1. Before sending an email anywhere you need to check the company's reputation carefully. Prestigious websites often provide rights to ensure privacy for users. These companies will not trade their long-standing reputation by

using spam for customers.

2. Check if the websites provide email security reports. You need to carefully review the detailed reports to know what types of emails will be sent to you, how often . Based on that you will decide whether you need those types of emails. In addition, you also need to check carefully to prevent fraudulent companies that can send your email address to hundreds of other websites.

3. Finally, check that the site actually respects your privacy. Usually you will find some documents like "I agree to receive email" with a check box. You can agree to receive emails by clicking on this check box. If that checkbox is already checked, this could be a sign that the site doesn't respect your privacy.

Also need to pay more attention before filling in the online forms. If you are sure that everything on that website is safe, start providing your email address. Remember that once your email gets into the spam site you will be very hard at clicking the 'spam' button or 'deleting' unwanted messages.

Tip: You can create a temporary email address if you are not sure about the privacy of the site.
