## 1. Bose QuietControl 30 - The best anti-static wireless headset (USD 299)

Bose is one of the leading names in many years in the field of headphones, so it is not surprising to know that the company offers one of the best noise protection models.

Due to noise resistance, Bose QuietControl 30 headphones come with neckband (neckband). The headset also has a mobile application that allows to adjust the noise level to the environment. This feature is useful if you wear headphones in public places while paying attention to traffic and other dangers.



Battery life may last more than ten hours. However, it has a significant limitation as the microphone quality. Sounds are not as clear as other models of rival brands, so those who want to use headphones to chat on the phone will consider finding other options.

1. Poor microphone quality

**2. Jabra Elite Sport - Good quality headphones for the price (\$ 179.99)**



The Jabra Elite Sport headset is one of the most affordable quality headphones you can find on the market. Unlike Bose QuietControl 30, the Jabra Elite Sport headset is completely wireless, with no neck strap connected to the two headphones.

This is also one of the best wireless earbud headsets in sports headphones. It has a heart rate monitor, step count and when you run, you won't worry about a dropped headset.

**Advantages:**

1. Wireless completely
2. Much cheaper than other models of the same feature
3. Ability to monitor health

**Defect:**

1. The battery lasts only five hours
2. No microphone

**3. Sennheiser HD1 - The best wireless headset for making phone calls (188.19 USD)**



Many users buy headphones not only to listen to music, they also want to use it to make phone calls. If you are looking for the best headphones to make calls, you need to make sure to buy a pair of high quality microphones. Actually there is only one model you should consider that is Sennheiser HD1.

This headset is not cheap, you will have to pay about 200 USD, but it is equipped with an impressive microphone and a headset that can provide 15Hz - 22KHz and powerful bass. The design has a remote control feature below the left earpiece, which is used to adjust the volume, skip songs and answer phone calls. The battery of this model lasts about six hours.

**Advantages:**

1. Best microphone
2. Handy remote control

**Defect:**

1. The neck strap is not elastic, the cable behind the head may be loose after a period of use
2. There is no wired option

**4. SmartOmi Q5 - The best universal wireless headphones (\$ 32.99)**



The SmartOmi Q5 earbud headset is one of the cheapest wireless earbud headset models you can find, they are just under 40 USD. But don't let its "cheap" price fool you, with this money, you won't be able to find a better headset.

The headphones provide clear and crisp sound, although the bass may be better, but if you like to enjoy less bass music like folk and rock, then this is a reasonable choice.

**Advantages:**

1. Cheap
2. Sound quality above average

**Defect:**

1. Can fall while exercising
2. No microphone

## **5. Bose SoundSport Free - The best wireless headset for sports players (\$ 205.99)**



On this list, there was a wireless sports earbud headset, the Jabra Elite Sport, but if you want a more advanced model, consider Bose SoundSport Free headset. This headset is completely wireless, without a neck strap. It also brings the safest and safest in-ear fit, so you won't worry about falling out while listening.

And even if the headset is splashed and falls off while exercising, you'll find it quickly thanks to Bose's **Find My Headphones** feature. In addition, you can monitor your health with a heart rate monitor and it is also IPX4 waterproof, providing good quality sound.

**Advantages:**

1. Waterproof
2. In-ear is very safe
3. Attached to the application
4. Headset finder

**Defect:**

1. Lack of strong bass
2. More expensive than Jabra Elite Sport
3. Isolate poor noise

## **6. Linner NC50 - The best wireless headset for under \$ 100 (\$ 79.99)**



Linner NC50 earbud headset is a step forward of Smartomi Q5 popular line mentioned earlier. Although in each place, it cost from 80 to 90 USD. This kind of earbud headphones is generally as good as some of the more popular models. Of course its noise-proof quality is not as good as that of Bose products, but it is also quite good at noise in the most noisy environment.

Battery life is also more impressive than some other headphones we've reviewed, about 9 hours. Due to the ANC capability, the Linner NC50 headset uses the rear neck design, the ANC processor sits in a small box beneath

each ear. And because there's an ANC, it's not a complete wireless type. Finally, this earbud headset provides the best bass among the six models we mentioned here.

**Advantages:**

1. Water resistant IPX4
2. High quality bass sound
3. Great noise protection at this price
4. High battery life

**Defect:**

1. Treble sound needs improvement
2. Not really wireless

## **7. Jaybird X3 - The best overall wireless headset (USD 100)**



Jaybird X3 has made significant improvements compared to the X2 model. Although technically it is considered a sports headset (with a nano coating without water to remove moisture), they are comfortable to use for everyday purposes. The design has a pair of silicone earfins attached to the ear to keep them safe, not to fall while listening. Battery life is also surprising with about 8 hours of music playback.

The X3 has 6mm drivers for great sound, powerful bass. You can download Jaybird's MySound app for Android or iOS to adjust audio to your personal preferences. The wireless remote control makes it easy to navigate with 3 buttons and you can pair two X3 headphones into the same device. In short, the X3 offers the perfect combination of quality and comfort.

## **8. Bose SoundSport - Wireless headphones good for sports players (USD 149)**



For many athletes, music gives them energy to be able to complete difficult exercises. Good sound is important, but perhaps more important is the fit and fit of the headset. This sweat-resistant Bose SoundSport wireless headset comes in three different sizes, with StayHear + earplugs with a soft silicone earfin that feels comfortable to wear headphones but doesn't fall during motion. However, the disadvantage of this is that outside sounds can enter but for runners and cyclists, it is absolutely no problem because they need to be alert to their surroundings. Battery life is rated about six hours and can be paired with Bluetooth and NFC easily.

## **9. SENSO Bluetooth - Best wireless headset (USD 30)**



When buying headphones with a limited budget, you definitely have to sacrifice some features, but when it comes to good value headphones, everything you want will be packed with the best price possible. That's exactly what you get from SENSO headphones. This headset is designed to be solid and simple but still comfortable to use. With a frequency range of 20-22 kHz, this bluetooth headset can provide true Hi-Fi sound with treble sound and booming bass. Battery life up to 8 hours used to listen to music.

## **10. Apple AirPods - Best headphones for iPhone (156 USD)**



When Apple introduced their iPhone 7, the world was surprised at its thinness. That's because Apple has removed the headphone jack completely. Instead of Apple's iconic white earbud headset, the company has launched wireless AirPods.

AirPods are controlled by a specially designed Apple W1 chip and have excellent software integration. As soon as you remove them from the box for the first time, you will see a phone window asking you to synchronize with it. Siri plays a major role in managing your controls. This AirPods headset produces vivid sound and has an excellent dual mic with powerful noise suppression technology. The battery of this headset can last for about 5 hours and can be quickly charged in its case (15 minutes of charging you can use for 3 hours to listen to music).

## **11. Anker SoundBuds Slim +: Wireless headphones best price (30 USD)**



Anker SoundBuds headphones have a hook-shaped design that sits above the ear, ensuring greater safety and comfort. This headset has a variety of sizes and shapes suitable for most types of ears. SoundBuds Slim + is made of rubber material to prevent waterproof dots (IPX5) and weighs 5.6 ounces, they are so light that you feel like you're not wearing headphones. Inside this headset, Anker is 6mm drivers, making it a standard bass sound.

The actual battery life of SoundBuds only lasts about 7 hours. For those who are on the move or athlete, this is not a problem but if you are a music addict, you should review. Anker offers an 18-month warranty plus good customer support.

## **12. Beats BeatsX - Best designed wireless headphones (USD 149)**



Although this headset-style headset was developed by Beat, it was designed with the help of Apple's design and engineering team. The neck strap or 'Flex-Form cable' as called by Beats, is made of two wires made of titanium-nickel alloy, making it malleable, durable and lightweight. This earbud headset has internal and magnetized 8mm drivers, so you can stick them together when not in use and wear them like collars. Like Apple's AirPods, BeatsX has a low-power W1 chip that can be paired automatically with iOS devices. The battery life of this headset is about 8 hours and if you want fast charging (via Lightning cable), you can get 2 hours of use with only 5 minutes of charging thanks to Fast Fuel technology.

### **13. ISOtunes PRO Earplug - Wireless headphones for best hearing protection (USD 90)**



Unlike other headsets, ISOtunes headphones are designed as ear plugs. Whether you work as a contractor, carpenter, mason, etc. in a noisy environment, hearing protection is a top priority. The ISOtunes PRO Earplug headset has a 27dB noise cancellation feature, which significantly reduces loud and persistent sound. You can even answer the phone in such an environment.

The headset button is made of materials that match the earpiece shape and internal speakers using ISOtunes' patented SafeMax Technology, allowing users to listen to music at maximum volume without damaging the hearing. feeling. For those who do manual labor, ISOtunes Pro headphones feature sweat-proof, IPX4 waterproof. The headset is also compatible with Bluetooth-enabled devices and provides 10 hours of music playback or 240 hours in standby mode.

#### **14. Endive Activate BX Waterproof Bluetooth Earbuds - Wireless headset with best battery life (USD 50)**



On average, a good Bluetooth wireless headset has a life of about 8 hours. Endive's Activate BX headset is proud to offer 10 hours of continuous music playback (or 10 days in standby mode). This is one of the longest-lasting headphones on the market. The Activate BX earbud headset is created for athletes, so its design is durable and comfortable. The headphones come in three different sizes and are made of lightweight materials that have a light image that matches the user's ears. The buds feature anti-sweat, rainwater IPX5. In addition, it provides a powerful wireless connection with a range of about 33 feet.
