The PC version of the game was released in April 2021 and is about to be available on phones on May 24, 2022, promising to create a new game fever.



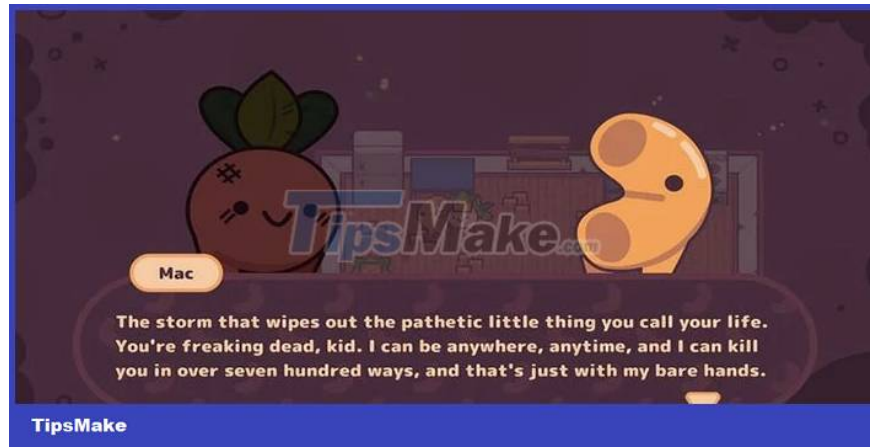

Talk to everyone

Tear off all tax documents

Turnip Boy Commits Tax Evasion means turnip boy evades taxes, so the world of this game is filled with tax documents. Players are not required to pay that amount, but need to tear every tax document into small pieces.



Tear up tax documents not only to satisfy but also to provide players with achievements. Furthermore, gamers who find and tear them one by one will be rewarded with a boss battle and secret ending.

Notes on side quest information

Given the small scale, this game has no world map or minimap. Maps and waypoints are not only superfluous in such a small game, but they also detract from the exciting sense of discovery that, like Elden Ring, is a trend that gamers love.



Although the game is short in length and the map is small, players should still take note of the side quests and their locations. It is essential to remember a particular NPC after finding the item they requested.

Don't miss the heart

One of the similarities between Turnip Boy Commits Tax Evasion and The Legend of Zelda is that the game rewards gamers with a heart full of power to complete a 'dungeon'.



However, getting the heart is not as easy as in The Legend of Zelda, just entering it is done. This heart tree needs to be watered first. After defeating one of the game's bosses, be sure to find a yellow heart tree, as watering it will reward a new heart.
