

# This is what you actually get with the cheapest subscription plan: ChatGPT Go!

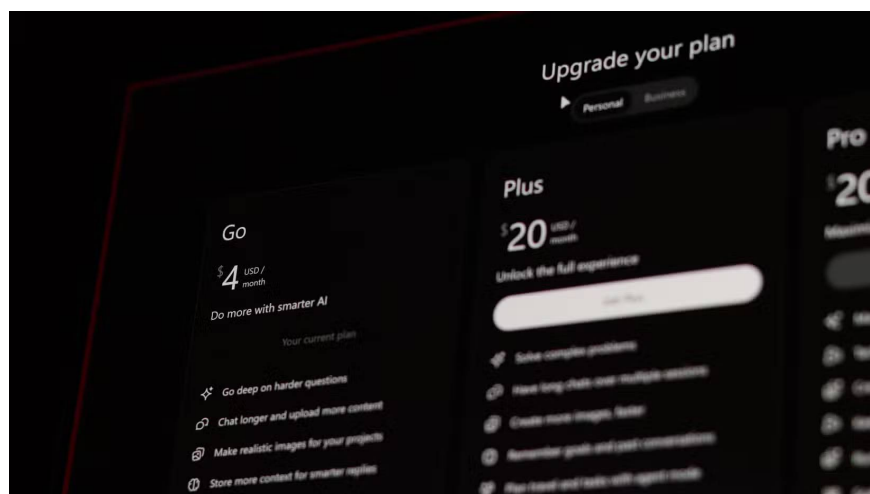
ChatGPT Go includes access to GPT-5, the same top-tier model that powers Plus plan users.

AI subscription services are popping up everywhere, but few can match what the industry's best options can offer. While most AI services like Perplexity and Gemini offer packages starting at \$20, ChatGPT has introduced a Go package for just \$5 for basic access.

Now you can use many free AI chatbots so you never have to pay a dime for AI, but usage limits will still hinder your progress after just a few prompts. \$5 a month is quite attractive considering the subscription prices of competitors. So many people have decided to try ChatGPT Go, and here's what you actually get for your money.

## Switch from Plus to Go

The difference isn't as big as it seems.

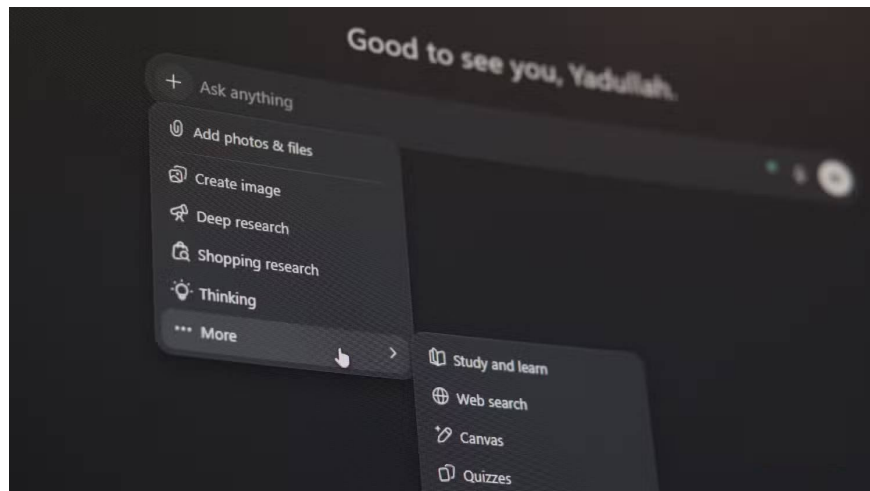
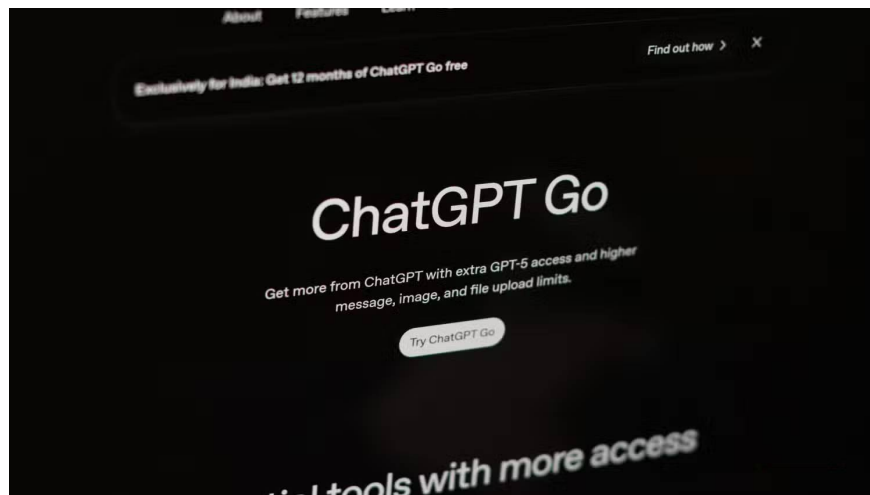


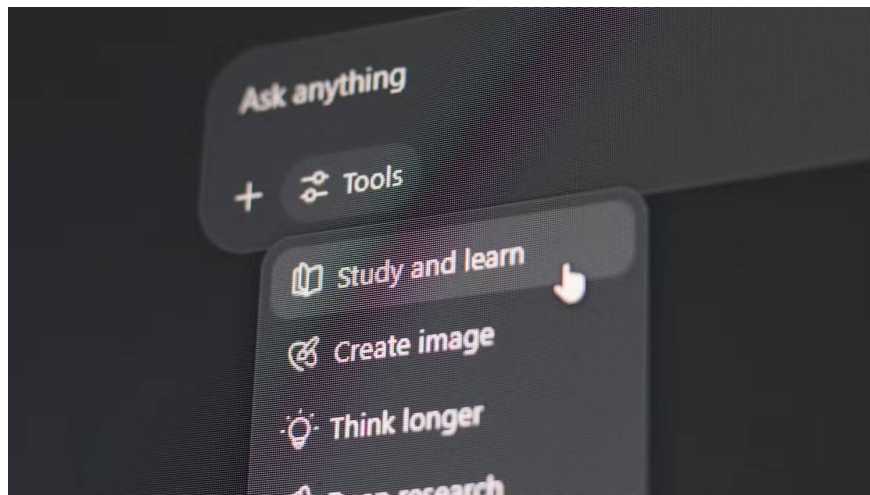
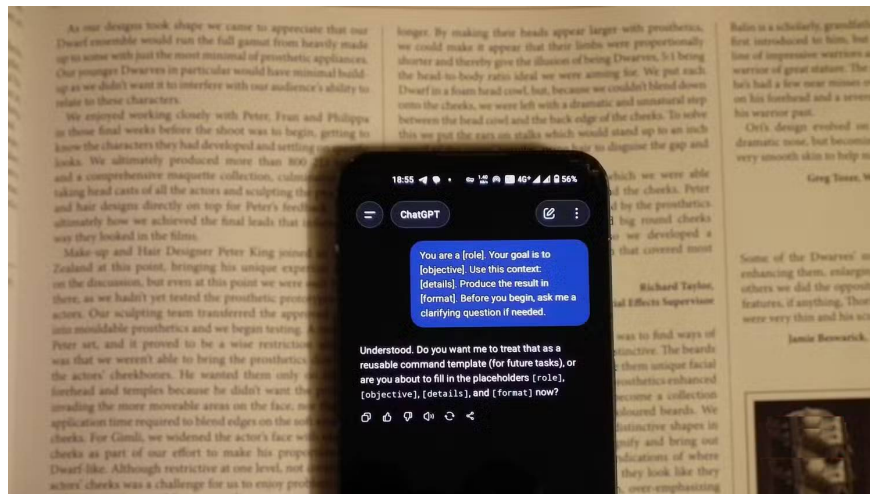
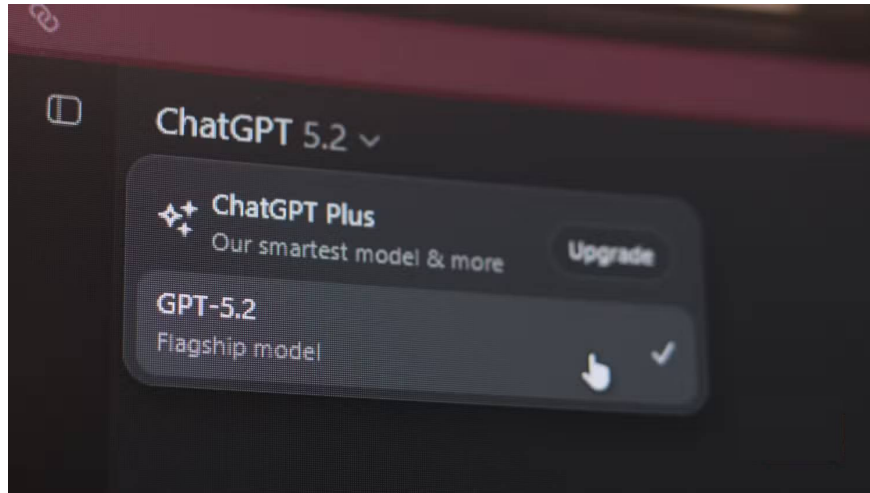
Many people had previously subscribed to ChatGPT Plus , paying \$20 a month for a professional user experience whenever needed. When Go launched, the price difference was hard to ignore. Given the 75% price drop, some decided to downgrade and see if they would immediately regret it.

Fortunately, the transition went smoothly. Chat history remained intact, custom GPTs created still worked, ChatGPT's automation features that speed up daily tasks still functioned, and no upgrade notifications appeared after every two prompts. Essentially, you'll have the same user experience with ChatGPT Go as with any other ChatGPT subscription plan.

## What ChatGPT Go offers you every day

The core experience remains the same, only refined in a few minor details.





ChatGPT Go includes access to GPT-5, the same top-tier model that powers Plus plan users. That's its most notable feature, and it's more important than you might think. You don't get an outdated, performance-reduced model, but rather OpenAI's latest inference engine. The GPT-5 usage limit on the free plan is too low for any reasonable work, but the Go plan addresses that issue.

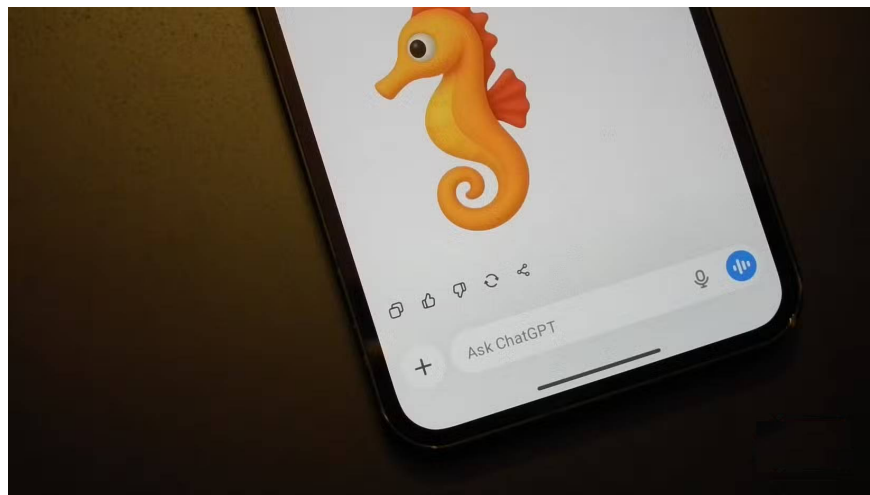
Beyond the basic model, Go offers many additional features. You get the ability to create scalable images, upload files for documents and spreadsheets, expanded memory (to allow ChatGPT to remember context between conversations), data analysis using Python, and the ability to create and use custom GPTs. Even the Shopping Research feature, ChatGPT's groundbreaking new feature for holiday shopping, works well.

The memory feature is particularly useful. When using the free version, you'll constantly have to re-explain the project context. On Go, ChatGPT remembers your workflow between sessions. You can go back to a conversation from a week ago and it will retain the relevant details without you having to retype everything.

However, complex data analysis is where this package begins to reveal its limitations. It will handle simple CSV files with ease, but if you are working with a complex multi-sheet dataset requiring cross-referencing and custom calculations, then the limitations begin to appear.

## **There are still limitations you need to take into account.**

**Excessive use will reveal your limitations faster than you think.**

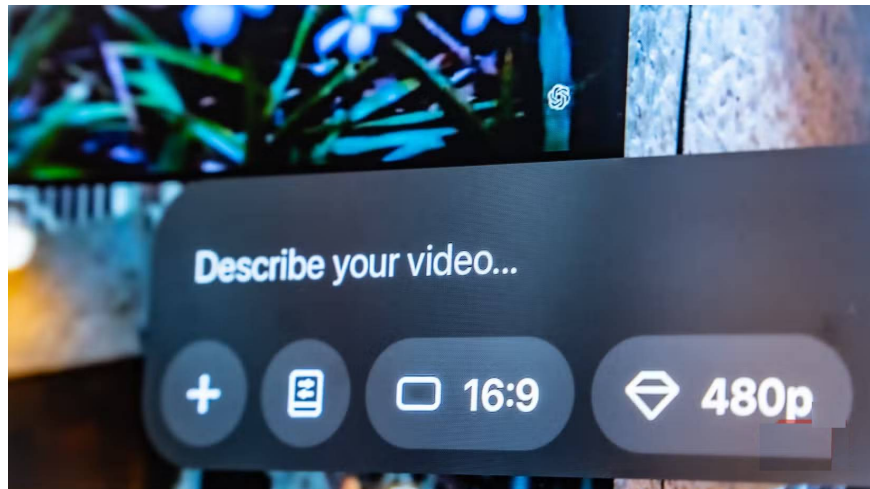


No matter how good it is, Go is not without its limitations – and you'll feel that if you use it a lot. ChatGPT Go is only available in certain regions. OpenAI has a full list of regions you should check before considering downgrading .

The message limit is the most obvious limitation. While OpenAI doesn't publicly disclose the exact number, on average you can send between 10 and 15 messages within a 3-hour period during peak hours. This might sound restrictive, but you rarely reach this limit when researching or writing.

As long as you carefully craft your questions, allowing the model to think for itself and avoiding sending questions haphazardly, everything will be fine. Building a ChatGPT question that's appropriate for every situation can be helpful, especially if you're using an AI service for repetitive tasks.

Image creation also has daily limits, although not as consistent as with text conversations. File uploads are also expanded compared to the free plan, but are still limited. However, the most significant missing feature is Sora, OpenAI's video creation tool.



You also lose model flexibility. With Plus, you can switch between GPT-4o, GPT-4 Turbo, and GPT-5 depending on the task. Go mostly limits you to GPT-5. This isn't a huge problem, especially if you're not someone who likes using specific models for certain tasks. Most of the time, GPT-5 is more than enough for any task you assign it to. But if you prefer specific ChatGPT models, Go might not be sufficient.

Last but not least, you may experience slower response times compared to the Plus plan, especially during peak hours.
