## 7. Tailors

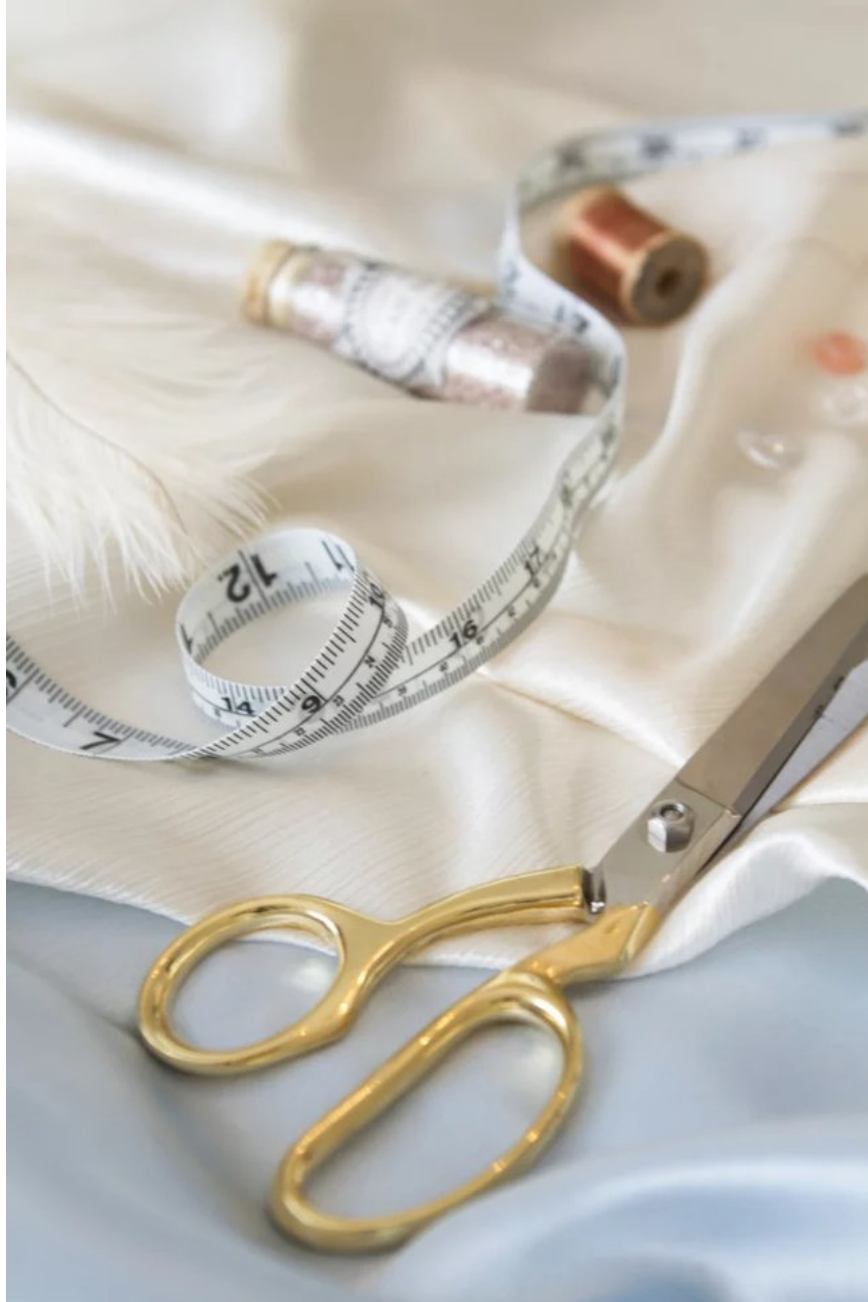
