Tips for playing Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles: Shredder's Revenge

The game has 3 difficulty levels

There are no support options in TMNT: Shredder's Revenge. However, new players should not worry because there are 3 difficulty levels to choose from, the easiest is Chill and Gnarly is the hardest.



There is no way to change these settings after starting the game, so players should choose wisely. For those who plan to play alone, maybe choosing Chill will be better. If playing with a full squad, Gnarly or Okay is the best choice.

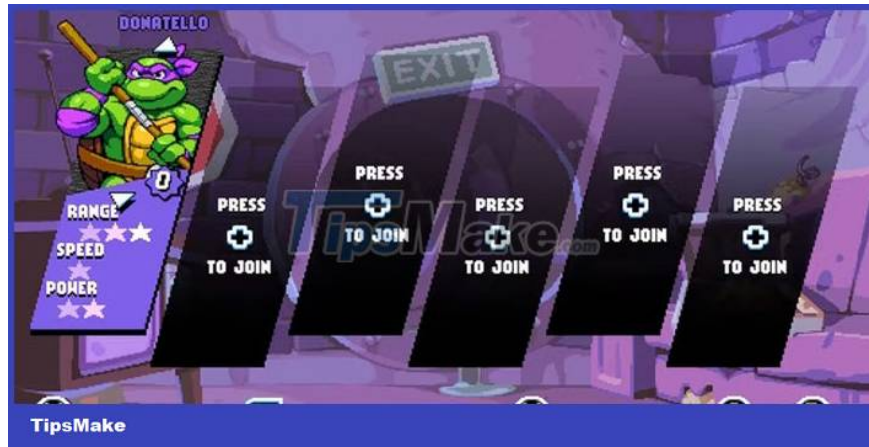
Don't skip instructions

There is no standard tutorial stage in the game. Instead, there will be about 20 pop-ups that guide you through the basic moves of the characters.



While it will be easy for gamers to figure out the mechanics for themselves, it only takes a few minutes to go through this small selection. It is essential to see some unique moves like grabbing opponents and throwing them on the screen, as it can be useful in a match.

Co-op combat experience



Co-op in this game allows the formation of groups of 6, with almost every character in the game, except Casey Jones. Players can co-op using the local feature or find rooms online. Rated as one of the most powerful co-op experiences, players should definitely try playing with a full squad.

Character selection when playing solo

Every character will work in solo mode but Donatello has a lot of side advantages. For example, Donatello's staff gives him a good attack range. Characters will level up so players should stick with one character for the first few levels.



To make the experience in TMNT: Shredder's Revenge easier, players can go to the hidden menu and look in the Fitness Journal. This will show the details of when the character levels up based on points and achievements.
