

Top 5 best wireless keyboards for Mac

Wireless Keyboard for Mac is designed and packed with wired keyboard 'analog' functions. Only this type of keyboard uses Bluetooth to connect with the device and is more flexible.

There are many types of wireless keyboards on the market, designed to work with both Macbook and PC. When faced with "so many" choices and you do not know which one to buy? So please refer to the article below.

1. Logitech MX Keys

The top spot on the top best wireless keyboards for Mac today belongs to the Logitech MX Keys. Basically, the Logitech wireless keyboard design looks quite compact, sturdy, and also has a built-in backlight.



Among the highlights of this wireless keyboard are the ability to pair with 3 devices, the key travel distance is short, quiet and low noise, supports USB-C charging and usage time up to 10 days for 1 full charge.

The only downside is that the Logitech MX Keys keyboard doesn't have a stand, this design may make some users feel uncomfortable when typing.

2. Kinesis Freestyle2 Blue

Although the design is not as "modern" as the MX Keys, in return the "split" keyboard Kinesis Freestyle2 Blue gives users a better typing experience.

Compared to Logitech's wireless keyboard, the key travel distance of Kinesis Freestyle2 Blue is longer, but it basically doesn't make much noise when typing. In addition, the wireless keyboard also has the ability to pair up to 3 devices at the same time, supports MicroUSB charging port, up to 6 months' duration for 1 full charge.



Unfortunately, Kinesis Freestyle2 Blue does not have a built-in keypad.

3. Keychron K2

Keychron K2 keyboard design looks quite compact, only 84 keys and includes 3 switches: red, blue and brown, each switch is designed to give users different typing experience.

Similar to some other wireless keyboards for Mac mentioned in the article, Keychron K2 is also equipped with RGB backlight, the ability to connect and work on 3 devices, support USB-C charging port, Bluetooth 5.1 .



The biggest limitation of this wireless keyboard set for Mac is its short battery life, up to 72 hours on a full charge.

4. Logitech K780

Logitech K780 is designed a bit "fancy" with round keys and especially is equipped with a stand, can be used as a phone holder or tablet.



Compared with other wireless keyboards, Logitech K780 has the "best" battery life, up to 2 years of use. This is also the biggest advantage of this wireless keyboard. Besides, the Logitech K780 also supports USB-C charging port.

5. Apple Magic Keyboard

No. 5 on this list belongs to Apple Magic Keyboard, Apple's wireless keyboard. Similar to Logitech MX Keys, Apple Magic Keyboard also has a built-in keypad.



Also some of the other highlights of this wireless keyboard for Mac include: support for Lightning charging port, more than a month of use, and use of scissor keys (on all switches) instead of keyboard butterfly wings before. This mechanism gives users a faster typing experience without making a lot of noise.
