

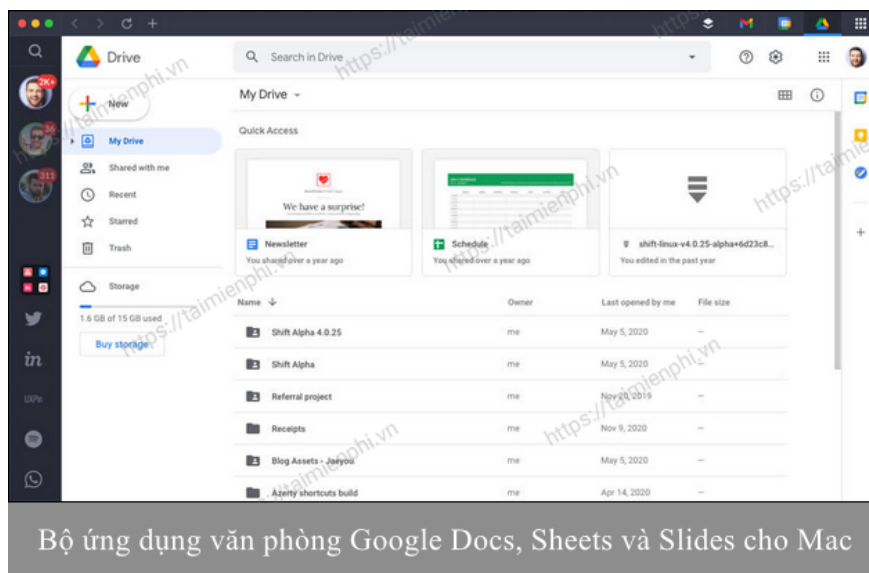
# Top 5 Office Alternatives on Mac

## *1. Top Office alternative software on Mac*

### *1. Google Workspace*



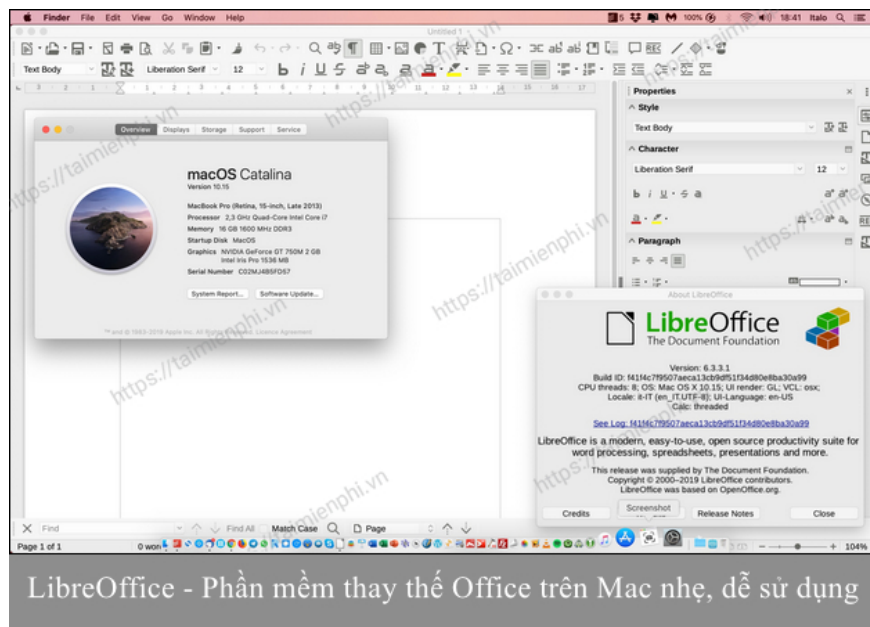
Need an alternative to Microsoft Office on Mac? Google Workspace is a top choice. It includes Gmail, Google Meet, Google Docs, Sheets, Slides, and Google Drive, making it easy to collaborate with your team without downloading anything. You can edit Microsoft Office files, integrate plugins, and collaborate in real time.

### *2. LibreOffice*



LibreOffice is a free alternative to Microsoft Office for Mac and Windows. Developed by The Document Foundation since 2010, the software supports over 110 languages and includes a word processor, spreadsheet, and slideshow maker.

Unlike Google apps, LibreOffice works offline with full functionality. Although it uses the ODF format, it supports many other formats, including Microsoft Office. It can also sync files from Google Drive or OneDrive for editing, but there is no online collaboration feature.

### 3. *iWork Suite*

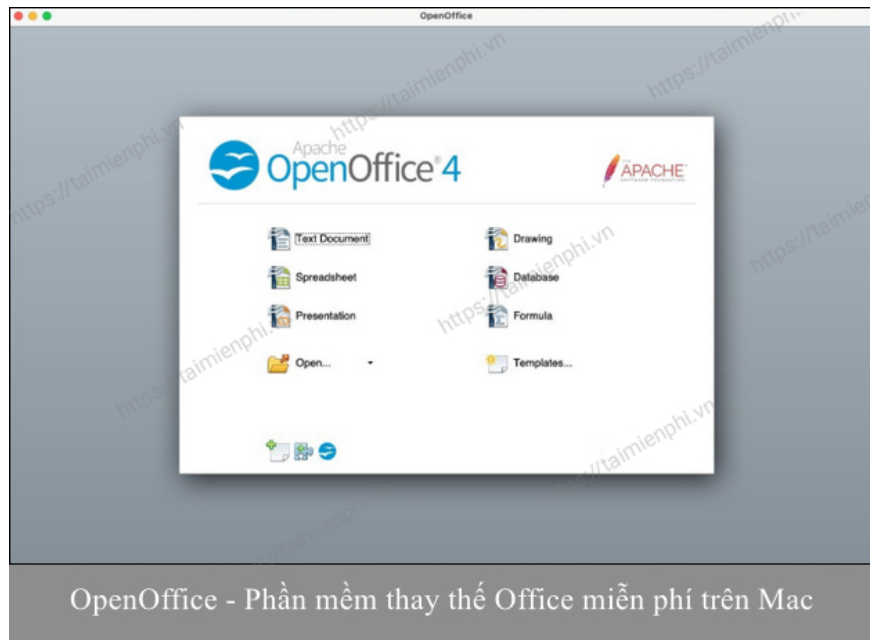


Macs come with the iWork suite of apps, including Pages, Numbers, and Keynote, which replace Word, Excel, and PowerPoint. Apple offers web versions that are compatible with Safari, Chrome, and iCloud integration.

Although it uses its own file formats, iWork allows you to import and export Microsoft Office files like .docx, .xlsx, and .pptx. However, if you're used to using Microsoft Office, the iWork interface will take some getting used to.

#### ***4. OpenOffice***

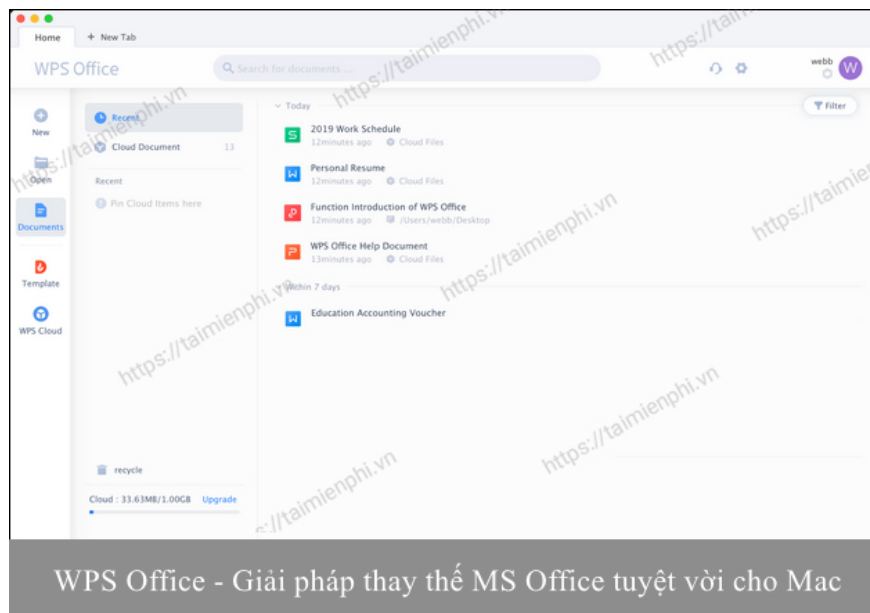


Apache OpenOffice has the most Microsoft Office-like interface. The suite consists of six tools: Writer, Calc, Impress, Draw, Base, and Math. Writer, Calc, and Impress correspond to Word, Excel, and PowerPoint, while the other three tools have their own functions.

Draw supports creating diagrams and 3D illustrations. Base allows creating and editing tables, forms, queries, and reports. Math is used to edit mathematical formulas. As a free, open source software, OpenOffice allows users to contribute bug fixes and improvements. An active support community helps troubleshoot problems while using it.

#### ***5. WPS Office***



WPS Office is a Microsoft Office alternative for Mac, with free and premium versions. The free version includes Writer, Presentation, and Spreadsheets, which are equivalent to Word, Excel, and PowerPoint.

WPS Office supports PDF to Word conversion, batch document export, split and merge PDF files. The premium version removes ads, supports 9 device connections, and provides 1GB of free cloud storage.
