In-ear headphones or earbud headsets provide flexibility, they are used with many items from relaxation to jogging, sports practice.

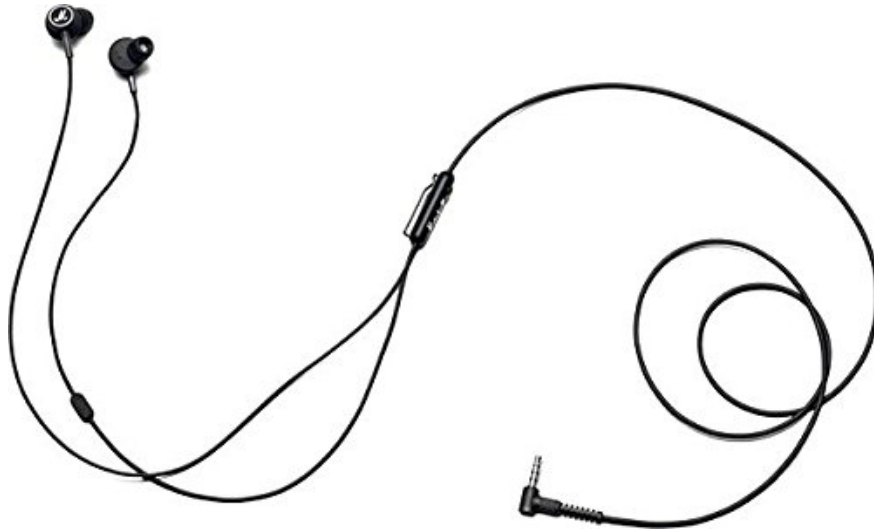
1. Top 6 best wireless earbud headsets

Panasonic ErgoFit in-ear headphones (USD 28.43)



Panasonic ErgoFit headphones have low price, providing comfort and stable sound quality. With this price, you will only enjoy the average sound quality and not uncomfortable for the ears but less durable.

Marshall Mode in-ear headphones (\$ 28.9)



Most users are not willing to spend more than \$ 50 to own an earbud headset. If you are looking for a headset with a rich audio frequency, you should choose Marshall Mode because not many headphones can beat its sound quality at this price.

Marshall Mode headphones provide wide frequency range and bass boost. It offers comfort in use, high durability and no distortion of sound.

Optoma NuForce HEM6 headphones (279 USD)



At this price, the Optoma NuForce HEM6 headset is considered a high-end luxury headset. The appeal of this headset is in the triple driver design, although you can choose one or two drivers to save money or HEM8 quadruple drivers to own superior features.

When buying this product, in addition to headphones you will get two detachable cables (one with microphone and one without microphone), an airtight box and water avoidance so you can easily carry it. , a headset cleaning tool, a super comfortable headset button set and adapter 3.5mm to 6.3mm.

Wired headphones on-ear

On-ear headphones are headphones with ear-tightness that do not completely cover them. Therefore, it tends to press your ear into the skull. On-ear headphones are a combination of in-ear headphones (flexibility but normal sound quality) and over-ear headphones (too heavy but the best sound quality).

Skullcandy Grind headset (USD 53.10)



This headset is cheap but hybrid brings good sound quality and receives many positive reviews in this price segment. The Skullcandy Grind headset also has a side button so you can pause and play music, convert songs and even receive incoming calls. The material of the ear cushions is not as expected but with such a price, Skullcandy Grind is not a bad choice.

Grado SR80e Prestige headset (99 USD)



Although Grado SR80e Prestige has been in production since 2014, it is still on the market today. It is sleek and compact (although the drawback is that there are braille on the earcups), which gives the user comfort and this is a very well produced product.

The sound is produced from SR80e very well from low notes to high notes even in the middle notes. It delivers excellent sound quality regardless of volume level. This is an open-backed headset, so you'll hear everything around you even while listening to music.

Beyerdynamic T51i headset (USD 218.72)



Beyerdynamic is known as a manufacturer of good products and Beyerdynamic T51i headphones are no exception. It may not be the best product it offers, but rarely do any on-ear headphones in the \$ 200 price segment provide this kind of sound quality, sound from bass to treble. .

In addition, it also comes with Apple remote control three buttons and microphone (for making calls and music controls), a nylon carrying case, 3.5mm to 6.3mm adapter and adapter for devices Right of Apple.

Wired headphones over-ear

Over-ear headphones often provide the best sound quality not only because the ear-tight round earplugs have good noise immunity but also because these ears are closed-back. If you are afraid that these headphones make you uncomfortable and dampen your ears when listening, you can choose open-back but its noise resistance is not as good as the above.

The following headphones are not noise-proof headphones, if this is not your choice, you can move on to the next section.

Sennheiser HD 202 II Headset (57.5 USD)



Sennheiser HD 202 II headphones do not provide high performance but sound quality is acceptable for this price. Good sound especially when in low notes and ear pads are removable for cleaning and replacement. The headset cord is 10 feet long but it comes with an extendable device.

Audio-Technica ATH-M50X headset (146.02 USD)



Audio-Technica creates all kinds of excellent audio equipment and the Audio-Technica ATH-M50X headset is no exception. This is one of the best products they have ever released and is often used by experts, although this is a headset for ordinary users.

One of the best features of the ATH-M50X is its exceptional noise resistance. It is designed as a studio monitor so if you want great sound that is not affected by background noise and reasonable price, consider purchasing an Audio-Technica ATH-M50X headset.

Sony MDR-1A headset (298 USD)



If you want to buy better headphones than the ATH-M50X and are willing to pay twice as much, Sony MDR-1A is an option to consider. It provides great sound with maximum comfort.

Headphones with noise-resistant wires

Many people hear about noise resistance and immediately think that these headphones can block everything. However this is not true. When operating, they can block certain types of sounds such as background noise and ambient noise but you can still hear loud sounds, bus sounds, etc. It can also reduce the fidelity of sound when operating.

In addition, although there are many noise-canceling headphones at affordable prices, those types are not very good, so here we only mention high-end lines.
