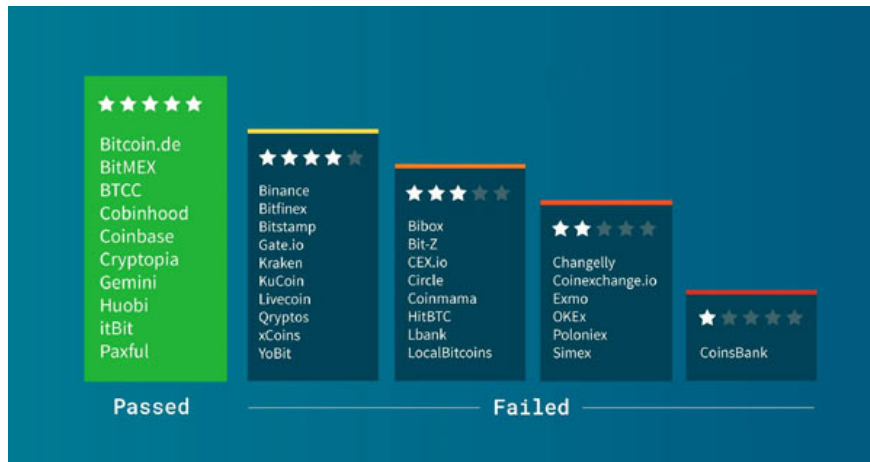
The Pentagon
