5. Dirt Rally



DiRT is a typical racing game about dusty properties with extremely difficult tracks on offroad terrain, not flat on the asphalt as the name Rally of the game. The game not only brings a sense of pure racing but also gives us a very adventurous feeling. Operation in the game gives us the feeling of being controlling a real car, you must be extremely proficient in gearing, reducing the throttle every time you make a cornering hug. The racing tracks of the game are really thorny and the maximum speed you need to use can only reach 80-90 km / h and not up to 200 km / h if you race the asphalt. The challenge has not ended in terrain but also in some other objective factors. DiRT Rally does not show players a mini radar map to track the track as usual, but has a navigation system that guides the player via the vehicle's built-in voice or on-screen guide icon.

6. Project Cars



Project CARS is a game directed by Slightly Mad Studios in the style of simulating you driving a real car. More specifically, the player not only controls his car with arrow keys, brakes and nitro but also has to look back, control the speed, gearbox of the car. The number of Project CARS racing tracks is very large with no less than 100 screens across the continent and many models from ancient to modern to choose from. In particular, the game does not force the player to unlock any model, but from the beginning you can easily own the latest Audi R8 or even a few F1 cars from the previous century. This will prevent players from having to plow hoes to own a car, but the value of the game lies in the simulation when driving a real car.

7. Asphalt 8



Asphalt 8 is a mobile racing game that has been around for a long time, but you can also play this game on Windows 10 by downloading it in the Microsoft Store. The game creates a real racing atmosphere when the player must be extremely focused in each screen if not want to be surpassed by other riders. The phase of flying cars into the air is still Asphalt's specialty, but with this 8th version, players can even control their cars to spin in the air to create unique acrobatics. With Asphalt 8 you can own expensive cars that you can not own in real life.

8. Shift 2



Shift 2 is the version that marks the new maturity of the Need For Speed ??series. No longer the street dusty style of illegal riders racing all day with the police and contention, but now the game becomes more professional to bring the feel of a true racer. The highlight of Shift 2 is that the player can choose to race from the first perspective. The frame you see will be the view from the helmet sitting on the left of the car and now the speed racing phase up to 200 km / h will certainly be much harder. The AI ??in Shift 2 is also not a medium, if you just made him deviate from the curve, he will probably try to retaliate at the next turn.

9. Gran Turismo



This is an online racing game that simulates an international racing tournament organized by FIA (Federation International Automobile). Gran Turismo best describes the details of a real-life racing car, so it can be said that this is a simulation game. The game has a lot of game modes for gamers to choose such as: Arcade Mode, Campaign Mode, Brand Central, Sport Mode, Livery Editor, Scape. More specifically, players can create their own ID on the system to store information about the achievements you have achieved through tournaments. The game also relies on this information to classify players, so that when using matchmaking, players will be paired with medium-sized opponents.

10. Assetto Corsa



This is a game that directly competes with Project Car, which is why these two games are compared to gamers. The competition in the racing game market share is increasingly fierce because the content in this game is almost no, merely speed. Just like its rivals, Assetto Corsa owns many models from new to old. Usually racing games allow players to crash and destroy obstacles on the road or collide with sidewalks without damage. But in AC the player will be subject to certain penalties for doing this, for example slowing the vehicle down for a while. This

is really terrible if you are in a fierce race with the opponent and what players usually do when encountering this situation is just pressing the restart button. The downside of this game is if you go ahead in the race, You will have to wait in the pit lane until all the remaining players have completed.
