

Tips to play Fate/Grand Order gamers need to know

It's a fun mobile strategy game with some interesting mechanics, a gripping story that slowly unravels as gamers level up their characters.

Tips for playing Fate/Grand Order

Do daily quests



The first priority whenever opening this game is to do the daily quests. These quests will give the player a steady stream of XP tokens to level up Servants and premium currency Mana Prisms.

Just completing the daily quests is enough to help the Servant level up fairly quickly and build up a stockpile of Mana Prism. Although it may be tedious, what it offers is definitely worth it.

Prioritize events



If you've completed the Daily Quest and there's an event coming up, make sure to take the time to do it and get as many rewards as possible. Don't worry about getting gems and shards, because the goal for the Event is to get the Servant bonus if you want to accumulate a stockpile of materials and other items.

These items are much harder to obtain outside of events and while they may not be needed at the moment, will certainly come in handy in the future.

Complete the story



Once the Daily Quest is complete and if there are no events going on, try to make some progress to the main story. In addition to gradually exploring the exciting world, players also receive many useful items to strengthen their Servants and unlock new features.

If you ignore the main story, people will lack the tools to effectively complete events and other content. Progress in the story as much as possible whenever there is free time.

Use Mana Prism



As they begin to gain more and more Mana Prism, players will gradually fall into using them to speed up progress by buying things like Experience and Status Up cards. However, the most ideal way to use them is to buy Summon Tickets.

Daily quests will give gamers enough Mana Prisms to buy one of these tickets every day. This is the best purchase a gamer can make on a daily basis to improve his team.

Combine the proportions of the Servants



Once stronger Servants are acquired, the player will begin to sacrifice weak Servants and focus on rare Servants. While it's clear that gamers should strive for rare Servants, make sure to keep a bunch of weaker Servants.

Rare Servants that are used in battle are expensive because they are expensive. But popular Servants don't cost much and one of them will be extremely useful when everyone is on a tight budget in the upcoming battle.
