The Taskbar bar is one of the most used features in Windows 10 as well as other Windows versions.

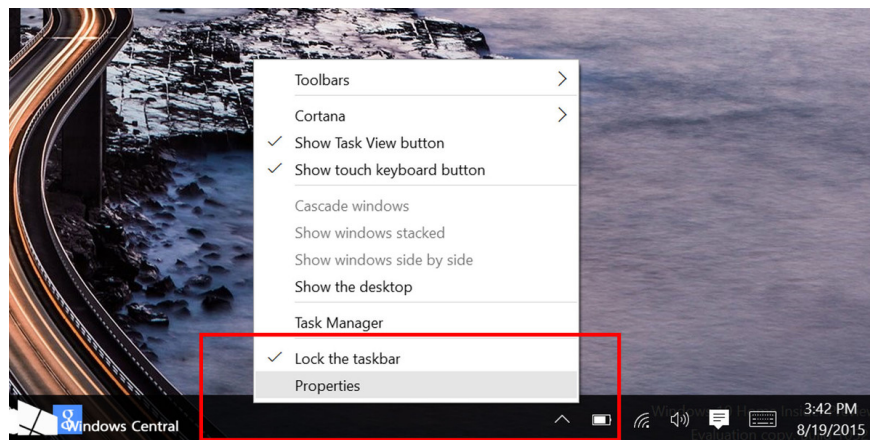
Windows 10 provides you with some features through which you can customize the Taskbar in many ways and the Auto-hide Taskbar feature in Windows 10 gives you more options to customize.

To set up to automatically hide the Taskbar on Windows 10, follow the steps below:

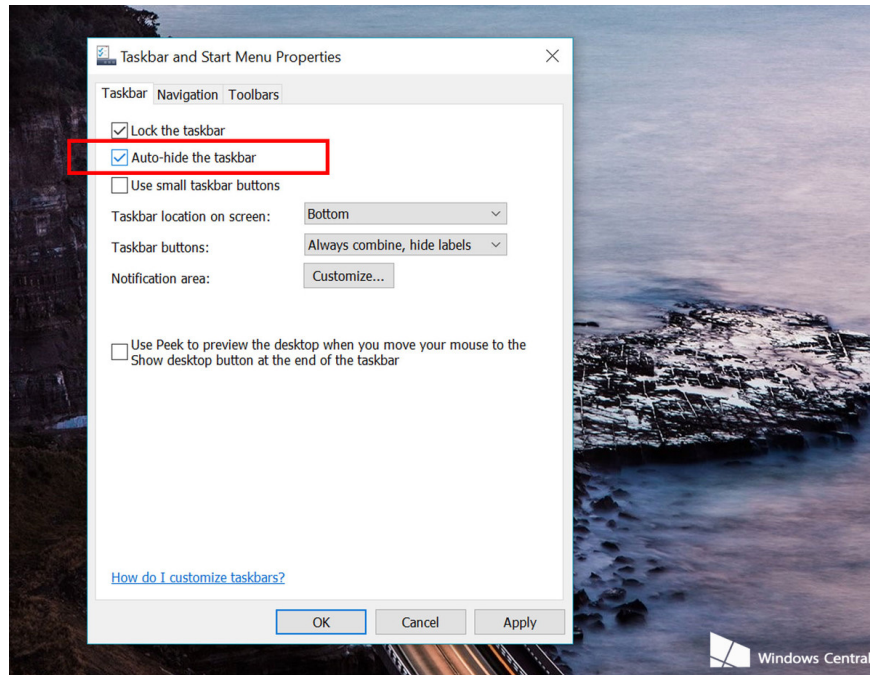
Step 1:



Right-click on the Taskbar, then select **Properties**.

Step 2:

A new window will appear, in this window, check the checkbox **Auto-hide the taskbar** .



Step 3:

Click **Apply** then click **OK** to confirm and save the changes.
