Learn the mechanics of factions

Players can join countless factions in Total War: Warhammer 3 and each faction has different activities. Any player can find a style of play to his or her liking, as long as he finds out which faction works best. Each faction in the game will be played in a different way, so customization is key.



For example, 2 factions are fighting each other and are very close to breaking out a civil war. However, there is another faction that craves war and will benefit more from destroying nearby settlements. Players should take the time to learn more about each faction before choosing to play.

Find out everyone's strengths and weaknesses



There are many characters for gamers to choose from while playing, and it is beneficial to learn how each character type works during the game. For example, the Khorne faction is suitable for close combat. Meanwhile, there are factions that will fail in melee combat but do better with the use of magic. Spending 15-20 minutes learning how each unit works will make the choice much easier for players.

Subdivide the unit



This seems obvious but many players don't realize that, if they concentrate all their units in one area, it's very easy for enemies to kill them all at once.

While it might be easier to rush all units into an area and cut through the enemy's path, it also makes the unit a lot easier to kill. Better yet, the player should spread out, dividing his army into a long line, to cover all enemy units and ensure that as many units survive as possible.
