white flag and adopted the tricolor flag of blue, white, and red, which it continues to use to this day.



Thus, France is the only country to use a white flag as its official national flag, with the purpose of affirming the resurgence of a monarchy.
