1. Lenovo ThinkPad X1 Carbon (Gen 8)

Advantages

1. Slim and light design
2. Bright, vivid 1080p and 4K display options
3. Top-notch keyboard
4. Fast performance

Defect

1. Weak graphics



Lenovo hasn't made much of a change to its beloved business laptop, but the new ThinkPad X1 Carbon now introduces 10th Gen Intel CPUs. In addition to delivering fast performance, you also get battery life. long (on the 1080p model) and two stunning screen options, 1080p and 4K, all in an ultra-light (1.1kg) chassis.

The Lenovo ThinkPad X1 Carbon (Gen 8) retains the same advantages as its durable design (with MIL-STD-810G durability), the best keyboard in its class, and high aesthetics.

Except for a few minus points like the ThinkPad X1 Carbon ditching the SD card reader and top configurations that can be very expensive, you'd be hard pressed to find a better overall laptop.

2. Lenovo Yoga 9i

Advantages

1. Overall performance is quick
2. Colorful 14-inch, 1080p display
3. Battery life more than 11 hours
4. Great rotating speaker

Defect

1. There is no infrared camera



The Lenovo Yoga 9i is the successor to the stellar Yoga C940, taking a proven formula and refining it. Refined design improvements, long battery life (11 hours 15 minutes) and refreshed 11th-generation Intel processors make the Yoga 9i a worthy successor to one of the 2-in-1s. top of last year.

As you'd expect from a Yoga laptop, the Yoga 9i features a premium, ultraportable chassis and a unique hinge that can act as a rotating soundbar. As a 2-in-1 device, that hinge can rotate 360 degrees to turn the Yoga 9i into a tablet or be placed in tent mode so you can watch movies without a keyboard. When it comes to viewing content, the Yoga 9i's 1080p (4K available) display is sharp, vibrant, and bright.

The Yoga 9i scores points thanks to additional features, including a webcam cover, a slot for an improved Active Pen and a fingerprint sensor. Unfortunately, there is no IR camera.

3. Lenovo ThinkPad X13 (AMD)

Advantages

1. Performance is excellent
2. The chassis is durable
3. The best keyboard among the options
4. Many ports

Defect

1. Poor battery life
2. Thick bezel



The budget-friendly ThinkPad X13, equipped with an AMD chip, offers some of the best elements of the ThinkPad line up for a much lower price point.

Some of those features include a minimalistic, portable chassis with military-grade durability, an outstanding keyboard and many security features, including a fingerprint sensor and an infrared camera. And thanks to the AMD Ryzen CPU, the ThinkPad X13 has incredible performance at this price point. The only major downside is the slightly poor battery life, but around 8 hours isn't too bad.

The ThinkPad X1 Carbon is still the best Lenovo laptop if you can afford it, but the ThinkPad X13 is a great, cheaper alternative.

4. Lenovo ThinkPad X1 Yoga (Gen 5, 2020)

Advantages

1. Bright, vivid 1080p and 4K displays
2. Great performance (super-fast SSD)
3. World-class keyboard

Defect

1. Thick bezel
2. Weak graphics



The ThinkPad X1 Yoga is made of aluminum and magnesium is a great change. Not only has a slim design, but this convertible 2-in-1 also boasts a bright display, the best keyboard in its class, and long battery life.

You also get loads of extra features, like a built-in stylus slot and a webcam cover. The ThinkPad X1 Carbon is still a favorite for its ultra-light chassis, but you should definitely buy a Yoga instead if you want to use a stylus.

5. Lenovo ThinkPad X1 Extreme (Gen 3)

Advantages

1. Beautiful, lightweight chassis
2. Stunning 4K HDR anti-glare display
3. World-class keyboard

Defect

1. Poor battery life (on the 4K HDR model)
2. Expensive



Lenovo's high-end consumer business laptop, the ThinkPad X1 Extreme (Gen 2) has an astonishing 15.6-inch 4K HDR display and blazing-fast performance thanks to a 9th Gen Core i7 CPU and a fast SSD drive. The X1 Extreme offers more power than the X1 Carbon or the X1 Yoga thanks to its 6-core H-series processor. The Lenovo ThinkPad X1 Extreme (Gen 3) also has a large display and more ports, making it a good laptop for productivity. And yet, with a weight of 1.7kg, this machine is easy to move. Just be aware of the limited battery life on the 4K model.
