

Tips to buy Smart TV at the best price

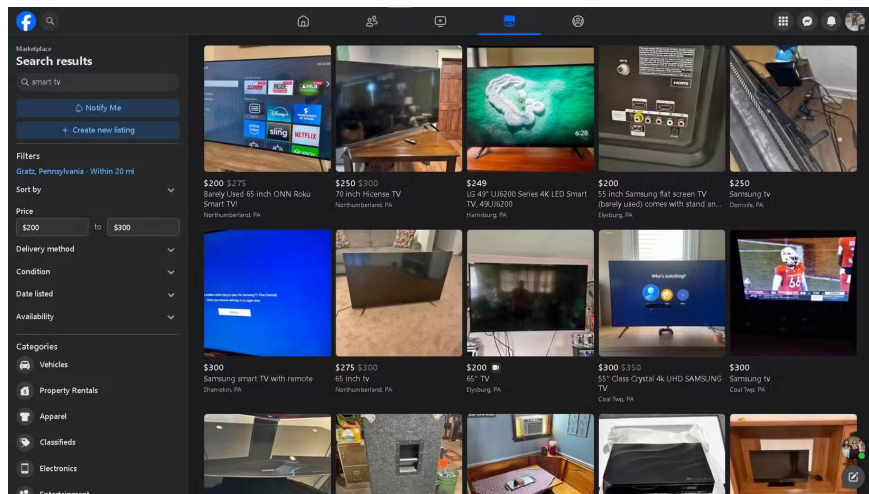
If you're a frugal person who's always on the lookout for bargains, there are a few ways to get that super-luxury Smart TV without breaking the bank.

Maybe you can't attend your local yard sale. That's where Facebook comes in handy, giving you a wider community reach near you.

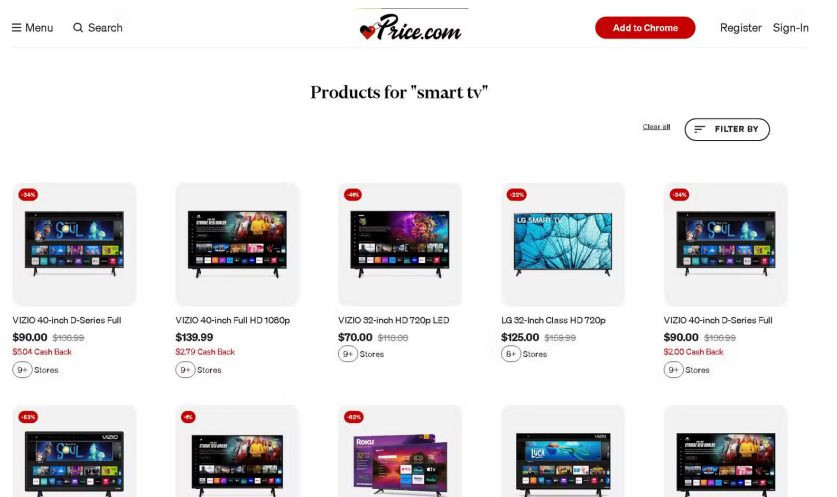
Facebook Marketplace focuses on specific regions. You can even get a cheaper Smart TV if you're willing to pick it up yourself.
