The first phone model in Google's flagship range, received the last major Android software update, but the Google Pixel XL is still the best option to help older people adapt to using Android phones.

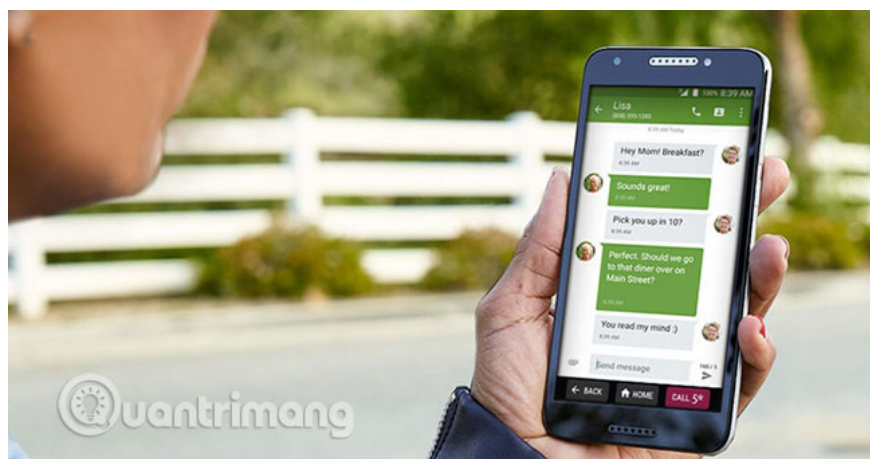
First, the Google Pixel XL is not too expensive and can be purchased for less than \$ 300 (VND 6,900,000), an attractive price. Google Pixel XL owns a 12.3MP camera, a 5.5-inch screen and a resolution of 1440 x 2560 pixels, ensuring every picture is beautiful and clear. User interface elements such as icons and font sizes can be increased for convenience when older people use them.

The final Android software update that Pixel XL received is Android 9.0 Pie, which is still the latest Android version at the time of writing. That means seniors will get all the top Android gadgets. The original Android user interface is one of the most user-friendly interfaces and will help older people get acquainted not only with the use of this phone in particular, but also with the entire Android operating system in general.

In addition to the really loud sound, PowerTel M9500 also has a user interface designed with large buttons clearly labeled.
