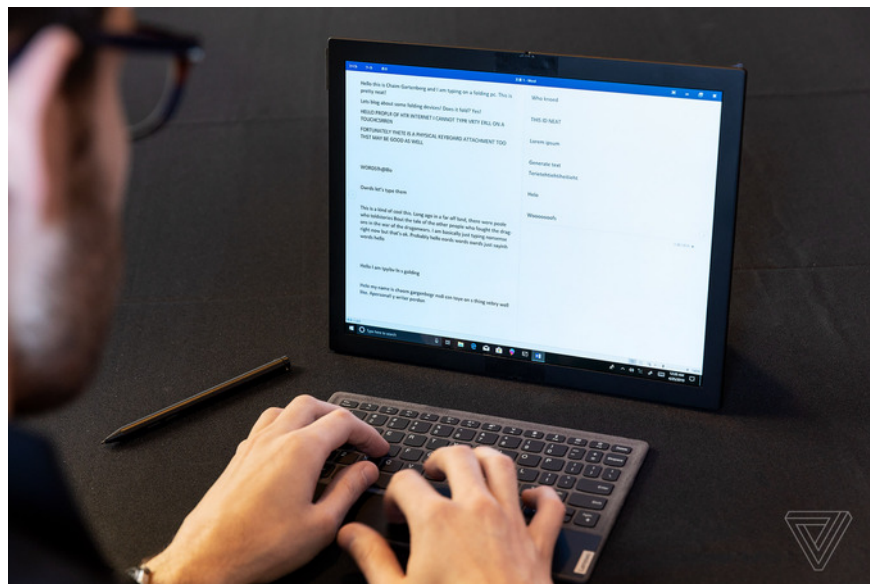


When folding and erecting a screen part, the computer with this folding screen looks like a small laptop with 2 touch screens.

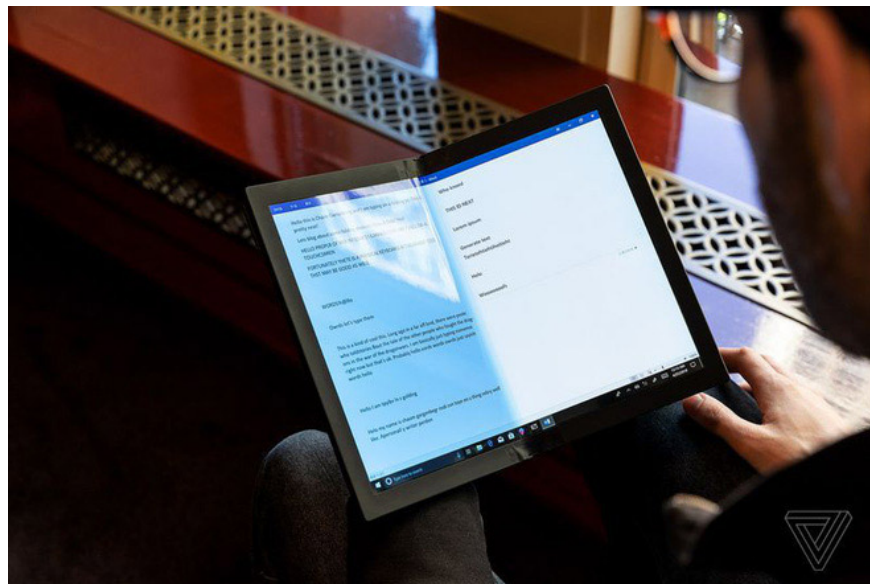




Lenovo's multi-touch screen also supports Wacom stylus to help write. Machine with USB-C connection.
