## 1. LG OLED65C9PLA TV (67.7 million VND)

**Defect:**

1. Not very bright
2. Ignore some details in the dark
3. Menu slightly confusing



The C series offers you the best picture technology of LG at the most suitable price. Although more affordable than some of LG's beautiful designs, it still looks outstanding with Invisible speakers. The vivid and realistic image of the TV does not disappoint viewers. This is really a TV worth considering.

## **2. Philips 50PUS6703 TV (more than 11 million VND)**

Although it is difficult to set up, in return you will be able to see color images that are quite bold but still subtle. This TV also performs well in processing skin tones. The user interface is not as good as the more expensive Android TV but at this price you can't complain.

Samsung has created the QLED, a TV technology that competes with OLED. This TV has solved previous complaints, improved viewing angles and improved image in the dark. Colors maintain a neutral balance. However, motion processing is not very good. If you ignore this, this is a TV worth buying.

The new Panasonic GZ950 does not catch up with the LG C9 and Samsung Q90 TVs in terms of dynamism and breakthrough, but it is affordable and sounds even better. It also boasts support for Dolby Vision and HDR10+. This TV gives viewers a balanced image, great natural colors. A better operating system and many applications will be better but the main components like Netflix and Amazon Video in 4K, HDR may be enough for some people.

## 5. LG OLED55C8PLA TV (over 29 million VND)

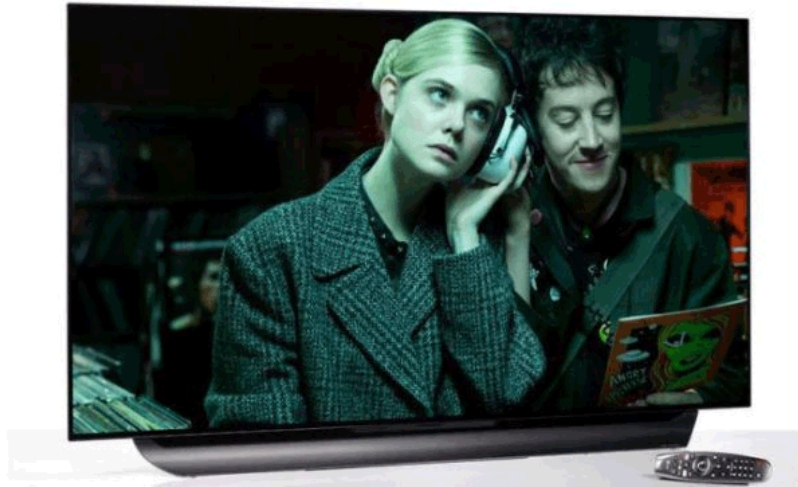

This TV has made a complete revolution compared to last year. But considering that LD leads the way when it comes to OLED, this is still one of the good TVs at an affordable price. It supports Dolby Vision, HDR10 and HLG. The colors are extremely rich and strong but slightly bright. However the picture looks natural, just like the real thing.

## **6. TV Panasonic TX-50GX800B (VND 22.3 million)**

The highlight of this TV is that it supports both Dolby Vision and HDR10 + for a very reasonable price. However, the viewing angle is not as wide and not as bright as some other TVs, but provides excellent images, clear details, balanced colors, smooth movement. This is really a great TV.

## 7. LG OLED55B8PLA TV (25.4 million VND)

This is Sony's flagship 2019 model only under the Master Series ZG9 8K LCD and AG9 OLED, and it aims to bring the Master Series' true method to more people. A set of backlighting directly brings highlights to this TV. The XG9505 has the same X1 Extreme processor with Sony's flagship 2019 but the price is much lower. If you can ignore the dim backlight and poor viewing angle, this is a worthwhile TV.

## 9. LG OLED65C8PLA TV (VND 41.8 million)

With this TV you will be able to see explosive images with clear colors and details. It also adjusts the audio balance to match your room settings.

So you won't be surprised to know it is a great device, from the easel-style stand that makes it look like a work of art to breathtaking image quality and exceptional level of detail.

## **11. Philips 43PUS6703 TV (9.3 million VND)**

### **Defect:**

1. May cause discomfort when used
2. Imperfect motion



Today a 43-inch TV is considered small, but the TV feels much larger thanks to Ambilight technology, a Philips feature, which shines colored lights from three sides of the screen to create a more realistic picture. It does not bring good HDR performance but at this price you can accept. The Philips 43PUS6703 also offers rich colors and details. If looking for HDR TV at a low price, Philips 43PUS6703 is the right choice.

## Notes when buying TV HDR

In order for you to understand more about HDR, we will go through some popular HDR forms.

The most common form is HDR10. This is an open standard used by many manufacturers, service providers (such as Amazon and Netflix), Blu-ray Disc Association (BDA). Basically all 4K TVs have HDR10. This means that your TV will be compatible with 4K Blu-ray discs, 4K players and 4K playback content. And it will provide much better images than 4K TVs without HDR.

Dolby Vision is another HDR format. It delivers more refined images because of its dynamic metadata adding HDR images on a frame-by-frame basis (while HDR10 adds HDR images on a scene-by-scene basis). Although in practice it depends on the level of technology performance of the film and the disc. TVs from LG, Panasonic, Sony and Philips all use Dolby Vision, although not all have. Netflix and Amazon Prime Video both support HDR10 and Dolby Vision.

HDR10 + is a HDR format based on dynamic metadata created by Samsung but other manufacturers also use this format. Not surprisingly, Samsung TVs use HDR10 + instead of Dolby Vision. New Philips and Panasonic TVs also support both formats. Amazon also has some HDR10 + content, although it does not flag, it is difficult to be sure that you are using this format. There are also a handful of 4K 4K Blu-ray discs encoded with HDR10 + like Bohemian Rhapsody.

HLG stands for Gamma Hybrid Log and is designed to play TV HDR. Most TV HDR support HLG, but the current content is very few and will develop in the coming years.

Finally, Advanced HDR by Technicolor is the format created by LG and Technicolor video experts. Therefore, until now LG is the only TV manufacturer supporting this format.
