This means that players will have to make use of all survival skills from assassination, hiding until fighting to be the only survivor on the island. However, it is not always possible to escape in a difficult-to-find area, because every time, the limit of moving around the island will be narrowed, if the player moves In the restricted area, the person will gradually lose blood.



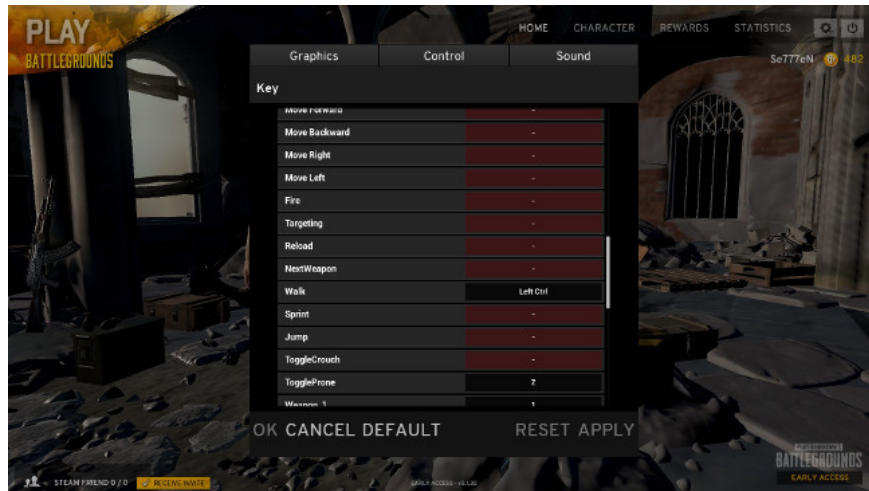
Tips to become the last survivor

1. Press Ctrl + T immediately



Before starting to play, you will be placed in a lobby to prepare and let the system arrange players. Press Ctrl + T immediately to turn off voice chat if you don't want other players to hear your plan. This time in the lobby is only about 1 minute before the system puts all players on a plane before dropping into the island. The time on the plane is usually when people talk to get to know each other, or even curse, causing enemies to resent before they start killing each other. Therefore, it is better to turn off the voice chat as soon as possible and don't think about turning it on if you don't want your opponent to accidentally know your plan and use it against you.

2. Change the default key press accordingly



One thing that you will want to do as soon as you intend to enter a survival battle is to change the game's default key press to suit you. For example, in the game will let the default C key is sitting and the Ctrl key is walking. Most gamers' habits will leave the Ctrl key to sit. If you are not familiar, change it.

After changing, remember to click Apply, otherwise your entire changes will not be saved.

3. When skydiving try to fall slowly and watch the people who have fallen first

After leaving the plane, you and other players will have to jump though to land on the island. Most people will try to land earlier, perhaps to find weapons and equipment for survival soon, but you should not. Use the third perspective mode (the default key is V) while parachuting to be able to see where other players have landed to

choose an empty area.



You should land in an area as far as possible to avoid clashes and easily collect more items. Of course, the farther away from the center, the more you have to worry about being narrowed down to the area, but there is nothing to worry about, you will have enough time to collect the necessary equipment and move to the central area before there is a narrowing of the area limit for the first time.

While falling, press the W key repeatedly to increase the drop distance. Also you can choose to open whether at any time on the flight. However, though it will automatically pop out when it reaches a certain distance on the ground, don't worry if you forget to turn it on.

4. Take advantage of the freelook function

The ability to observe will be the key point in the game if you want to become a winner. And the Battleground has made it easier for players to observe with the freelook feature. Hold Alt key to move the head as well as camera. This way you will be easy to observe around while jumping even while hiding.

5. Pick up items using Tab, not by picking up items one by one

After landing on the ground, you will need to equip yourself. Items such as hats, armor, weapons are often found in houses and buildings (sometimes also outside), taking care to observe under the floor and on the table. At first, it may be difficult to recognize the necessary items in dozens of other messy objects, but if you get used to the shape of each item it will be much easier.

When an item can be collected, you will see a note on the screen to prompt you to pick it up. Instead of collecting each item one by one, use Tab to pick up items. The screen will now display a column showing all the collectable items around, right next to your inventory. Right click on the item you want to collect then the item will quickly be added to your inventory. In this way, you will save a lot of time when the character will not have to perform actions to pick each item one by one.

6. Pay attention to reload when picking up a gun



When you find a gun, it usually won't have bullets but there will be one or more cartridges right next to you. Pay attention to reload right now because those guns will default to unloaded.

Right-click to switch to aiming mode with the gun. Use 1 to 5 number keys on the keyboard to change weapons more quickly.

7. Attach accessories to the gun



In addition to guns, you will find a lot of accessories that can be attached to guns such as laser sight, flash, silencer . If you find some accessory, attach it to the gun to increase function used.

Each gun has a separate accessory slot, which is displayed by the empty cells. Hover on each type of accessory, then the accessory's compatible slot will light up. Right click on the accessory to automatically add it to the gun. If you want to replace other accessories into that slot, do the same.

You can also drag and drop accessories into the gun, but right-clicking the mouse will be faster and easier.

8. Change the camera view between the two shoulders



When you are in the third perspective mode, press and hold the right mouse button, then press Q and E, you can swap the camera view between the shoulders. This will be useful when you are trying to look at different corners of the hiding place.

9. Some devices will have levels

It is great for you to own a helmet, armor or backpack. However, if you find one of those equipment again, don't ignore it and stop and check it. Such a device will have 3 levels, if you own a backpack doesn't mean you can't find a bigger and better backpack.

However with armor, the level will not be as important as the strength of the armor. A high-end, level 1 armor is definitely better than a low-end, level 3 armor. However, the higher the armor level, the more space there is to add accessories.

10. Helmet can save your life



Owning a helmet can help you avoid being killed unexpectedly when shot in the head. Even though you will still lose a lot of blood, your survivability remains.

Level 1 and 2 helmet will protect you when shot in the head but cannot protect you when shot directly in the face. However, level 3 helmets are possible.

11. Increase the volume in the game

Wear headphones and increase the volume in the game. It is extremely important to know the sounds around you to be able to deal with them. In addition to the loud and recognizable noises such as gunshots, vehicle sounds, you can also hear footsteps when running if you focus enough and the sound is loud enough. Try to pay attention to the sound of footsteps and remember that other players can also hear your footsteps.

12. Always close the door when entering and leaving the house
