

# Top 10 missing features from Google Plus

We have listed the top 10 things Google needs to fix or add to Google+. Check out the list and discuss with us what you feel it needs to be more interested in Google+.

*TipsMake.com* - **There is a lot of things about Google+ and it has the potential to make a big impact on the future of the Internet. After only 2 weeks in the Beta version, this social network had 10 million users. Even so, this number has not penetrated anywhere.** We have listed the top 10 things Google needs to fix or add to Google+. ## 1. Block someone from the Stream

In Google+, finding friends and people to 'follow' is a lot easier than any social network. With Circles, users can categorize people into groups, then easily switch between Streams in Circles. However, there is still a big Stream, it gathers everyone you have in the Circle and this is the default display you see in Google+. One missing feature here is the ability to block someone from this Main Stream (while still being able to view updates in their Circle). You can block posts from this Stream, but you can't block someone, at least up to this point. This is really necessary because you can stay connected to one person without being bothered by someone who has 'occupied' your entire Stream with posts and updates.



## 2. Display the list of items + 1 items from Google+

The +1 button allows you to give your consent to posts or updates to Google+. However, it also works as a list of favorites or bookmarks. Right now, there is no way to see a list of things that we have clicked +1. If I access My profile, I have a +1 tag, but that's a list of external items (from a website or Google's search results), where I used to click +1. Items from Google+ itself still need to be added to this list.

## 3. Resolve the share issue and re-share

One of the most difficult issues that Google needs to solve is the Share function. If you're familiar with Twitter, it's like Retweet (RT). However, when sharing a post on Google+, it will remove all comments and + 1, allowing you to add a separate comment to the download, then your followers can add + and comment of their own. they. This is nice, unless a group of friends follow and share and share the same post. With the goal Google shared, it will not be easy to get an answer, but it needs to do something to filter them out, at least for the things that have been shared 2 to 3 times in your stream. .

## 4. Categorize streams in real time

By default, the Big (and stream of the Stream) streams are categorized by relevance and popularity, based on the number of +1 has been voted and shared, so the most popular things are available. The top of the Stream. However, Google should let us choose to classify streams based on time stamps. From there we can see the share of people who have posted some interesting things even though they don't have many followers, like to post them.

## 5. Allow comment by thread

This is a very controversial issue, but we think Google should allow thread commenting so that people can comment and respond to comments, not just posting the original. This will make this flow much easier to follow when they have many comments. Besides, comments on comments by default can be broken and users can quickly click on a + to expand and view them.

## 6. Add more functions to mobile



It is quite impressive that Google already has an Android app for Google+ ready for users to download as soon as they release the 'Field Trial' of this service, and shortly after they show off an iPhone / iPad application for Apple. Even, Google+ Android application works very well. However, it is still not perfect and can make the mobile Google+ experience more like adding functionality - such as the ability to add +1, the ability to participate in a hangout, the ability to easily surf through the stream circle's big and stream, . Even so, Google should still add many main functions to the HTML application. It will be a great thing to be more involved and able to switch to Facebook - one of the great things not yet available on the mobile experience.

## 7. Expand this social network with Google Apps users

To be able to 'dig into' the Google+ beta, you need to have a Google address (or Google account). Currently it does not work with the domain of Google Apps, which is the business account where these companies currently

use the enterprise version of Gmail, Google Calendar, Google Docs, and other Google web applications. The giant has announced that Google+ pages for businesses will soon be released. Hopefully, Google+ for Google Apps users is not delayed too long. Because some people can use their own Google+ account for personal use (Gmail) and business use (Google Apps), Google should consider choosing to allow these users to access both accounts. This from different tags in Chrome browser.

## 8. Integrate sending private messages

One of the biggest things that Google+ lacks when compared to Facebook and Twittwe is the ability to keep personal messages to a certain contact. Certainly, there are certain ways that can make you do this, but Google needs to make this a part of its product. Integrating GoogleTalk (instant messaging) into Google+ doesn't hurt Google.

**Update:** Google has added a 'Send an email' button to the Google+ profile. So now users can email anyone with a Google+ profile, even if there are no friends in their circle. This is different from sending private messages, one of the pretty handy things.

## 9. Set up account confirmation

Because there are so many famous people involved in Google+ - and there are a lot of people willing to play celebrities - Google needs to set up something to confirm Twitter's same account as Verified Accounts. Try searching for 'Mark Zuckerberg' or 'Lady Gaga' on Google+ and count how many accounts you get. Besides, there are many evil scammers, such as the fake Jony Ive - the future successor of Steve Jobs at Apple. This account has also been deleted.

## 10. Display the list of interaction with each user

Another handy feature that Google should add is the ability to go to a user's profile page and see all the interactions that this person has made for you - their comments and +1 on their posts. you, as well as your comments and +1 on their posts. This will help show if you should add someone to your Circle and should give them a Circle.
