System management and monitoring tool:

1. Mactracker: provides specific information for each Apple Macintosh computer, such as processor speed, storage memory, hard drive, graphics card, support for Mac OS versions and more other period.
2. Maintenance: helps users to maintain the entire system and delete junk files.
3. xMod: system custom tool.
4. iStat Menus: monitor and control the Mac from the menubar bar.
5. Mini Usage: shows detailed information about the system such as CPU usage, data transmission via network connection, battery's current status and process names.
6. SMARTReporter: notify the symptoms or errors of the hard drive before they happen.
7. Onyx: check the boot process of the drive and the file system structure.
8. atMonitor: system monitoring tool as well as active processes.
9. Omni Disk Sweeper: Hard drive analysis tool.
10. Secrets: hidden 'data' repository of Mac OS X settings.

System performance improvement tool:

11. Cleaner Preferences: program created to delete setup files.
12. Wallsaver: store and use any screen saver as wallpaper.
13. SizeWell: provides the ability to zoom in and out of working windows.
14. TrimTheFat: remove PPC structure from other applications.
15. Lock-UnMatic: open locked data files.
16. QuickBoot: Set up a simple system and quickly boot from another partition or drive.
17. Hide-unhide: display hidden files.
18. Flying Windows: working in single application mode.
19. What's Keeping Me ?: Remove all data in Trash or open the optical drive.
20. BumpTop: create 3D desktop.

Office application, word processing:

21. OpenOffice: a set of product tools for popular office applications.
22. NeoOffice: similar to OpenOffice.
23. IBM Lotus Symphony
24. Siag Office: free office application package for UNIX.
25. Beans: a convenient, simple and functional text processing tool.
26. Editra: arranged with the interface and features primarily for programming, support to more than 60 different languages.
27. TextWrangler: an indispensable text management tool for Unix and server systems.
28. Komodo Edit: an open-source word processing application that can work with different platforms.
29. Smultron: Similar to the above office software, the program is suitable for both beginners and advanced.
30. Aquamacs Emacs: simple and compact, can handle Text, HTML, LaTeX, C ++, Java, Python, Perl, Ruby, PHP .

Application to view and edit photos:

31. GIMP: image processing program that works with Windows, Linux and Mac OS.
32. Inkscape: vector image processing tool with features similar to Illustrator, CorelDraw, or Xara X.
33. LiveQuartz: a popular application that can handle filter-based graphics and interactive layers.
34. Phoenix Slide: a comprehensive program for creating slide shows or photo shows.
35. Image Trick: a free image processing tool using Mac OS X Core Image filter.
36. DrawBerry: If you don't want to use complicated programs like illustrator or Inkscape, think of DrawBerry.
37. Paintbrush: similar to Windows Paint application.
38. ialterImage: with ialterImage, you can drag, drop, rotate, rotate, align, convert format, rename . image file or 1 folder of photos is extremely simple.
39. Acorn: the application can improve image quality with just a few taps.

Additional software for iTunes:

40. iTunesShut: turn off your Mac system after finishing listening to music.
41. BravoTunes: 'put' iTunes into the menubar, when the mouse scrolls the information related to the current and next song will be displayed.
42. SizzlingKeys: control iTunes from anywhere.
43. Get Lyrical: Automatically join words into songs in iTunes
44. Tune.Instructor: display information related to the current song, easily rank and review without going to iTunes.
45. iTunes Menu: similar to Tune.Instructor, the application can display song name, artist, album in the right menu.
46. ??youcontrol: tunes: the program allows users to control iTunes from the menu simply and quickly.
47. iTunes Doodad: Instead of controlling iTunes via the usual interface, now you just need to do it via iTunes Doodad widget.
48. Bowtie: manipulating iTunes via a shortcut, posting your favorite songs to Last.fm, and changing the theme.
49. GimmeSomeTune: This application inherits some of the functions of iTunes such as finding and downloading lyrics, data related information to albums that users do not have to do any action.

Other functional tools:

50. EasyFind: this can be considered as an addition or replacement for Spotlight, with the ability to search data, folders or content in any file.
51. Quicksilver: lightweight program, simple interface, can work well with many applications, contact lists, music and some other data.

53. Isolator: when you're working on a document and don't want to be distracted, use Isolator. The program will cover the entire desktop as well as the icons on it.
54. Spark: Convenient shortcut management program.
55. FlyGesture: allows you to use the mouse pointer to handle single applications, or a series of different programs.
56. KeyRemap4MacBook: reset all shortcuts on Mac system.
57. MagicPrefs: a perfect set of tools and settings for magic mouse.
58. Self Control: helps users prevent connections to certain mail servers or websites for a fixed period of time.
59. Caffeine: 'protect' the Mac system from the Sleep feature, instead it will dim the display or turn on the screen saver feature.
60. Spirited Away: Check carefully every activity of each process, if you see any program that doesn't work for a while, Spirited Away will automatically hide the program.
61. Task Till Dawn: a free tool that can perform sequential tasks, repeated over a fixed period of time initiated by the user.
62. App QuitTimer: automatically turn off any application with a preset time set by the user.
63. iSofa: can 'turn' your iPhone / iPod Touch device into a remote control of the Mac system.
64. MacTimer: the timer management application for Mac.

System backup and synchronization tool:

65. Carbon copy cloner: makes it easy for users to create a comprehensive backup of the hard drive.
66. iBackup: this tool can backup all data, set up, customize on the system as well as the system application.
67. Sync! Sync! Sync !: with just the operation of combining any two folders together, you have their full backup.
68. Fruux: advanced system setup utility with many options, can combine Address Book, Calendar, Task and Bookmark between different Mac operating systems.
69. Filesync: 1 simple utility to update the process of copying data on the system.
70. Backuplist +: It can be said that this is one of the free, comprehensive and functional applications, suitable for beginners or experienced users.
71. WinClone: ??create a backup copy of the XP / Vista bootcamp partition.
72. SilverKeeper: helps users to automatically back up data to other mobile backup devices with a smart setup mechanism.
73. MozyHome: helps you back up data to an online storage server.
74. MaBuRe: later save all data of mail.app and Thunderbird.

Chat programs:

75. Adium: the popular IM client program for Mac OS.
76. Nimbuzz: another popular IM client, supports many different IM protocols.
77. Messenger for Mac: helps users access and use MSN in Mac.
78. Canary: Twitter client program with an eye-catching interface, easy to use with all necessary features.
79. ChatX: can be considered as a compilation of the necessary additional components for Apple's iChat application to become more attractive than ever.
80. Yoono Desktop: a comprehensive application that allows users to connect to all social networking services as well as other IM.

File compression tools:

81. Slices: with Slices, you can quickly combine or split data files.
82. TarPit: just drag and drop files or folders to TarPit's work window, you have created tar-compressed files.
83. The Unarchiver: with the ability to work with more compressed file formats than the Mac's default Archive application.
84. 7zX: program to create compressed files at a high rate.
85. YemuZip: extremely simple to use, you just need to drag, drop and name the compressed file to create.

Screen capture tool:

86. SimpleCap: extremely simple, compact, easy to use and full-featured screen capture utility.
87. Capture Me: besides the basic functions, Capture Me also integrates some other features such as: rotating the frame, resizing, converting format.
88. Skitch: In essence, a web application, with just a single operation, users can post and share the desired photos.
89. Jing: a popular and fully functional program that allows users to take screenshots, edit content and share via the Internet.
90. InstantShot: with the basic and necessary functions to capture a certain image, a part or a certain window.
91. SnapNDrag: just press a single button and drag and drop the resulting image file after it's done.

Application removal tool:

92. AppCleaner: easy and fast to help users remove unnecessary applications from the system.
93. AppTrap: when moving any program to the trash, the application will automatically ask if you want to remove the attached components.
94. DesInstaller: A simple tool capable of 'reading' information from code generated when a user installs pkg package with Apple's Installer program. All files installed by this data package are deleted, whether edited or stored in other forms.
95. Permanent Eraser (: enhances security by overwriting data up to 35 times, changing the original file name, cutting the maximum file size before Permanent Eraser completely removes the system.

Application to create notes:

96. SlidePad: the program makes notes simple and compact, extremely convenient.
97. Sidenotes: appears as a 'drawer' containing documents at the bottom of the screen (left or right).
98. JustNotes: simple, user-friendly interface, easy-to-use but still fully functional is what you can see at the JustNotes app.
99. QuickNotes: is a perfect combination of Sticky and Clipboard Manager, quickly record what you need to do, store, important scripts or anything you need.
100. MacNote3: Similar to Windows NotePad, the program is quite light, simple and works stably on Mac OS X platform.
