Thankfully, there are many great home security cameras that can help you. You can also use them to watch pets while at work, supervise them when they are home alone and monitor their babies in their kennels.

1. Logitech Circle 2 - Best overall home security camera (2.8 million VND - 3.3 million VND)



Logitech Circle 2 boasts great 1080p videos, an easy-to-use application, two-way audio, multiple accessories and a wireless version.

Logitech Circle 2 offers many of the same features as high-end security cameras and it is easy to use, the most setup of all home security cameras on this list.

This is an upgraded version of the original Circle camera and it has several improvements. The biggest improvement is that you can use it with a standard AC adapter or a wireless battery-powered version that can be used for up to 3 months on a single charge.

Logitech also makes many accessories for cameras, including window mounts, plugs, rechargeable battery packs and weather resistant camera covers.

You should use the wired option because it's more reliable and you won't have to worry about charging or buying extra accessories for it. However, if you do not want to use a wire and even use an external camera, the Wireless Circle 2 is a great product, you only need to add \$ 20.

Both wired and wireless can watch 1080p live video 24/7 and receive intelligent alerts when motion is detected. The camera has a wider 180-degree viewing angle, so you can see more space in the shot. Logitech has also supported and improved night vision, so you can see in absolute darkness. There is no delay for feeds, so you can rest assured knowing that you are viewing a live feed.

Two-way audio allows talking to children or pets while away from or threatening thieves. In addition, Logitech home cameras are easy to set up and use. The cute design also helps the camera 'blend' in with all kinds of indoor décor.

With the application, you can playback, download or share recorded videos for 24 hours from a private cloud account. You can purchase additional Circle Safe subscription storage packages with Person Detection and Smart Zones, but users don't need them. The app also provides 30 seconds of free fast-forwarding of activities for the past 24 hours, so you can get an overview of all activities.

You also don't need to plug in every time, as it can last up to 12 hours on a single charge.

Pros: Affordable, 1080p video, two-way audio, wireless operation, free app, no delay, easy setup, cute design, wide viewing angle, great app, customized choose wireless.

Cons: Need good Internet speed, buy additional accessories.

2. Wyze Cam V2 - Best cheap security camera (over 900 thousand VND)



Wyze Cam V2 can do most of the things that more expensive cameras can do at a much cheaper price.

If you don't want to spend a lot of money on security cameras, the Wyze Cam V2 is the best budget device you can buy. It offers many of the same features as high-end cameras at a low cost.

Wyze Cam V2 is a small device, not prominent, so you can easily hide it indoors. It has a flexible hinge that helps customize the height and angle of the camera.

Video Quality of Wyze Cam V2 is on par with most cameras on this list. You get 1080p videos at 15fps, like the more expensive Wise Cam Pan camera. It also has black and white night vision with the ability to see up to 30 feet and two-way audio. However, this camera has a disadvantage that it only has a 110-degree viewing angle, significantly narrower than most other cameras.

Wyze stores videos recorded for 14 days in the cloud. There is also a maximum memory card slot of 32GB.

The Wyze app provides almost the same features for V2 as the Pan except for panning. You can view live feeds, use two-way audio, take pictures and create time-lapse videos. Like Pan, V2 can send alerts based on motion, smoke, sound and CO detection. And it also works with Alexa, so you can show footage on Echo Show or Fire TV.

Wyze Cam V2 is a basic home security camera, without advanced features such as panning or face recognition.

Pros : Cheap, small, 1080p videos

Cons : Narrow viewing angle, inability to pan the camera, fairly basic features

3. Nest Cam IQ Indoor - The best security camera for smart homes (nearly 7 million VND)



Nest Cam IQ in-house is stylish and functional and integrated with Google's smart home system.

If you want to monitor your entire home with security cameras, you need a system with an application so you can quickly and easily manage all of those video sources. If so, Nest Cam IQ is the camera you need.

The Nest Cam IQ shoots 1080p HD video with a 130-degree viewing angle. It also provides night vision and two-way audio.

Nest Cam IQ is also very simple, easy to set up and use. Clear video and night vision are also effective, allowing you to easily detect movement in the dark. Nest will send motion alerts while you are out.

In addition, this home camera also has advanced features, including face recognition, customized areas and video time-lapse. However, you need to subscribe to Google's Aware Nest package to be able to use these features for \$ 5 per month or \$ 5 per year.

The Nest app is a convenient way to control all smart home devices in one place. For example, if you have Nest Hello or Nest Cam IQ Outdoor, you will also access those feeds and settings in the Nest app.

Pros: 1080p resolution, 130-degree viewing angle, great apps, works well with other Nest products

Cons: Expensive, requires registration for advanced features

4. Netgear Arlo Pro - The best outdoor security camera (nearly 5 million VND)



Netgear Arlo Pro provides excellent picture quality, can be used both inside and outside and provides two-way audio.

Netgear is known as a company that manufactures routers and Internet modems, but it has branched out quite a bit over the past few years. The company has infiltrated home security with a range of high-quality and easy-to-use security cameras like Netgear Arlo Pro.

Netgear Arlo Pro really refreshed the camera that debuted in 2015 and the new version brings some great features. For example, it provides two-way audio, allowing users to chat with indoors.

Of course, it's important that image quality and Arlo Pro don't let you down with 1,280 x 720 pixels and 130-degree viewing angles. Best of all, you get night vision of up to 25 feet and motion detection, as well as sound-activated recording.

The camera is also quite beautiful in white, and it is IP65 waterproof, so it can be used both internally and externally. Although the system is easy to use, it requires a slightly larger hub.

This camera uses a rechargeable battery that lasts for up to 6 months to recharge, you can even be notified via the included app. Users can also monitor the video recorded in the application, review the previous footage.

Pros : Great image quality, beautiful design, waterproof, long battery life

Cons : Need hub to work, the price is a bit expensive

5. Nest Hello - The best home security camera for your door (nearly 7 million VND)



Nest Hello is not only a security camera but also a doorbell that you can control from the inside

Are you looking for a camera that can hide in your home? Perhaps replacing the doorbell with the camera is a suitable option for you. Gone are the days when people used door holes to see who was outside, now you can take advantage of the latest and greatest technology to see someone outside without having to go near the door.

Nest Hello is a favorite video doorbell for many. It's quite small, with dimensions of 4.6 x 1.7 x 1 inch, suitable for most doors. The camera needs wires to connect, so it's harder to install than battery-powered devices like Ring Video Doorbell 2.

Hello also records excellent 1,600 x 1,200 resolution videos at 30 frames per second, with 160-degree viewing angles. It also provides an advanced face recognition feature. When a guest arrives, the Nest app will send you a warning telling you that not only someone has been coming but also those who have come if it is a frequent visitor. With the app, you can see guests' photos to confirm their identities. And if you don't want to answer guests, Nest Hello can provide pre-recorded feedback like "No one can come to the door."

Nest Hello is also integrated with Google's smart home ecosystem. That means you can ask Google Assistant to view the doorbell feed on any Chromecast-enabled device.

Advantages: Integrated Google Assistant, face recognition, convenient automatic feedback

Cons: Requires wired connection, complicated installation

6. Wyze Cam Pan - The best indoor security camera (860 thousand VND)



Wyze Cam Pan features motion tracking, 1080p video, and Alexa support

Wyze Cam Pan lacks some of the advanced features that you can find in high-end cameras. But it offers pretty good basic features for just \$ 37.

Pan records 1080p videos at 15 frames per second and has a 120-degree viewing angle. This is not a wide angle like some other cameras.

Wyze Cam Pan is simple to set up and use. Intuitive application and easy user guide setup.

When out, the Wyze app will send you a notification when it detects motion. You can also turn on sound, smoke and CO alerts. Users can view the camera feed from the phone.

You can also enable motion tracking, help the camera track whoever triggered the alert, or you can set the camera to automatically rotate between preset points. Users can take photos and use two-way audio to chat with intruders.

If you're a smart home enthusiast, you can also use Amazon Alexa to view the Pan feed on your Echo Show or Fire TV device.

Pros: Affordable, 1080p video, Alexa integration, Alexa support, free storage

Cons : Viewing angle is only 120 degrees, lacking some advanced features

A few things to keep in mind when buying home security cameras

However, in order to buy a good home security camera, you need to consider some issues.

1. **Resolution :** First, you need to consider the resolution of the camera, which is the main factor when buying security cameras. 720p is the standard resolution for home security cameras today, but some cameras offer an even better resolution. You should use 1080p if possible or 720p if you want to save.

2. **Viewing angle** : Next, you also need to consider the perspective of the camera, basically this is the ability to see left and right of the camera. With a home security camera, the bigger the view, the better, because you'll see more space with one camera instead of having to use another.
3. **Night vision** : If you need to observe your house at night when you're away, you should choose to buy a camera with good night vision.
4. **Application design** : Many home security cameras connect to applications and use them to set up. It is important that the application is easy to use and reliable. You should choose larger companies to get better applications.
5. **Cloud storage** : Security cameras store online footage today, and many companies also offer certain free cloud storage with their products. You should consider the cloud storage they provide and whether it is enough for your usage or the price to buy additional storage.
6. **Security and privacy** : Make sure the camera you buy has a strong privacy and security policy. Because the camera will shoot footage of your home and private life and no one wants hackers to spy on it. The companies on this list all offer strong security and privacy with strong cloud storage and strong encryption.
7. **Strong Internet** : You will need a strong Internet connection to the camera as most of them run over Wi-Fi. If the signal is poor, your camera may not work.
