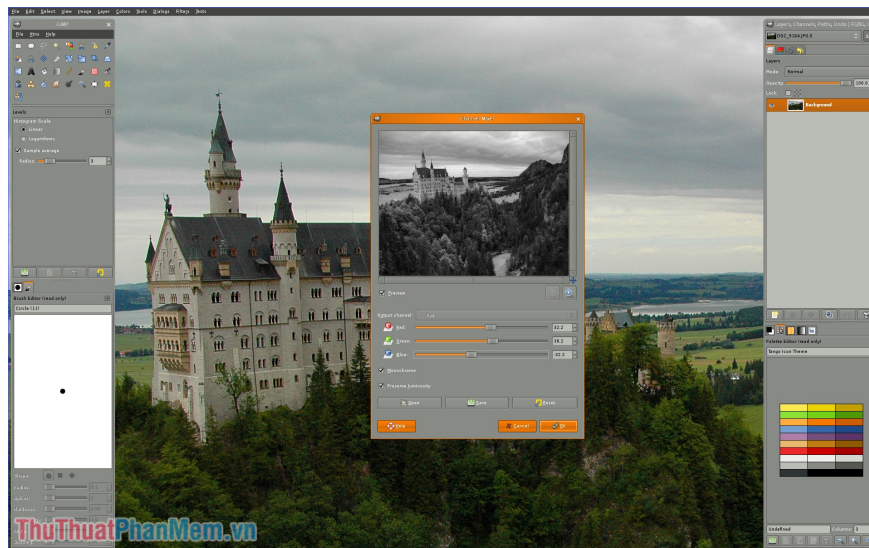

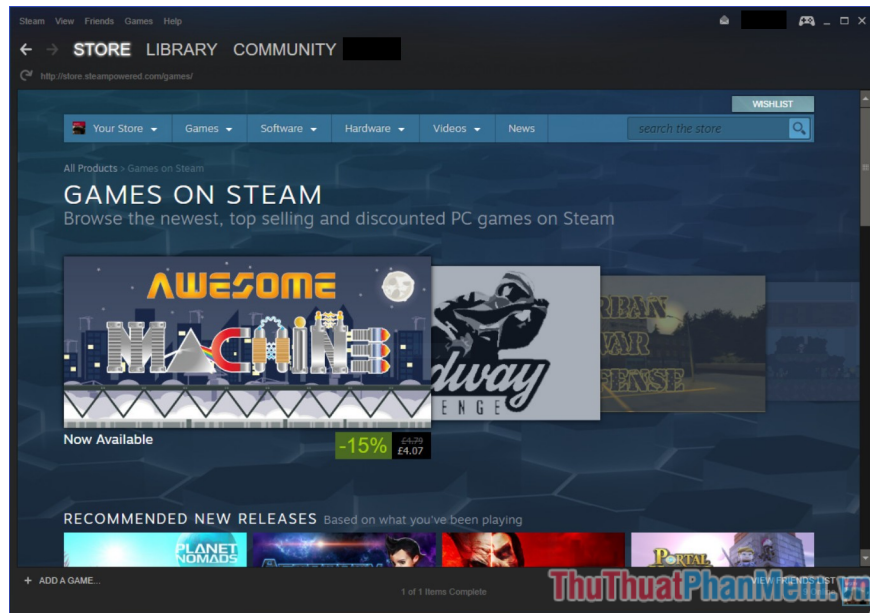
6. Stream audio: Spotify

11. Antivirus: Bitdefender Antivirus Free

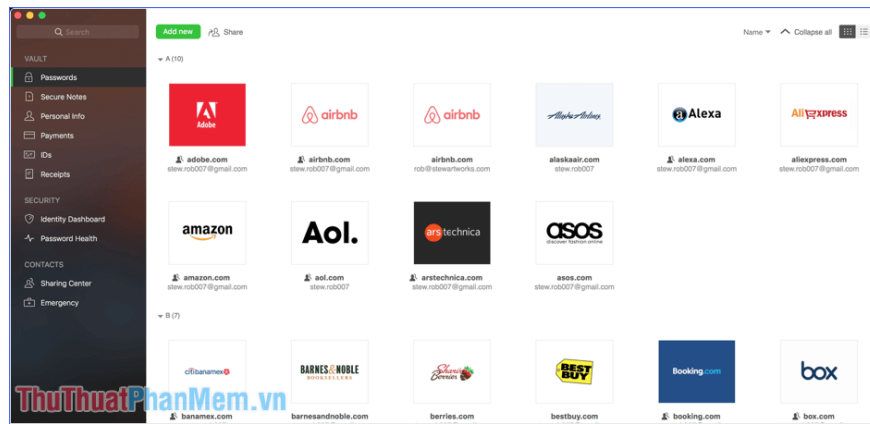

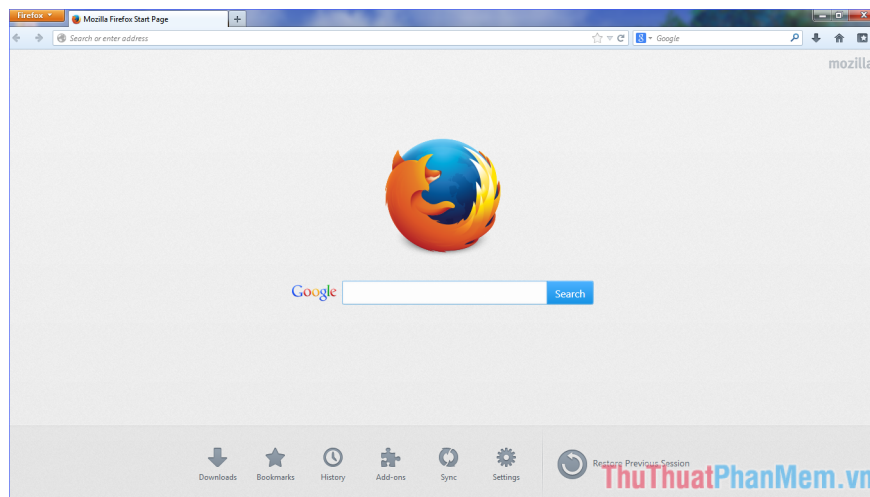

22. Burn the disc: CDBurnerXP

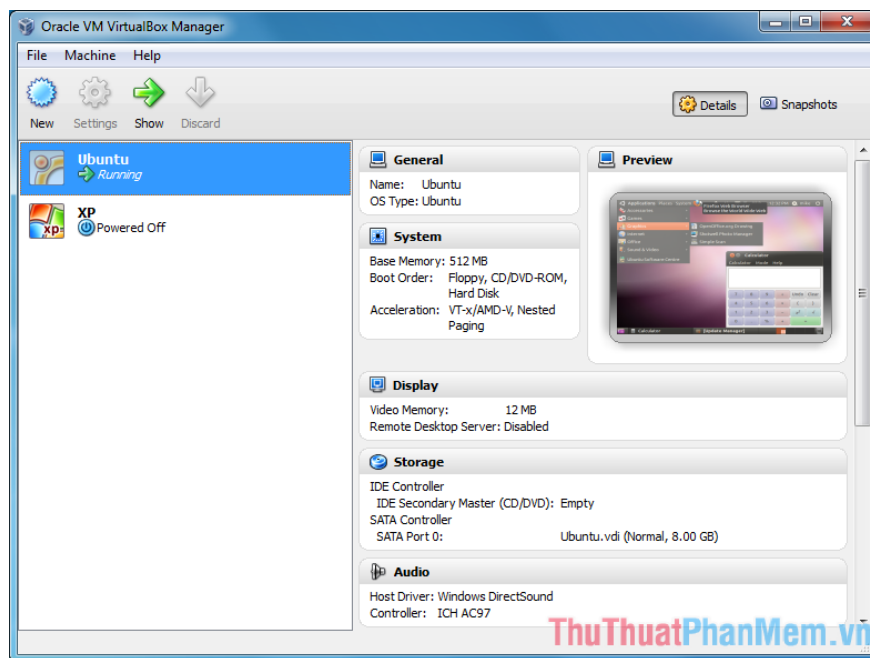

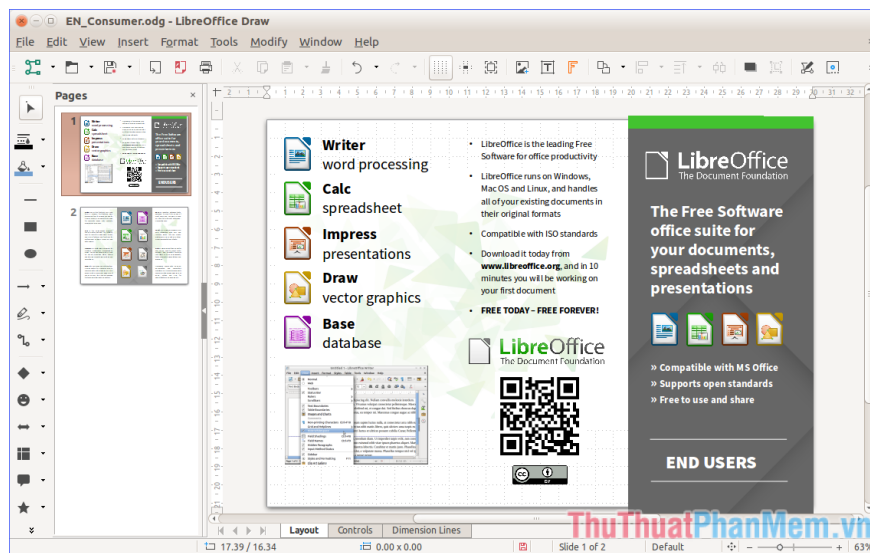
