

# Top 10 best smart sockets today

Smart plug makes it easier for users to control and manage electronic devices when plugged in, and can be controlled remotely via the phone.

Smart plugs are currently being used and used by many to make life easier. This device is a regular electrical outlet but has many other smart features to perform some automated tasks such as timer to turn off the device, control toggles, . On the current market there are 2 types of smart sockets are automatic socket or remote control socket. The following article will summarize to readers **some of the best smart sockets today** .

## Top smart socket midrange price

### 1. Smart WiFi Plug Mini Socket (TP-Link HS105)

Smart WiFi Plug Mini can be controlled via the Kasa app or voice control via virtual assistants such as Alexa (Amazon Echo), Google Assistant (Google Home) or Siri (Apple Home Kit). The outlet has an auto-off schedule and a Away Mode that automatically switches on and off over a period of time. Users can identify the status of the outlet via the LED display.



### 2. Smart socket HS100 TP-Link

This HS100 socket also has a voice control mode to control the devices that are connected to the smart socket. Or users control via Kasa application to control remotely via WiFi. The automatic toggle schedules are done by the power outlet at the time you set.

### **3. Xiaomi Smart Power Strip**

Xiaomi Mi Power Strip smart socket type has 6 sockets, supports WiFi connection for control via phone or tablet. The outlet also has a timer for turning off and on, which is set according to the date and time according to the user, counting the time to turn off, indicating the power consumption of the device that is charging. Below the toggle button is the fuse circuit that protects the current and automatically switches off when something goes wrong.



### **4. Xiaomi Mi Plug Mini socket**

This mini outlet has a WiFi connection to control anytime, anywhere, turning on or off the auto power plug. Users need to install the Mi Home app to connect to the power outlet and control the outlet via WiFi. On the Mi Home application, users will easily turn on the power remotely, check which phone or electronic device is on to turn off the power if they forget it.

### **5. Sonoff S22 WiFi power outlet**

Sonoff S22 is also capable of remote control via WiFi or 3G / 4G, especially capable of connecting with its temperature and humidity measurement sensor to set the on / off mode automatically according to temperature or degree. warm. When your phone installs the eWeLink app, you can easily control it remotely, send data via the cloud, making the adjustment of the on / off timer more economical. This outlet also manages power consumption of household electrical appliances such as water heater, water heater, .



## 6. Wyze Plug

The Wyze Plug works reliably, has an easy-to-use application, and can even track the use of whatever you plug into it, a feature commonly found on more expensive smart sockets.

You can schedule on and off based on time of day and day of the week, but can't schedule based on sunrise and sunset times like some other models. However, you can still program that option through integration with Amazon Alexa, Google Assistant or IFTTT (excluding Apple HomeKit). In addition, a set has 2 sockets, allowing you to control two lights, fans or whatever you want to make the house smarter.

## **7. Kasa Smart Wi-Fi Plug Mini (HS105)**

Kasa Smart Wi-Fi Plug Mini (HS105) is a great option. Like the Wyze Plug, it allows you to monitor device usage and is always reliable, whether you use the app or pair it with Amazon Alexa, Google Assistant, SmartThings or IFTTT (the device does not work with Apple HomeKit).

Unlike the Wyze Plug, the Kasa Smart Wi-Fi Plug Mini offers the ability to schedule according to sunrise / sunset times, but this device is a bit bigger and costs twice as much as the competition. .

## **8. Wemo Mini**

If you need to integrate your smart plug into your Apple HomeKit system, Wemo Mini is a must-have device. It supports all three major voice control platforms (Amazon Alexa, Google Assistant and Apple HomeKit) and typically cost only about half that of most HomeKit compatible sockets.

However, the Wemo application is not as user friendly as other applications. The Wemo Mini doesn't include power monitoring or equipment, and despite being 'Mini', it's still bigger than the Wyze Plug and Kasa HS105.

## **9. Kasa Smart Wi-Fi Outdoor Plug**

The Kasa Smart Wi-Fi Outdoor Plug (KP400) is designed for outdoor use, something a conventional smart socket does not. Kasa Smart Wi-Fi Outdoor Plug can operate in the temperature range of -4 to 122 degrees Fahrenheit, including 2 sockets that you can control independently by application or voice (via Amazon Alexa or Google Assistant ). The device is easy to install and use. However, the KP400 is more 'bulky' than the average size of smart plugs and does not include HomeKit support.

## **10. Kasa Smart Wi-Fi Power Strip (HS300)**

The Kasa Smart Wi-Fi Power Strip (HS300) is a bit more expensive than the average price for a smart outlet, but it has the ability to convert one wall plug into six independently controllable sockets, so that You can turn on and off different devices, as well as create separate schedules and activation.

Among the tested Smart Power Strip devices, Kasa (HS300) also has the most USB ports (3 ports) and has the longest power cord. The device supports power monitoring, voice control through Amazon Alexa and Google Assistant, as well as automation through IFTTT.
