

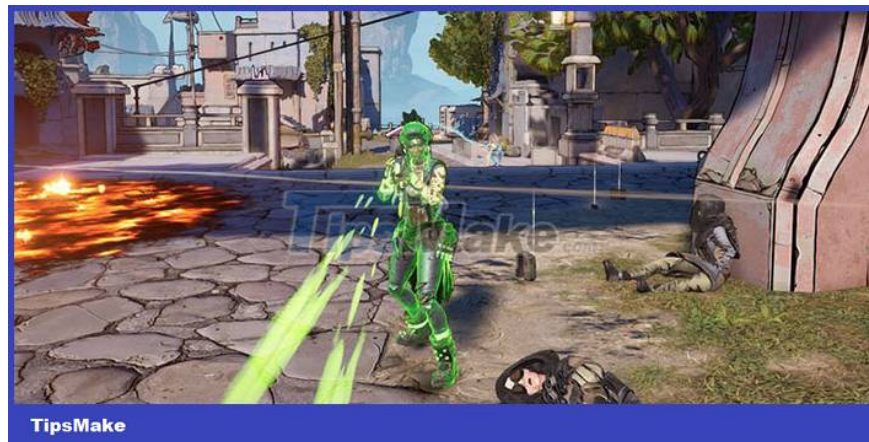
Tips to play Borderlands 3 gamers need to know

With Borderlands 3 being free on the Epic Games Store, the gaming community continues to boil over with this first-person shooter. Although it has been released for many years, Borderlands 3 has always owned a large and loyal fan base.

In this article, let's explore the essential Borderlands 3 gameplay tips for rookies and veterans alike.

Use elemental damage strategically

First and foremost, players need to pay more attention to elemental damage in Borderlands 3 than ever before. Since the Slag is gone, there is a rebalancing of elemental counts and corresponding element usage which, depending on the situation, should make a big difference in damage. Use **Corrosive** for **Armor** , **Shock** for **Shield** , **Fire** for **Red Health** .



While it doesn't include Cryo damage or the new elemental type Radiation, these two are more versatile and can be used in most situations without issue. Plus, on Mayhem modes and in True Vault Hunter, elemental damage becomes even more important.

Collaborate to scale and earn easily

The scaling in Borderlands 3 is truly something of a miracle. In Cooperation Mode, each player will see their enemies scaled down according to their level, regardless of the difference between players.



This means that level 5 and 50 players can team up with each other while still getting their own leveled drop weapons, enjoy fighting against moderately challenging enemies, and gain experience. relative experience. Basically, cooperation only brings benefits, not harm.

Ragdolling the enemy is actually quite useful

Many people didn't like ragdolling in Borderlands 3 at first, however, as the game went on and the enemies became more aggressive and tougher, it really became a kind of professional strategy to use methods that could be used. can defeat the enemy.



If enemies are in the air or on the ground, they will not attack the player. Plus, for particularly nasty enemies, there are plenty of ways to easily take them down.

Weapon makers are more important than ever

More than any other Borderlands title, the producer makes all the difference. In previous games, a lot of the weapons had minor changes, but for the most part, they were the same.



Although there are still small differences like reloading explosive bullets, splash damage, elemental damage, etc. But Borderlands 3 has integrated weapon manufacturers into the plot.

Players will actually spend most of their time going through the manufacturer's headquarters. Pay attention to the gun maker, that's more important in this game.
