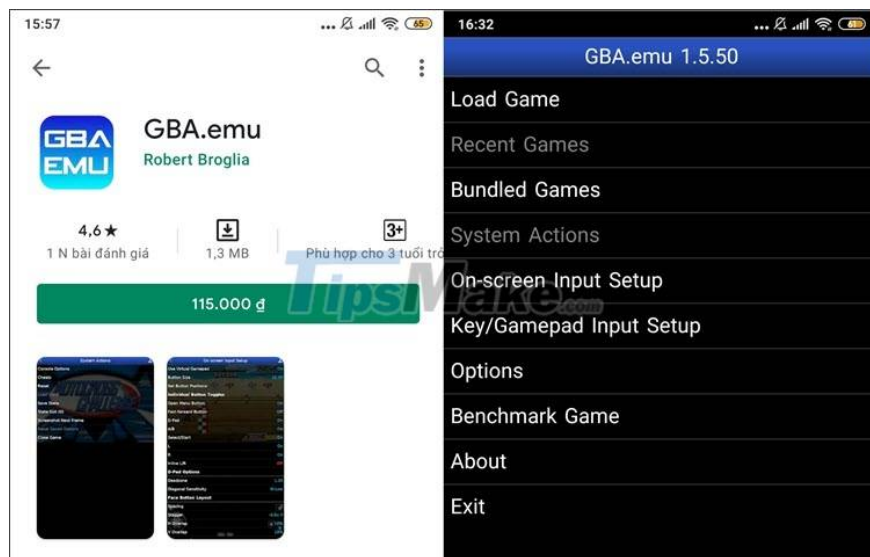


Top 5 Game Boy Advance (GBA) emulator apps on Android

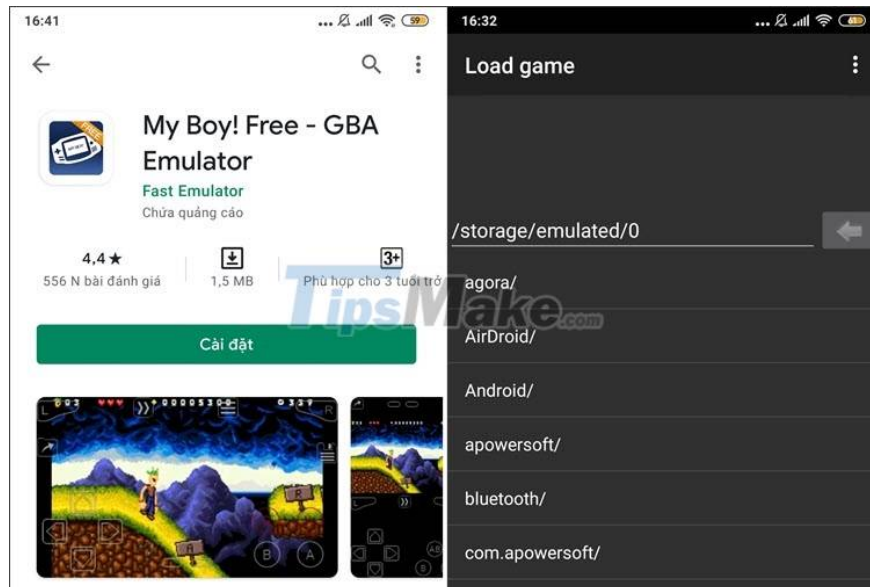
1. GBA.emu

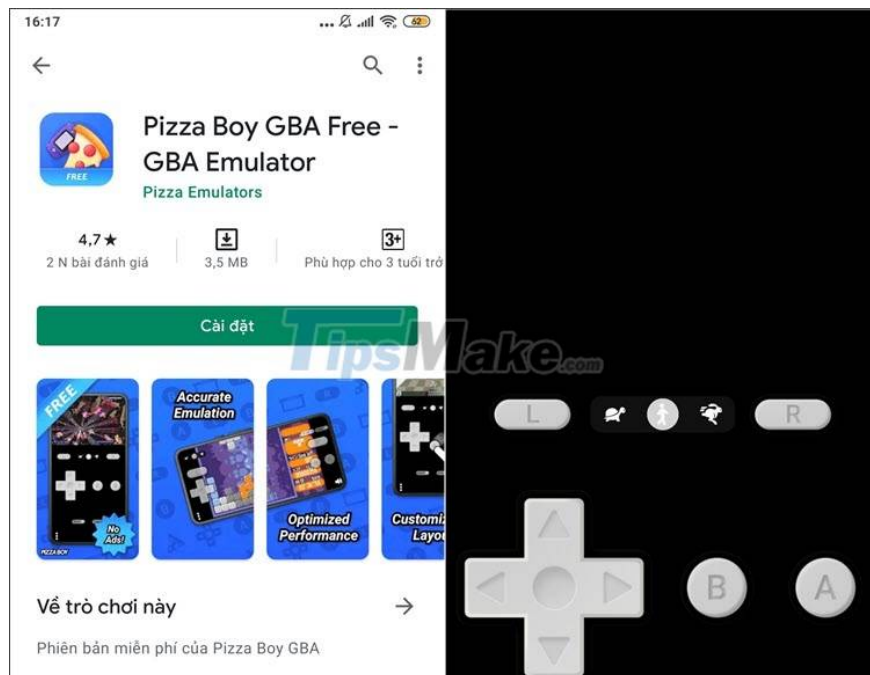
2. My Boy! Free - GBA Emulator

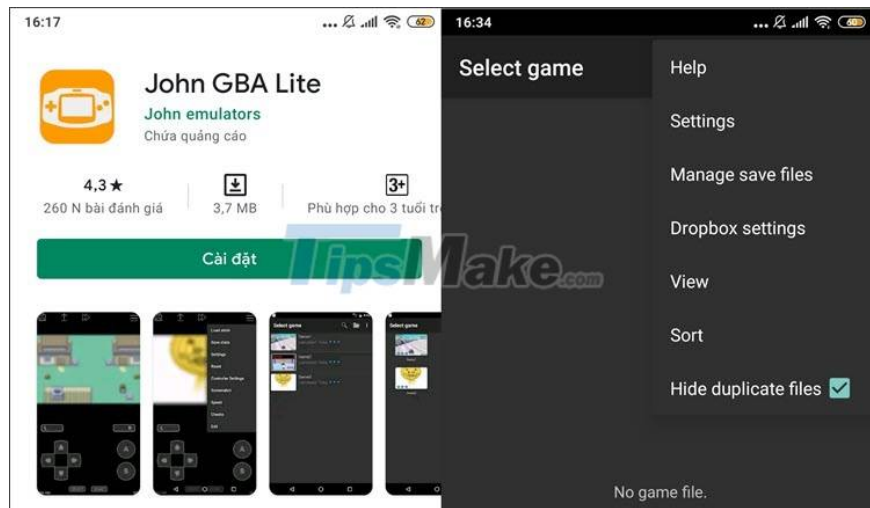
3. Pizza Boy GBA Free - GBA Emulator
