1. FaceTime

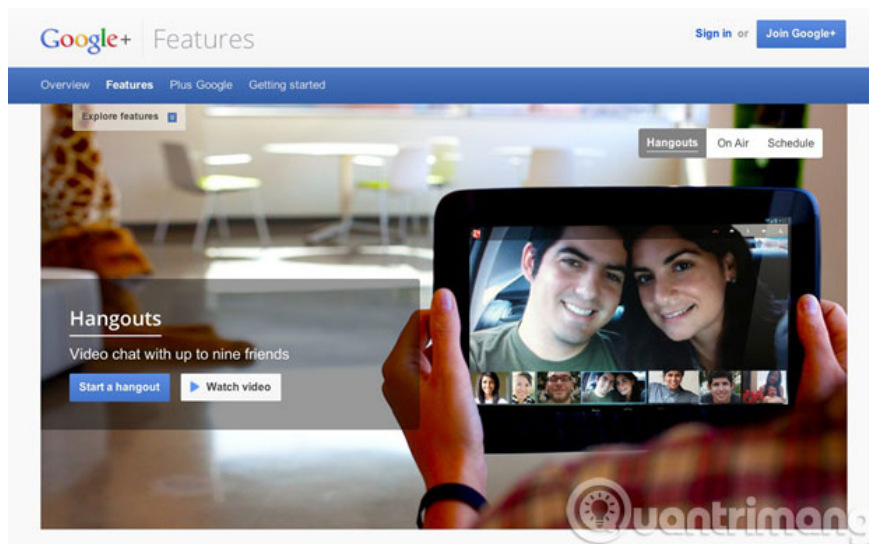

Although FaceTime has a big limitation that is only for Apple iOS devices, it is still the app to make the best free video call from this iOS device to another Apple iOS device.



On iPhone, FaceTime can be accessed right from the contacts application (Contacts) without having to go through a lot of lengthy selection operations like other similarly featured apps. In addition, the most important thing is that the quality of video calls is very good with smooth images. However, if you are looking for a complete messaging application in addition to the ability to make video calls, FaceTime is still lacking.

2. Google Hangouts

By default, the Hangouts app will be preinstalled on **Android devices** , but it will also be installed on **iOS devices** and this will be the best app for you to make video calls between the two platforms. Different mobile platforms without any limitations.
