

Tips to play Sky: Children of the Light gamers need to know

After playing any game for a while, people are bound to find out things you wish you knew sooner. Whatever it is, knowing about it sooner will probably improve everyone's gaming experience.

This is true of Sky: Children Of The Light (SCOTL). At first glance, it seems simple - save the Spirits and collect everything. However, the game is much more than beautiful graphics, so in this article, let's explore Sky: Children of the Light tips to overcome the obstacles in your journey with ease. than.

Tips for playing Sky: Children of the Light

Spirits are more important than in the beginning

At the start of the game, everyone will learn that their main goal is to free the trapped Spirits and bring them back into the light. Therefore, it is quite clear that they direct the game's story and help the player progress from mission to mission. However, at first SCOTL still did not specify the importance of Spirits.



Once the Spirits are released, they will wait for the character at the end of the Realm with offerings to say thank you for your help. They then reappear in the Social Area (the social area where the player arrives before traveling to the next Kingdom).

In this area, people can go up to the Spirits and interact with them. Here, they will perform their useful role: giving gifts to players and players can also buy goods from them. Everything from expression upgrades to items is purchasable.

Players will need to return to Realm

There are multiple puzzles and locked areas in each of the game's Kingdoms. To unlock some of these areas, people need to go to the next Kingdom and collect items or Spirits from there.

Then people will have to go back to the previous page because now the previously inaccessible areas are unlocked. This is very true of a locked area leading to the Spirit in the Daylight Prairie.

If you've spent a long time trying to solve a seemingly impossible puzzle, it's likely that people will need to skip it and come back to it later. Usually, it seems that the areas that are locked and need Spirits from another realm are the places that contain the things people are missing in that world.

The house and social areas are very useful



In the Social and Home Areas, players can do a lot of activities. At first glance, it looks like the Home area is where you can enter the Kingdom from the very beginning or continue playing your game from the last save point. However, it's much more than that, like customizing your character, leaving messages for other players, and even playing with friends.

The Social Area is the area between the Kingdoms if you choose to go from one place to another. This area is extremely useful for meeting other players and forming alliances with them. This is a great area to socialize with others. If there is no need to connect with other SCOTL players, people can customize their characters here without having to return to Home.

Use expressions when communicating

Teamwork is pretty important in the game, so being able to communicate with other players online is important. When unleashing Spirits in the game, some of them reward emotes.

Gamers can access the emotes by pressing X in the game and it will bring up a side menu that includes all the unlocked emotes. Click on one to equip your character with that emotion.



When in a Kingdom and asking for the cooperation of others, things can get tricky. Therefore, by using different expressions a player can make, it helps to clearly communicate his intentions.

Eg; If a puzzle has been solved and needs others to see it, the player can perform a finger gesture to let them know where it is.

Hit Realm at peak multiplayer time

There are times when the Kingdom in the game is eerily quiet. Being alone in the Kingdom means that players will need to do a lot of work until they have to stop. This gets really difficult after a while because people can get stuck on one part and have no way to work it out.

From observation, there seems to be a peak time for Sky: Children of the Light players. If you want to play a Realm when there are many players, you should do it on weekends, especially in the evenings. It seems like at any point after 6pm on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, there will be a lot more players than usual.
