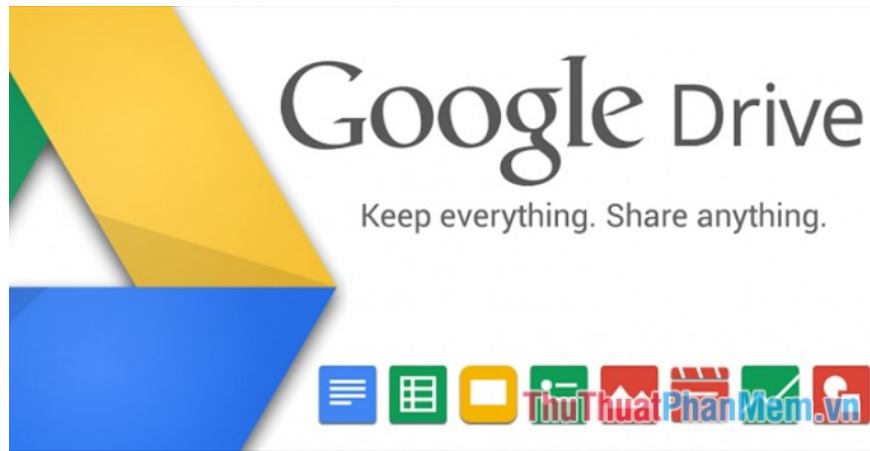
1. Dropbox

2. Google Driver

With a free account you will have 15Gb of storage which can be said to be a remarkable advantage of Google compared to other services. Using Google Drive is very simple as long as you have a Gmail account to use Google Drive. Download and Upload speed on Google Drive is very fast, supported on platforms: Mobile, Tablet, Laptop, PC, Window, Linux, Mac, Android. If 15Gb free is not enough, you can buy more storage with a quite pleasant price of 45,000 / month / 100Gb or 225,000 / month / 1Tb.

3. OneDriver



OneDrive is Microsoft's cloud storage service, previously when it launched it was called SkyDrive. With OneDrive you will have 5Gb of free storage, now OneDrive has been built into Windows 8.1 and 10. Basically with OneDrive you can not only access data in shared areas, but also can Access all data in a computer using the same OneDrive account. It provides a direct synchronization service between PC and PC that other services do not have. Synchronization occurs quickly with extremely low latency, making OneDrive an indispensable application for Windows users. To use OneDrive, you only need to register for a Microsoft account to have 5Gb available for free storage. If you want to buy more storage, you can buy packages like 50,000 / month / 50Gb or 1,299,000 / year / 1Tb.

4. Box



Box.com is a cloud storage service that seems to be familiar to people around the world, this is one of the leading Web sites in online storage services, so this site is very popular. many people around the world use, moreover to retain their users, they have also constantly launched and equipped with other useful features for Box.com. With the free account you will have available storage space with 10GB capacity, in addition you can buy an additional 100Gb of storage for \$ 5 a month. The Box service is supported by a number of mainstream applications such as Google Docs and Office 365. The Box Sync application is available from the download page for Mac and Windows, as well as an official service for Android.

5. Mega



Mega.nz is a famous US cloud storage service. Mega.nz will encrypt the file before uploading so it is highly secure. However, with Mega.nz you should use public file storage and sharing.

- Data capacity: Mega.nz provides 50 GB of free storage for users.
- Upload method: Upload quickly.
- Security: High security.

However, you should use Mega.nz with public data, you should not use this storage service for individuals because for files in long periods of inactivity they are deleted.
