Meanwhile, the top three ODM manufacturers also experienced a **14% drop** in shipments, as brand partners began preparing for next-generation models, and inventory was too much from March.

Among those companies, HP, Acer and Lenovo witnessed a **decline in shipments** more than their *peers* in April, all with a **20%** drop .

This fact may result in a **15%** decline in total notebook shipments worldwide in the second quarter compared to the same period last year, but still **3%** higher than the first quarter.

For Lenovo's plan to acquire IBM's server business, even though the two companies still disagree on prices, Digitimes Research still believes that China's largest computer maker will continue to negotiate with IBM to find a voice. In general, both parties cannot find better partners for this deal now.
