

# This is what causes the refrigerator to vibrate and shout unusually

Have you ever wondered if your refrigerator is loud and shaking when you use it? So what causes this phenomenon, and how to overcome it? Let's find out in TipsMake.com in the following article!

A **refrigerator** that screams and vibrates is a common phenomenon in families, but many people will certainly not be bothered by this problem. Leaving this condition long will affect the durability of your refrigerator. If you find your refrigerator to be like that, don't ignore the causes and how to fix the refrigerator to vibrate and call out below.

## 1. The refrigerator is cold or the magnet is broken

**Cause:** The refrigerator used for a long time also caused the refrigerator shell to be broken and this is also easy to cause noise. In addition, it is also easy to make a lot of noise when operating on the surface of the refrigerator or with hanging tools that attach magnets to the refrigerator.

**Fix:** To eliminate noise due to this reason, you can press firmly on the 2 sides of the refrigerator to make sure the cabinet is closed. Also you should remove the items placed on the refrigerator, remove the magnet bars in the refrigerator door.



## 2. The freezer drawer makes a sound

**Cause:** In the process of using if you see a loud cry emanating from the freezer, it is very likely that the refrigerator motor's fan motor has been dry or lacking lubrication.

**Remedy:** You should stop the refrigerator operation and unplug the power supply. The next step is to use a screwdriver to open the lid to blow the wind. Looking inside will see the fan motor. You only need to remove the motor, apply oil and reinstall the old position, the refrigerator will operate normally.



### **3. The refrigerator is not balanced**

**Cause:** When the refrigerator is called, you should also check to see if the refrigerator is in a balanced position. Because if you don't put a refrigerator in a balanced plane, the warping part of the refrigerator's foot will touch the floor and make a sound.

**Remedies:** You should check the balance to see if the refrigerator is listed in a flat place, whether the base of the cabinet is channeled.



#### 4. The waste water tank is damaged

**Cause:** The waste water tank is usually designed under the refrigerator, and is usually mounted on a foam rubber layer so that it will not vibrate and ring when the refrigerator is running. It is likely that during use, for one reason, the compartment is deflected to one side and slightly touches the cooling line or heat sink. Then the compartment will vibrate and create noise.

**Fix:** The sign of recognizing this phenomenon is very simple, just lower your body, if there is noise coming from the bottom of the refrigerator, the cause is the deflated waste compartment. The simple operation is that you just need to move the waste compartment to the right position where the noise will no longer exist.



#### 5. Noise sounds like a wind

**Cause:** When the refrigerator has not reached the desired temperature, the refrigerator will continue to cool, then the fan motor operates causing a 'whooshing' sound. Or because a large capacity refrigerator needs to operate at a higher capacity, it also causes noise.

**Fix:** You should not be too concerned with this noise, this is a normal phenomenon in refrigerator lines.

## 6. The refrigerator does not close the snow causing a noise

**Cause:** Some refrigerators do not close snow when used for a long time, snow will close on the frame, then the ice discharge relay will work to emit a 'rattling' noise.

**Fix:** This is normal machine noise, and usually does not last long.

## 7. Screw catch the cold frame loose

**Cause:** When you hear the refrigerator having a "podium" cry, it is most likely because the 4 screws catch the indoor unit loose.

**Fix:** To remove this noise, you can manually turn off the power, remove the screw and add the cushion and tighten the screw again.

The above are the basic causes for your refrigerator to vibrate, shout and make some corrective measures accordingly. Hopefully with simple cases you can fix yourself at home, for more difficult cases you should ask the help of a refrigerator repairman for maintenance. Or if you need replacement, you should find a reliable address to order a new refrigerator !
