

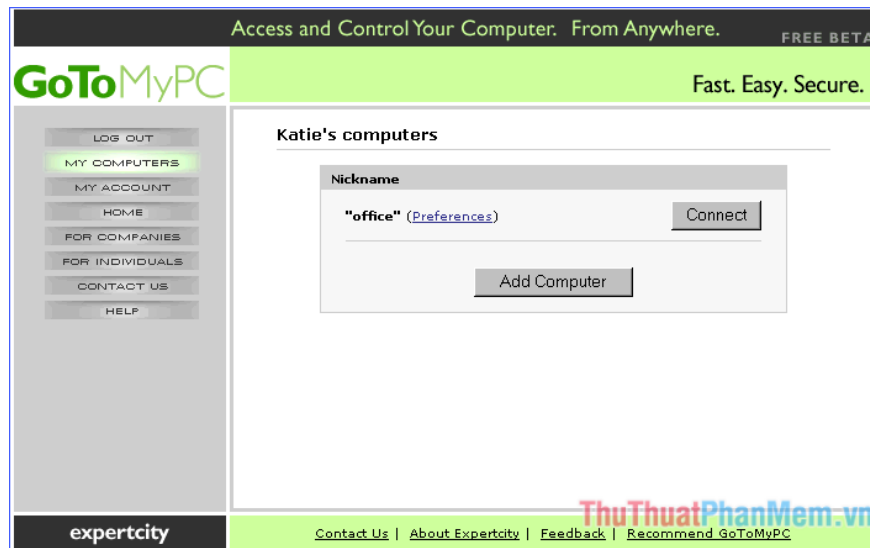

**Step 1:** Pay and register for GoToMyPC here. Or you can also choose to try this product for free here.

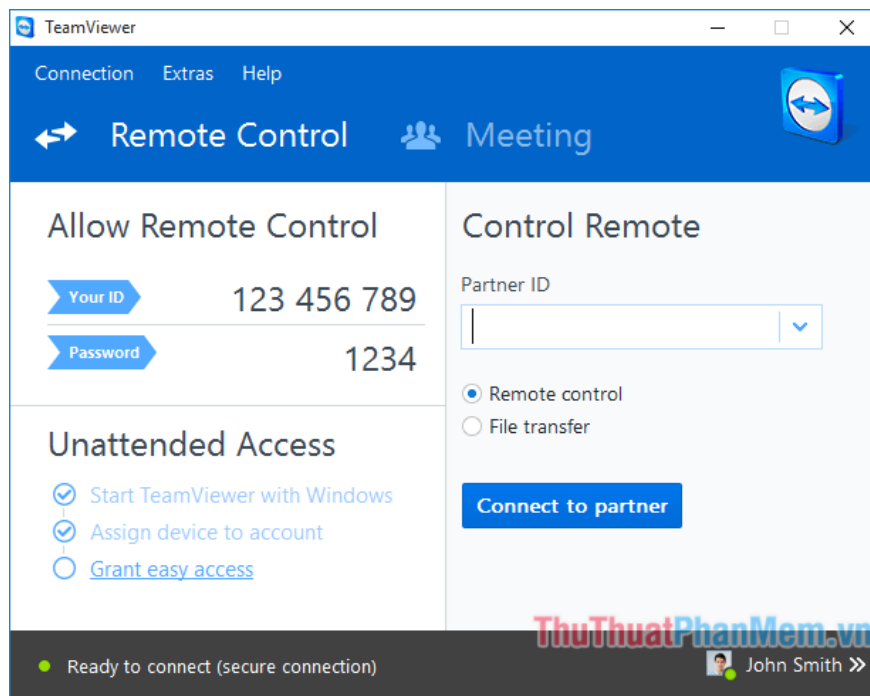
**Step 2:** Install GoToMyPC and log in on the software with the email and password provided when registering to use the product. This process only takes place once.

## 2. TeamViewer

TeamViewer is a remote access and sharing application capable of meeting business needs with full features, running on all computer platforms and mobile devices. The interface of TeamViewer is the most modern style in all remote access software. For non-commercial users, it also offers a simpler free account, although it's not exactly the app you'll want to install if it's just to help your friends and family members.



Steps to use TeamViewer:

**Step 1:** Download and install TeamViewer (can download the latest version on the homepage). Requires both your computer and the remote computer to have TeamViewer.

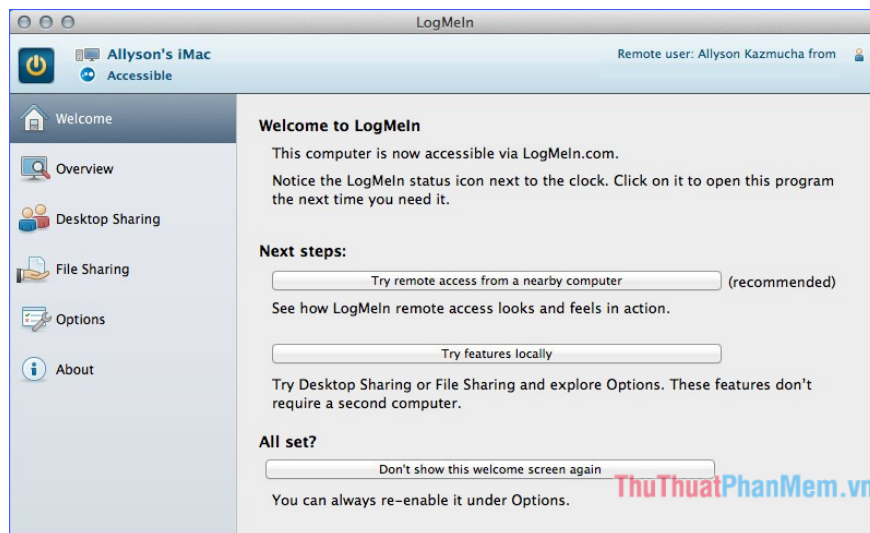
**Step 2:** Open TeamViewer (both machines). Request the remote phone to provide the ID and Password after opening.

**Step 3:** In the 'Create session' section on the TeamViewer window on your device, enter the remote machine ID (provided in step 2) and then click **Connect to partner** . Confirmation window appears, enter the password for the remote device and then click **Log on** .

**Step 4:** Start controlling the remote computer.

### 3. LogMeIn

LogMeIn is a smooth, professional remote access application for Windows PCs and macOS. It also provides flexible file sharing features including cloud storage - a feature that is almost unavailable for most similar services. This is a great option for anyone who needs to operate a remote computer, whether it's your home computer when you're on the road or an acquaintance who needs technical support.



Steps to use LogMeIn:

**Step 1:** Register an account here.

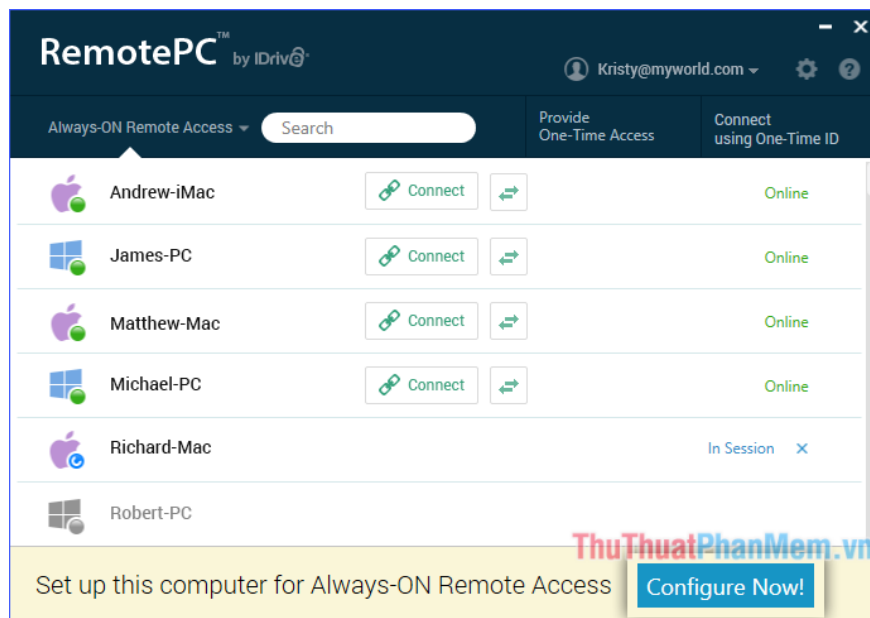
**Step 2:** Install LogMeIn.

**Step 3:** On the computer you want to access, log in at [www.logmein.com](http://www.logmein.com) and click **Add Computer** .

**Step 4:** Connect to the internet for your computer. Then log in at [www.logmein.com](http://www.logmein.com) to connect right away.

### 4. RemotePC

RemotePC is also one of the best remote access apps, providing identical features on PCs and Macs, fast performance and minimal but intuitive interface.



How to use RemotePC:

1. To access your computer remotely:

**Step 1:** Register an account here.

**Step 2:** Download RemotePC (here) and install it on your computer.

**Step 3:** Log in with your account on the software.

**Step 4:** Click **the Configure Now!** .

**Step 5:** Set Computer Name and Personal Key and then click **Enable Now!** .

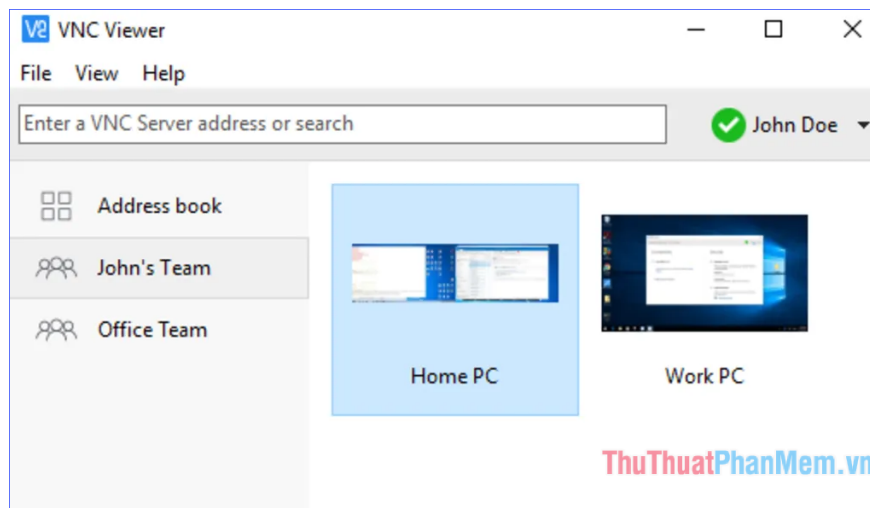
After setup, your computer will appear on the application home page. You can access it from any other computer.

1. To allow others to temporarily access your computer remotely:

Similar to TeamViewer, both your computer and the visitor must have RemotePC installed. After running and logging in, select **Provide One-Time Access** and click **Enable Now!** . Then, copy the **Access ID** and **Key** values and share it with the visitor.

## 5. VNC Connect

VNC Connect provides remote control and sharing of meetings for both personal and business use. Individual users may be attracted to the free package, and small businesses may prefer this application because the subscriptions are quite cheap for both professional and business purposes. Overall pricing is a strong point of VNC Connect, but this remote access software lacks some of the nifty features that can be found in more expensive competitors, such as the ability to send one-time invitations. for remote users when you need technical support, or drag - drop files between the screens of the remote and the local machine.



How to use VNC Connect:

1. On the remote computer that is controlled:

**Step 1:** Download VNC Connect (here) and install.

**Step 2:** Login to VNC Server to apply the registration form, or try it out.

1. On the computer you are using:

**Step 1:** Download the VNC Viewer (here).

**Step 2:** Log in with your RealVNC account information (register if not already).

**Step 3:** Connect to the remote machine.
