

This may be the future smartphone: No 'holes', no ports, no wires and no buttons

The Meizu Zero, with lots of improvements, is worth considering its appearance.

Meizu, the world's 11th largest smartphone maker, and one of the most popular consumer technology brands in China, announced its latest smartphone on Wednesday - the Meizu Zero, with lots of improvements, is worth the appearance.

Meizu Zero doesn't have any holes - even holes for external speakers. Instead, the phone is equipped with Meizu's "mSound 2.0" technology, which allows audio to come from the screen itself.



Talking about the screen, the Meizu Zero has a 5.99-inch OLED panel, using fingerprint scanner technology built right below the screen, as well as a selfie camera for face detection.

As mentioned, Meizu Zero won't have any connection ports either, so you won't be able to charge this smartphone with the cord as usual. Wireless charging will be the only way for you to power Meizu Zero. Thankfully, the device will be supported by "super fast" wireless charging technology, so there's no need to worry about charging.



Speaking a little more about Meizu's 18W wireless charging solution, if the specifications as announced are reached, this new fast charging technology will bring a much greater capacity than charging methods. wires of other reputable manufacturers such as Apple (7.5W capacity) and Samsung (9W capacity).Based on the above parameters, it is theoretically possible to see that Meizu's wireless charging technology will shorten battery charging time by almost half compared to other brands' technology.However, we will still have to wait until the commercial version of Meizu Zero is released to be able to make certain assertions.

The Meizu Zero has IP68 water resistance ratings, water and dust resistance - just like Apple's iPhone XS and Samsung's Galaxy S9 - so you can comfortably soak this phone with a maximum depth of 2m in about 30 minutes .However, one thing that experts expect more in Meizu Zero is that this phone should be better for water resistance, because it doesn't have any connection ports or holes in the body. .



In fact, although the Meizu Zero doesn't use any connection ports, this device has two ultra-small needle holes: One for microphones and one for emergency reset. These two holes were hidden by Meizu quite well, as well as very small and hard to detect, but to effectively combat water is another story. This is probably the reason why this smartphone cannot be completely waterproof.

You may wonder if there is no hole, how to install a SIM card? Meizu has removed the traditional sim tray to encourage the use of embedded SIM, as well as eSIM technology. These technologies offer superior benefits over traditional physical SIM. In addition, Meizu said the launch of this smart phone in China will be decided by operators and how they deploy eSIM technology.



Meizu Zero will not have any buttons. The device has virtual buttons on either side, using tactile feedback technology, so you will feel slight vibration when you turn on, turn off your phone or adjust the volume with these virtual buttons.



Besides the design and appearance highlights, the Meizu Zero's configuration is also remarkable. It will be powered by Qualcomm's latest Snapdragon 845 processor (used on most popular Android smartphones in 2018), Bluetooth 5.0 and 12MP dual camera Sony IMX380 f / 1.8 OIS + 20 MP Sony IMX350 f / 2.6, 5.99 inch OLED screen. However, there are still many things we cannot confirm about the Meizu Zero configuration.



The Meizu Zero is expected to be officially launched at Mobile World Congress, taking place from February 25 to 28 this year. Hopefully this device will blow a new wind into the 2019 smartphone market which is showing signs of slowing down after many years of booming development.
