

To play GTA 6, you must need at least RTX?

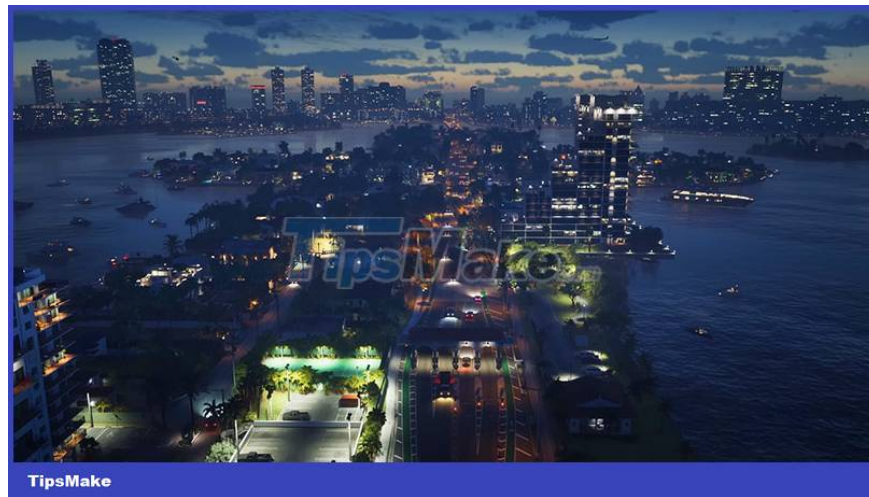
There have been many predictions about GTA 6 configuration on gaming sites, that after 10 years, GTA 6's configuration will require a lot for you to be able to play GTA 6 on PC.

You are looking for GTA 6 configuration requirements. After 10 years of waiting, Rockstar Games has released the official trailer of GTA VI. And there are many things that players are curious about this next game.

Through the trailer, you can see that GTA 6 is set in the current Vice City based on the city of Miami, Florida, USA. And this is also the first version where players can control female characters in the game.

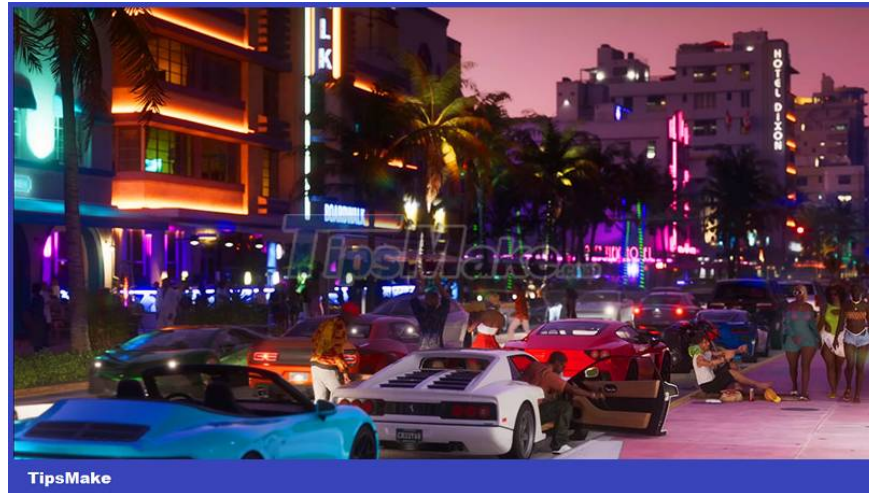
With the majestic image in the game trailer, many players also wonder what the configuration that GTA 6 requires will be. There have been many predictions about GTA 6 configuration on gaming sites, that after 10 years, GTA 6's configuration will require a lot for you to be able to play GTA 6 on PC. Although there is no exact information from Rockstar Games about the release of GTA 6 on PC, TipsMake.com.com still would like to give the predicted configuration of GTA 6 on PC below.

Minimum configuration of GTA VI on PC



1. **OS:** Windows 10/11 64-bit
2. **CPU:** Intel Core i5-10600K or AMD Ryzen 5 3600X
3. **Memory:** 16GB RAM
4. **Graphics card:** NVIDIA GeForce RTX 2080 or AMD Radeon RX 6800 XT (with 8GB VRAM)
5. **DirectX:** Version 12
6. **Free hard drive required:** 150GB SSD

Configuration requires GTA 6 on PC



1. **OS:** Windows 10/11 64-bit
2. **CPU:** Intel Core i7-8700K or AMD Ryzen 5 2600X
3. **Memory:** RAM 24GB
4. **Graphics card:** NVIDIA GeForce RTX 3060 TI or AMD Radeon RX 5700 XT (with 8GB VRAM)
5. **DirectX:** Version 12
6. **Free hard drive required:** 150GB SSD

Comparing with the configuration of GTA 5 on PC, you will immediately see that the configuration of GTA 5 has quite easy system requirements even though the game has been updated a lot. Although this configuration is higher than GTA 5, if compared with current AAA games, it is not too different. Moreover, the new game will officially launch in 2025. Between now and then, there will likely be many other AAA games that will have higher configuration requirements than GTA 6 on PC.

Publisher Update - December 5, 2023: GTA 6 is confirmed to be launching on Xbox Series X|S and PlayStation 5 platforms. Although Rockstar Games has not confirmed whether GTA 6 will be released on PC or not. But this is certainly a "fertile land" that Rockstar Games won't be able to ignore.



Although the system requirements of Grand Theft Auto 6 on PC when officially announced may be different from the predicted requirements above. But you should rest assured because GTA 6 will definitely require more hardware than GTA 5.

We can foresee that, with AAA games released from 2024 onwards, they are expected to "eat up" At least 12GB of RAM on your PC and maybe even more. Although these are just predictions based on comments from the long-time PC Gamer community. But from the past until now, predictions about the configuration of upcoming games will be close to the official configuration announced by the publisher or even the official configuration will require more than that.
