History of men's shirt button

Many historical experts hypothesize that the cause of the right button of men's shirts is in the past, clothing must be designed to store weapons.

Chloe Chapin, a fashion historian at Harvard University, said that during wartime, we always kept weapons in our clothes. Since most people are right-handed, the button is placed in the right flap.



But there are some other opinions that the necktie button must have appeared before the gun is not popular in Europe.

According to Paul Keers, author of the famous book "A Gentleman's Wardrobe": "At that time, gentlemen's swords were worn on the left to draw with the right hand. cover up, entangled when drawing swords, so old gentlemen need a buttoned shirt in the right flap. "

In return, the button of the men's shirt is placed on the right flap to make it easier to withdraw weapons.

But why must the women's cuffs be reversed?

One of the most plausible hypotheses is that in ancient times, women's dresses had many floors, so they needed a helper when wearing.



Melanie Moore, owner of the women's fashion brand Elizabeth & Clarke, said: "Ancient women have never had to wear their own clothes, that job has a maid. Because most people are right-handed, so the cuff button is placed most conveniently with the opposite person".



In general, we have not yet identified the real cause for this difference. But that doesn't matter, because few people pay attention to this detail. Now, the men's shirt on the right and the button on the left has become an unwritten rule in fashion, it can't be helped.

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
