1. Hostinger

Advantage

Hostinger's premium plan costs only VND 44,900/month, but gets you 100GB of storage, unlimited bandwidth, free SSL, support for 100 sites, automatic backups, managed WordPress, suite 1GB email memory, virus

scanner, spam filter, Vietnamese language support, etc. SSL won't cost you extra after the first year: it's free for the life of your account.

Hostinger's WordPress support is the main highlight. If you just want to run a small blog, the basic account supports one website, 30GB of storage, 100GB of monthly bandwidth and free SSL, with prices starting at just VND24,999/month for a 4-year account.

The other three WordPress plans add even more features, but even a business-friendly WordPress Pro account (300 sites support, 200GB storage, unlimited bandwidth, daily backups, Cloudflare CDN, etc.) still only costs 279,000 VND/month in the 4-year package.

Hostinger does not offer dedicated hosting packages, which is perhaps a problem for business users who need the fastest possible speed. But Hostinger's cloud hosting plans give you dedicated system resources, which can deliver up to 4x the amazing speed. Additionally, SSH access, CDN, and daily backups are only available as add-ons in more expensive plans.

However, Hostinger's wide range of VPS plans can rival powerful dedicated servers, with the premium plan offering 8 cores, 16GB RAM with enterprise-grade 12TB monthly bandwidth. Testing has proven this web host to be the top quality provider available today.

2. Bluehost

Advantage

Bluehost is a top quality choice when it comes to web hosting providers because of its rich feature packs, easy setup, reliable network, and great live chat support to help keep you going. keep your website running smoothly.

Bluehost's WordPress beginner plans are priced the same, but with important feature tweaks. WordPress comes pre-installed, so you can get started right away.

If you're looking for something a little simpler, Bluehost's Website Builder (starts at \$2.95/month, billed annually) lets you build websites that look a bit better than dragging and drop. It's super easy to use yet so powerful that the top plans (\$24.95/month, billed annually) can even build full-featured web stores.

Bluehost also has a lot for professionals to like, from value VPS and configurable dedicated hosting, to hosted WooCommerce packages, business-friendly Google Workspace, domain registration and even migration support to easily transfer an existing website to your Bluehost account.

3. HostGator

With over 20 years in business, HostGator has grown into a leading web hosting provider with products for all levels of users.

Similar to both Bluehost and Hostinger, cheap is the highlight of HostGator, with the cheapest Hatching plan offering unlimited bandwidth and disk space, free domain for 1 year, free SSL for the duration of the plan, one-click WordPress installation, and a website builder included. There's a generous 45-day money-back guarantee, and HostGator will even transfer a simple site from your existing site to the new space for free.

HostGator's WordPress plans are a bit more expensive, starting at \$5.95/month for 3 years (\$9.95 on renewal), but add essential features like backups and malware protection.

More demanding users can choose from 3 VPS and 3 dedicated hosting plans, and if you're ambitious, you can even start your own business through HostGator's resale plans.

4. GoDaddy

US-based GoDaddy is a huge web hosting company with a huge range of products. Dedicated, shared and VPS hosting available, WordPress support covering everything from simple personal blogs to fully featured WooCommerce-enabled web stores; an easy to use website builder, Microsoft 365 email and hosting, digital marketing tools, domain registration, payment processing, point of sale system, etc.

GoDaddy also provides high quality service that fits into the pocket of its users. The web dashboard is beautifully designed and easy to use; The installer automatically sets up WordPress and over 150 other top web apps in just one or two clicks. The industry-standard cPanel has every tool you'll need to manage your web space.

5. GreenGeeks

The famous products of GreenGeeks are powerful shared hosting packages. Even the cheapest offers unlimited bandwidth, a free domain for 1 year, nightly backups, 50 email accounts, multi-user access, and free SSL for the life of your account. . Prices start as low as \$2.95/month for a three-year plan.

GreenGeeks VPS and dedicated hosting plans are available for high-traffic websites. These plans look a bit more expensive than most other providers, but that's largely because the provider doesn't have any incentives.

6. InMotion Hosting

This starts with shared hosting, website builder and WordPress products. There's free SSL, and prices start at just \$2.49/month for a 3-year service (\$8.99 on renewal).

But InMotion offers much more, from configurable VPS plans, to powerful dedicated servers and enterprise-class hosted private cloud solutions.

InMotion's reseller hosting service will appeal to anyone who wants to be a web hosting provider. 80GB of SSD storage and 800GB of bandwidth can be yours for as little as \$15.39/month on a 2-year plan, split among up to 25 people. Everyone gets cPanel to help manage their web space, and the included WHMCS manages all the accounts and payments for you.

InMotion is always working hard to help keep your website running smoothly. There's 24/7 phone, email and live chat support, a support website, and even a community forum to chat with others. Plus, most plans come with a market-leading 90-day money-back guarantee.

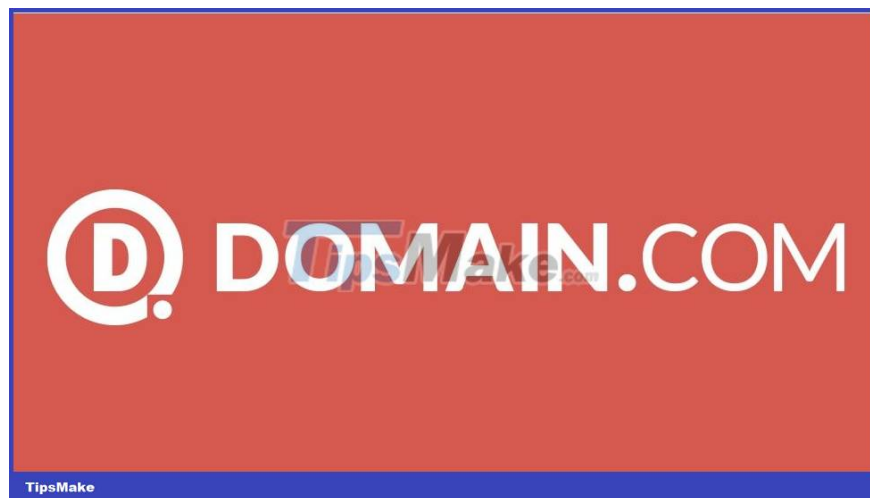
7. Domain.com

Advantage

1. Free SSL
2. Good value shared hosting packages

Defect

1. No VPS or dedicated hosting
2. No cPanel
3. No monthly payments for most plans



Domain.com is best known as a domain registrar, but it also offers surprisingly powerful shared hosting.

Domain.com's easy-to-use website builder is ideal for those new to web design. Drag and drop pre-made sections and page layouts to build your website, and add blogs, contact forms, social sharing tools, and more. Every site comes with a free SSL charges for the life of the account. Prices start at \$1.99/month (\$4.99 on renewal) for a simple 6-page website, while the eCommerce plan supports unlimited pages and builds several professional web stores for just for \$12.99 (\$14.99 on renewal).

Shared hosting is reasonably priced, starting at \$3.75/month billed annually (no monthly option), \$4.99 on renewal, for one site, with free SSL and zero storage limit. Your web space is managed through a very limited control panel, but it covers the basics, getting you up and running pretty quickly.

8. Liquid Web

Advantage

Liquid Web is an expert at providing premium managed hosting solutions for everything from email to WordPress, WooCommerce, VPS, dedicated and other types of cloud products.

Liquid Web doesn't focus on cutting features to lower prices. Instead, Liquid Web creates products quickly and top-quality, then only charges you for what you find valuable. Liquid Web's base price is higher than most of its competitors, but it's commensurate with the quality of service.

9. Namecheap

Advantage

Namecheap was founded in 2000 as a domain registrar, but over the years Namecheap has grown to offer a wide range of other products and services. In addition to basic shared hosting: Namecheap also has WordPress, VPS, dedicated and reseller accounts, business email hosting, spam filtering, premium DNS, cloud hosting, CDN, even VPN . You can find all the web related products you need on the Namecheap website.

Plans are generally good value, with low starting prices and some unexpected features. Shared hosting starts at \$2.18/month, billed annually (\$4.48 on renewal). The advantage is that SSL is only free for the first year. But pluses include free site migration, CDN, domain for a year with privacy, twice weekly backups and support for hosting up to 3 websites.

Namecheap VPS and dedicated products are not completely competitive. Prices are considered reasonable and there are many configuration options, but they do not meet all needs (such as no Windows hosting service).

10. Hostwinds

Advantage

Hostwinds is a quality web hosting provider with some very well-configured products that work for home and demanding business users.

For example, shared hosting starts at just \$3.74/month for a 3-year plan (renew for \$4.99), but the feature set is very rich, including free SSL, free dedicated IP, Website builder and easy WordPress installer. And optional extras include Hostwinds Monitoring, where the company monitors your site and automatically signs up for support if it goes down.

When it comes to keeping websites secure, Hostwinds plans come with free SSL, which is used to verify a website's identity, as well as encrypt information sent to and from the site.

Hostwinds really excels with its range of dedicated servers. Prices start at \$122/month for a single CPU, 4 cores, 8GB RAM, 1TB HDD system with 10TB of output. That's enough for many tasks, but Hostwinds offers much more. You can choose from 13 base servers, then add up to 10 SSD or HDD storage devices, use RAM from 8 to 32GB, choose your favorite Linux distribution (or Windows server) and set the permission level arbitrary bandwidth from 10TB to unlimited.

Add one or two optional extras (backups are \$1/month plus hosting, Hostwinds Monitoring is \$2/month) and you have a capable system ready for even the most important tasks. most important of the business.

11. Dreamhost

Advantage

1. Email is hosted with 25GB inbox, smart anti-spam feature
2. WordPress packages for every need and budget
3. Generous 97-day money-back period for shared hosting, pay by card

Defect

1. No refunds for some plans and payment methods
2. No phone support



Some web hosts target the consumer market, others are business-oriented, but DreamHost is a little more ambitious: Plans are designed to appeal to everyone.

For example, WordPress hosting starts at just \$2.59/month on a 3-year plan (\$5.99 on renewal), but still includes free SSL and unlimited traffic. But if you need more, there is a smooth upgrade path through the WordPress Unlimited plan (unlimited websites and emails for \$3.95/month), a managed WordPress plan for increased speed and reliability. , even a WordPress VPS plan for maximum performance.

DreamHost also offers email hosting capabilities. DreamHost's email plan goes beyond the basics with a spacious 25GB inbox. It is supported by IMAP, so you can see the same messages coming and going from all your devices. Built-in spam filtering blocks spam, malware, and Phishing attacks - all for as little as \$1.99/month if you pay monthly or \$1.67/month if you pay for one year in advance.

12. WP Engine

Advantage

Defect

1. Beginners will take some time to get used to
2. WordPress hosting is a bit expensive
3. Premium features can be overwhelming for newbies



WP Engine plans are built for WordPress with easy setup and migration, reliable and automatic WordPress updates, extra security features, professional performance optimization, and unique features. valuable troubleshooting, etc.

Staging is another benefit of WP Engine. When changing themes, adding site features, or just making a few updates, the Staging area allows these to be safely tested on the site copy, before going live. Other advantages include more secure WordPress updates, while built-in performance tests will test your site and offer helpful speeding tips.

The WP Engine interface is well laid out, but it's filled with tools and options, which can be daunting for inexperienced users.

Pricing is also well above average, with even the most basic WP Engine plan costing \$25/month, billed annually, about 3 times the cost of the competition. But if you are looking for an optimized environment, with quality tools and great support, this can be a "great value for money" option.
