Battles consist of 5 turns and you will only have one chance to reload if you make a mistake. Smart positioning will have the Vek attack each other or burn themselves alive, while one mistake can have catastrophic consequences for your battle.

7. Bad North

Bad North is a Viking-themed roguelike that pits your people against waves of fierce raiders. You'll give your soldiers general orders before battle begins, but they'll react to enemy actions intuitively. This allows you to avoid micromanagement and focus on the bigger battle. Like Into the Breach, one wrong move can cost you and send you back to where you started, so plan carefully.

Bad North is also a visual masterpiece. Take some time to admire the scenery before starting the fight.
