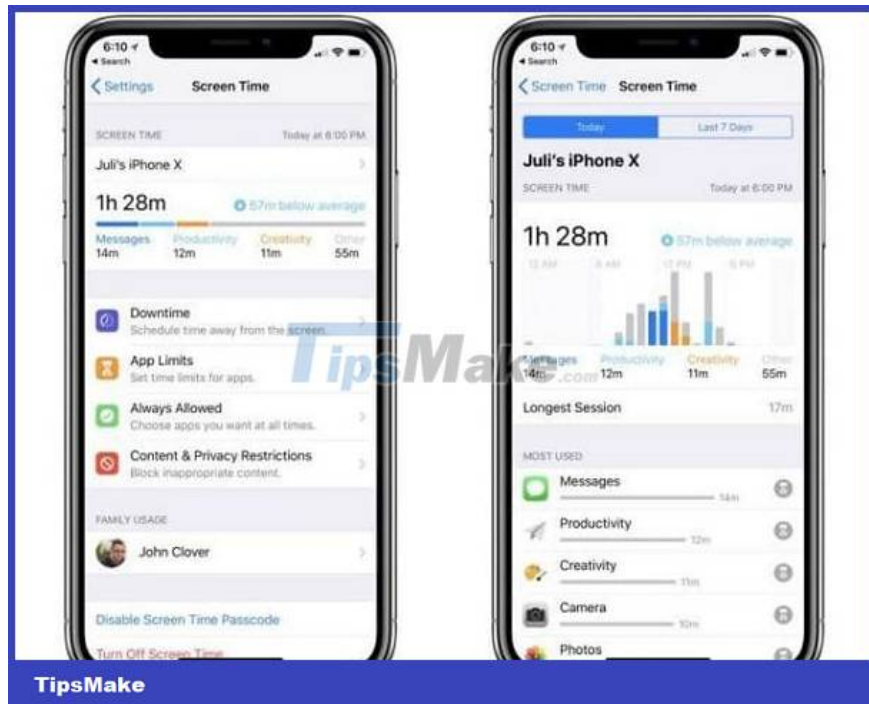
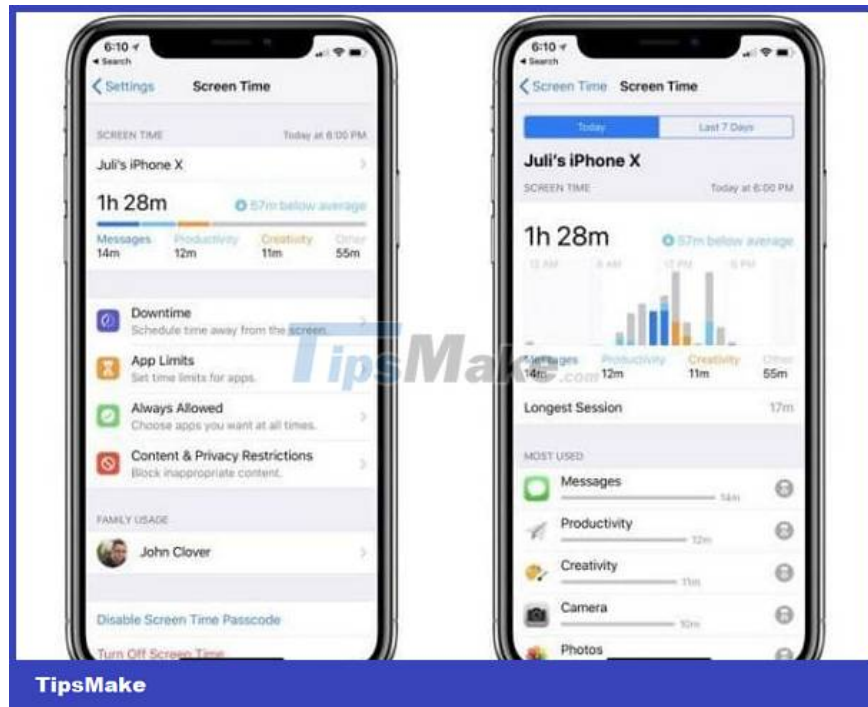


Tips to fix when usage time on iPhone is wrong

The usage time on iPhone is wrong so you want to turn off this feature on your phone? If you don't know how to do it, please refer to iFan immediately

The screen time feature on iPhone brings users many benefits. Thanks to this usage time report, iFan will know the usage time of the phone, monitor battery loss. However, this feature does not always work correctly. Many users have encountered a situation where the usage time on the iPhone is incorrect. Don't worry because TipsMake will help you find a quick solution.





Instructions to fix usage time on iPhone

Normally, the way to view app usage time on iPhone is extremely simple. When you enable the screen time feature, you will receive a weekly screen time report. Users can click on it to see details. However, in some cases, iFan discovered that the reported data was incorrect.

There are many reasons why iPhone screen time reports don't work correctly. It could be because websites may be running in the background, apps running in the background, or not working at all. Besides, the iPhone is having some software problem which can also cause the usage time on the iPhone to fail. To fix it, please apply the following measures.

Turn Screen Time off and back on

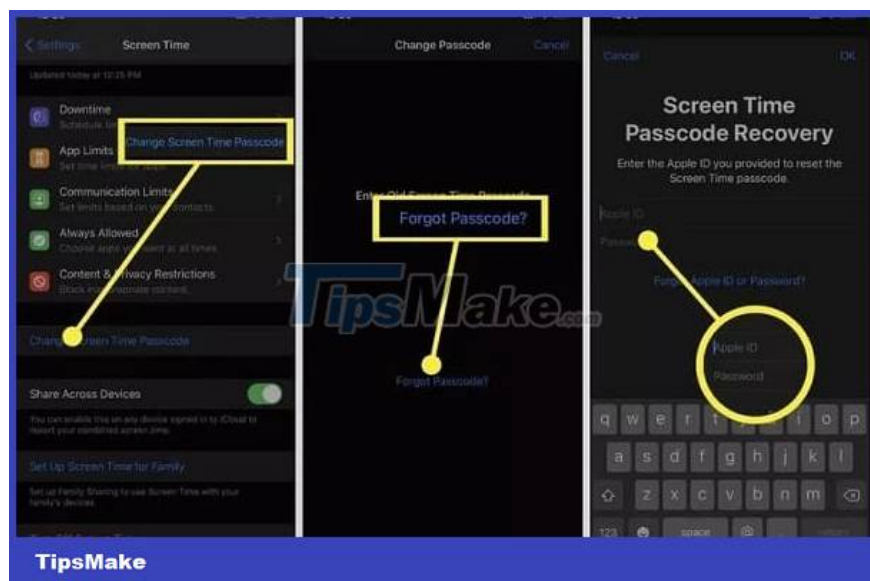
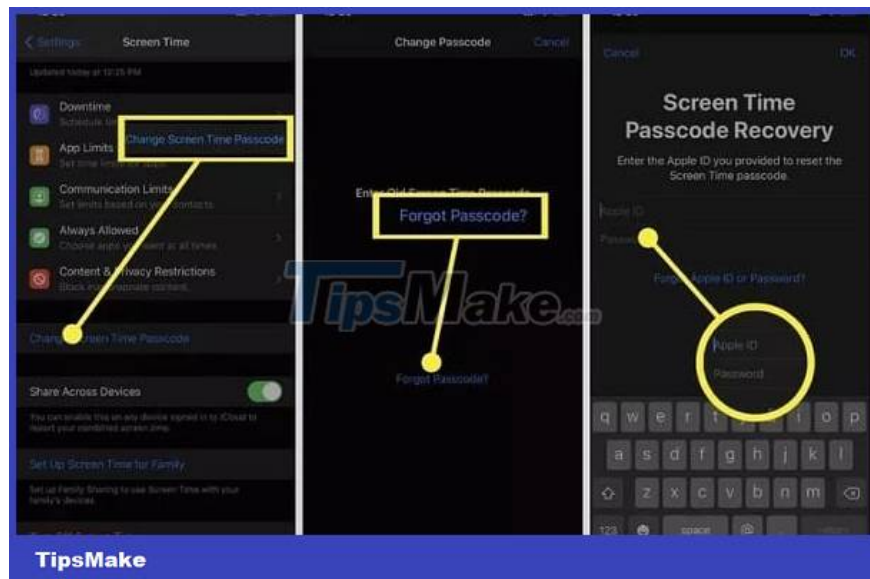
Currently, there is still no way to clear screen time on iPhone. However, users can reset and completely delete previous data histories by turning Screen Time off and then back on. This is also a quick measure to handle the problem of incorrect usage time. Many people often wonder whether or not they should turn off screen time on iPhone? This question depends on your needs. Because many iFans feel monitored and constrained when this feature is enabled. Therefore, they will choose to turn off this feature!

1. Step 1: Go to Settings > Select Screen Time.
2. Step 2: Scroll down and select Turn off screen time.
3. Step 3: When the notification appears, click Turn off usage time again.



NOTE:

In case you have set a password but forgot your iPhone usage time password. The way to turn off screen time on iPhone when you forget your password is: Go to Settings > Screen Time Passcode > Click on Change Screen Time Passcode > Continue clicking Forgot Password (Forgot Passcode) > Enter Apple ID account > Enter new password and confirm again.



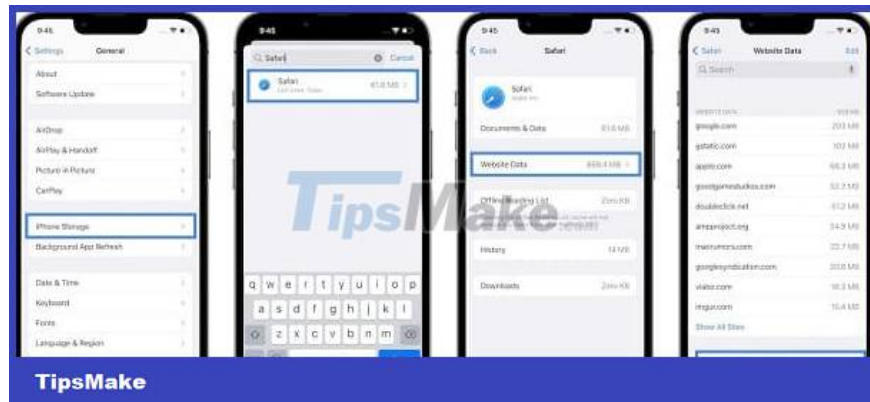
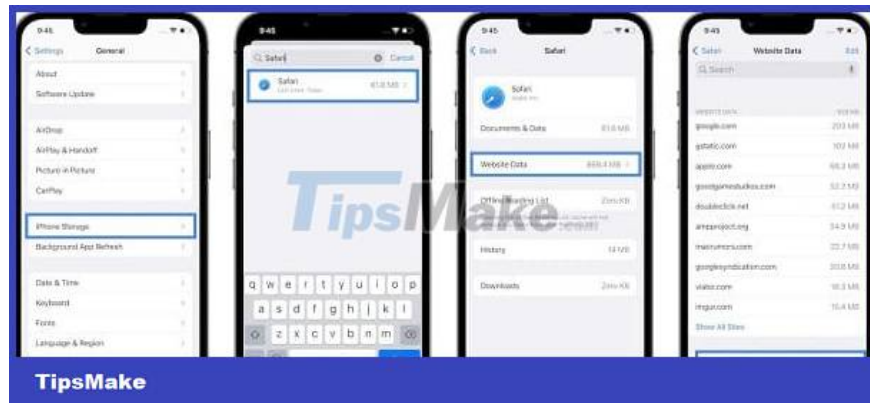
You can then use this new password to turn off screen time. Or if you want to remove the password completely. Then go back to Change Screen Time Passcode and turn off the screen time passcode (Turn Off Screen Time Passcode). After turning off this feature, if you want to continue using it, turn it on again and check to see if the problem is gone or not!

Restart your iPhone

One of the simple but very effective tricks that you cannot ignore is: turn off and restart your computer. This trick will help users eliminate minor problems on their phones. Therefore, it depends on the iPhone model you are using. Try powering it off and restarting it to fix the problem.

Clear Safari's cache

This is also an effective measure when usage time on iPhone does not work correctly, applied by many iFans. Go to Settings > General > iPhone Storage > Click Safari > Select Website Data > Select Remove All Website Data.



Update iOS for iPhone

If it's been too long since you updated your iPhone. The old operating system version does not work smoothly and has many problems. This may be the reason why your phone has unexplained problems. Therefore, users should check and update iOS to the latest version. The new version will fix existing errors in the old version. So, maybe the situation you are experiencing can also be fixed.
