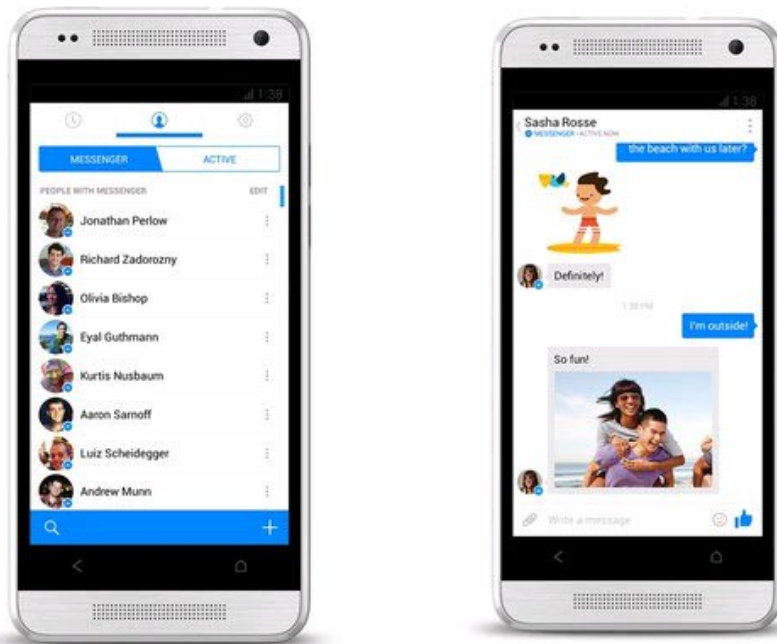


# To chat Facebook must use the standalone Messenger application
